Part 1 crime reported in Stevens Square – Loring Heights, 12/19/14 to 1/22/15 (source: CPS Chelsea Adams)

- 2 robberies of person – 1/14, 3:15 p.m., at 1920 4th Ave in which a suspect entered this Public Housing high rise, pushed a person, and grabbed money from her jacket pocket – the person struggled with the suspect and got her money back, but in the process was shoved to the ground and cut her hand; 1/17, 6:20 a.m., at 1806 3rd Ave in which two suspects robbed a person at gunpoint and then fled on foot.
- No aggravated assaults (except domestic).
- 2 burglaries – 12/25 to 12/30 at 1707 3rd Ave in which an unknown suspect stole electronic from an apartment; 1/12, 3:15 to 4:50 a.m., at 1825 2nd Ave in which a laundry room was burglarized.
- 2 motor vehicle thefts – 12/30, at 19th & Nicollet; 12/31, at 326 East 18th St from a parking lot behind this condo building.

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, possession of liquor in a park.

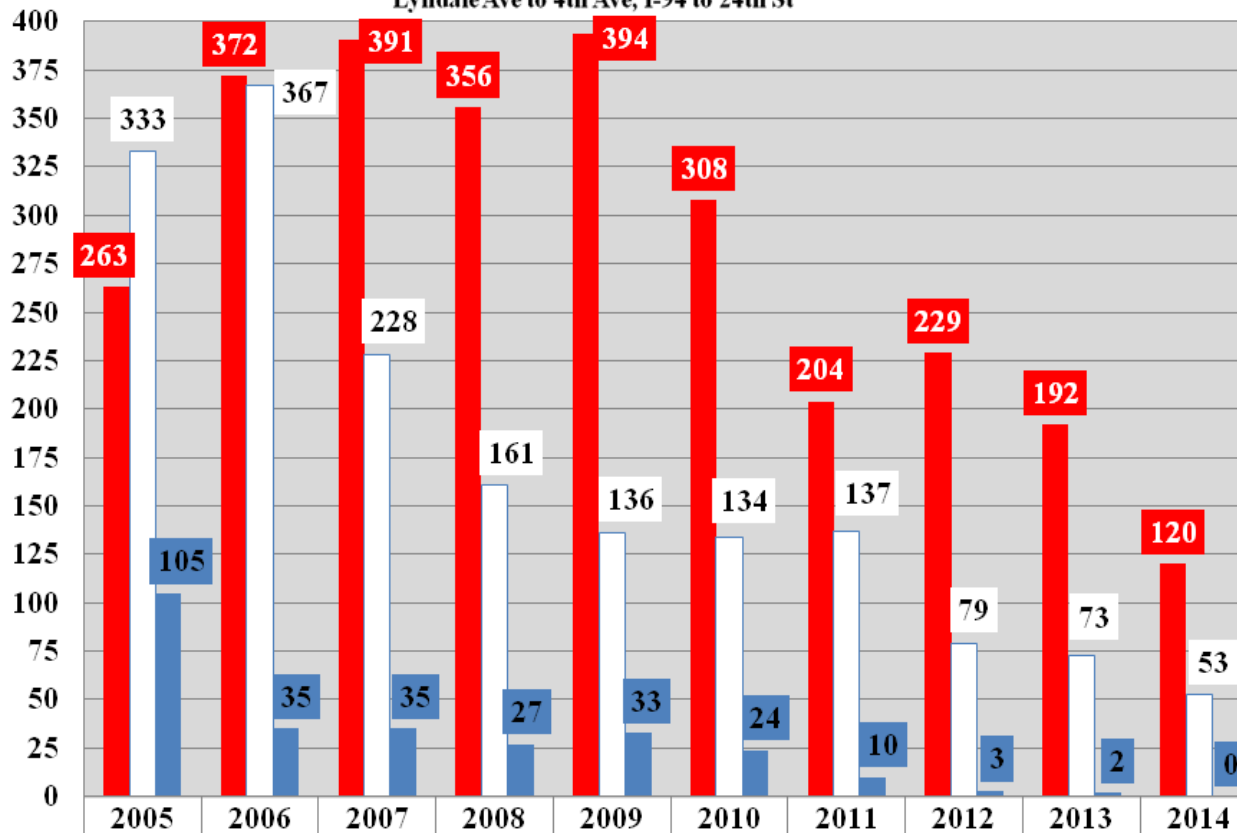
Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

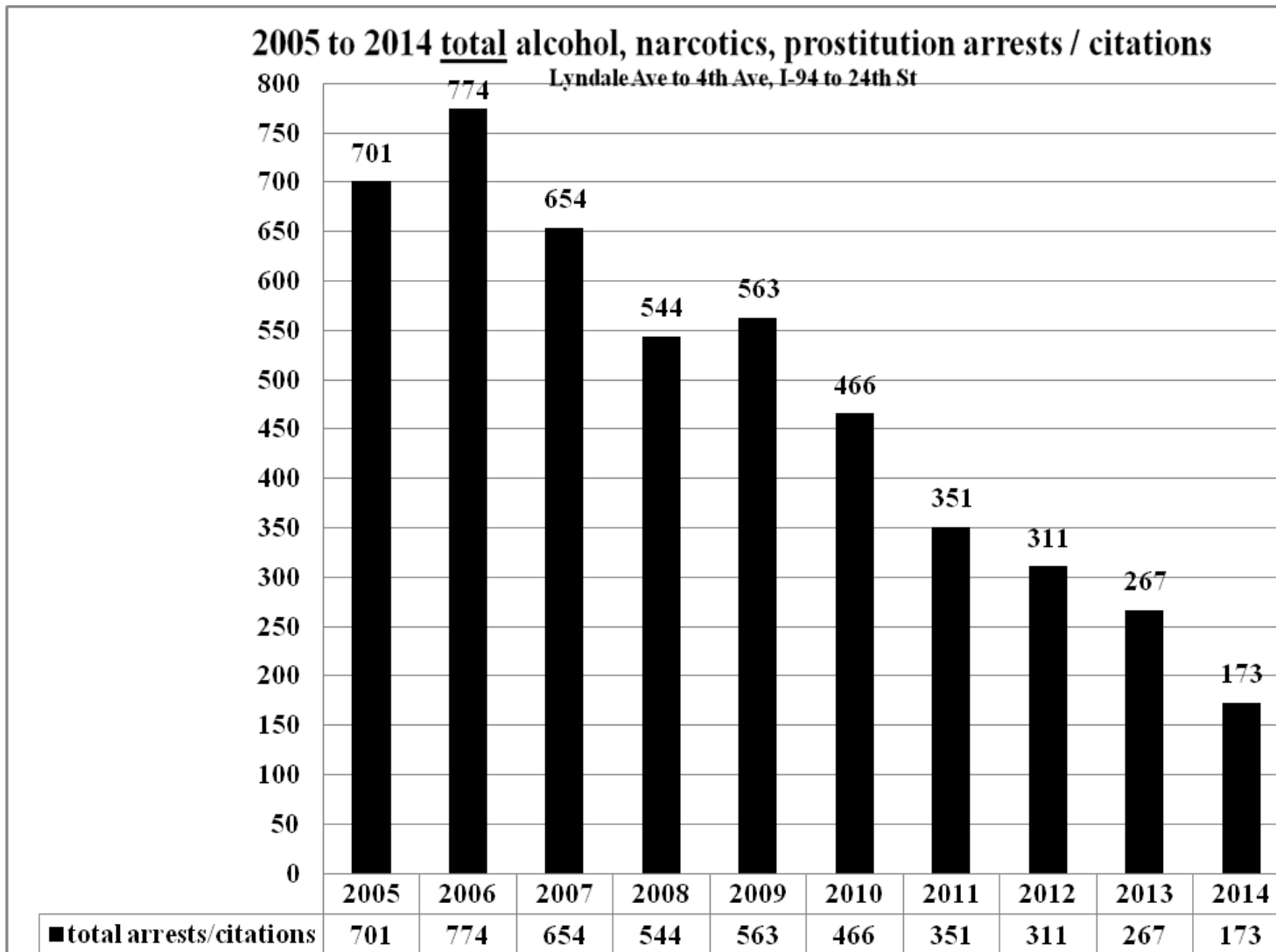
2005 to 2014 alcohol, narcotics, prostitution arrests/citations

2014 alcohol-related arrests are down 37.5% compared to 2013 and down 69.6% compared to 2009.
 2014 narcotics-related arrests are down 27.4% compared to 2013 and down 85.6% compared to 2006.
 Prostitution-related arrests are down from 105 in 2005 to 0 in 2014.



2014 arrests for all three categories combined are down 35.3% compared to 2013 and down 77.7% compared to 2006.

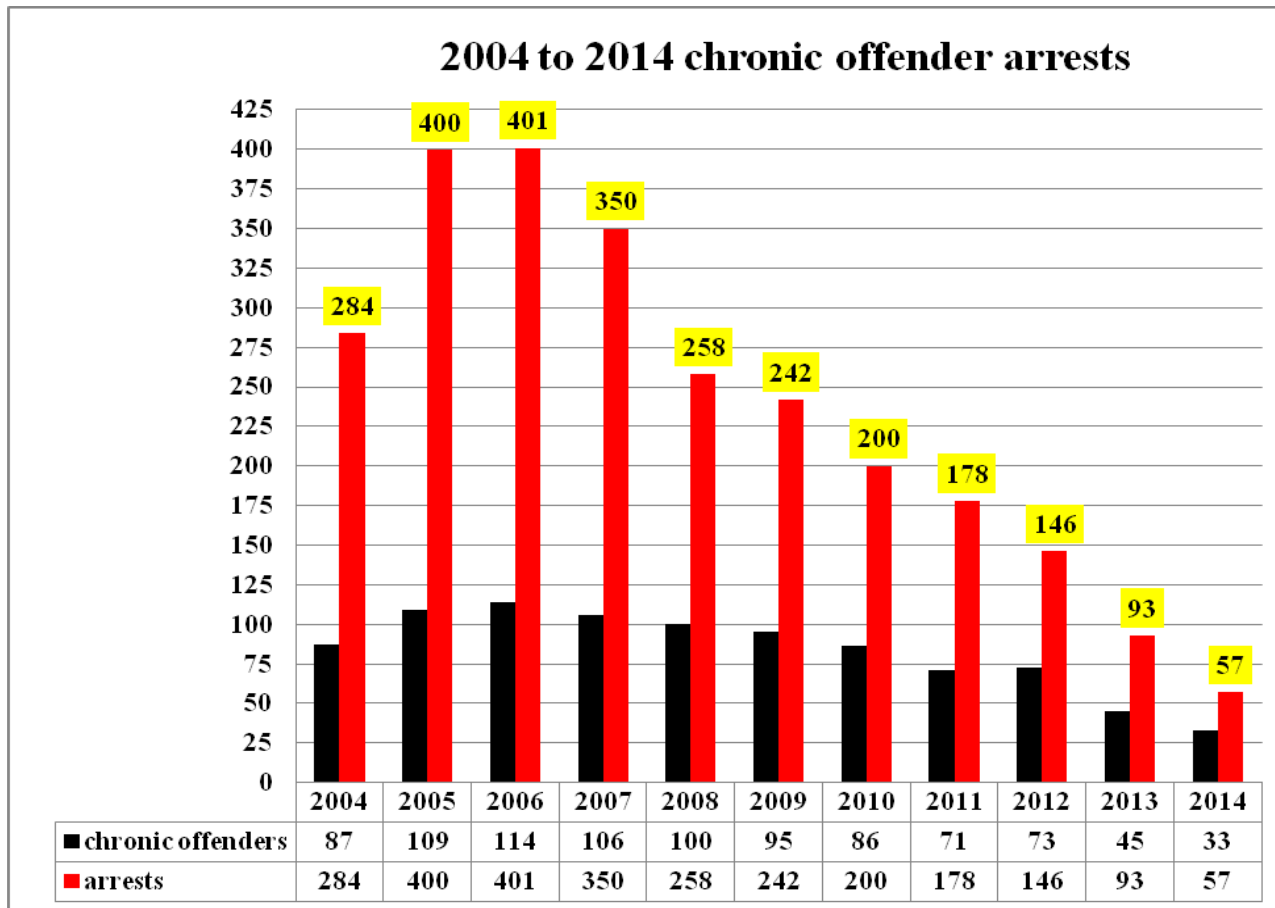
chronic offender = five or more arrests in the area within two years

For example, 87 chronic offenders accounted for 284 arrests in the area in 2004.

231 chronic offenders have accounted for 2,609 arrests in the area since 2004.

The number of chronic offenders arrested in 2014 is down 26.7% compared to 2013 and down 71.1% compared to 2006.

Total arrests of chronic offenders in 2014 are down 38.8% compared to 2013 and down 85.8% compared to 2006.



top offender arrests per year, 2004 to 2014

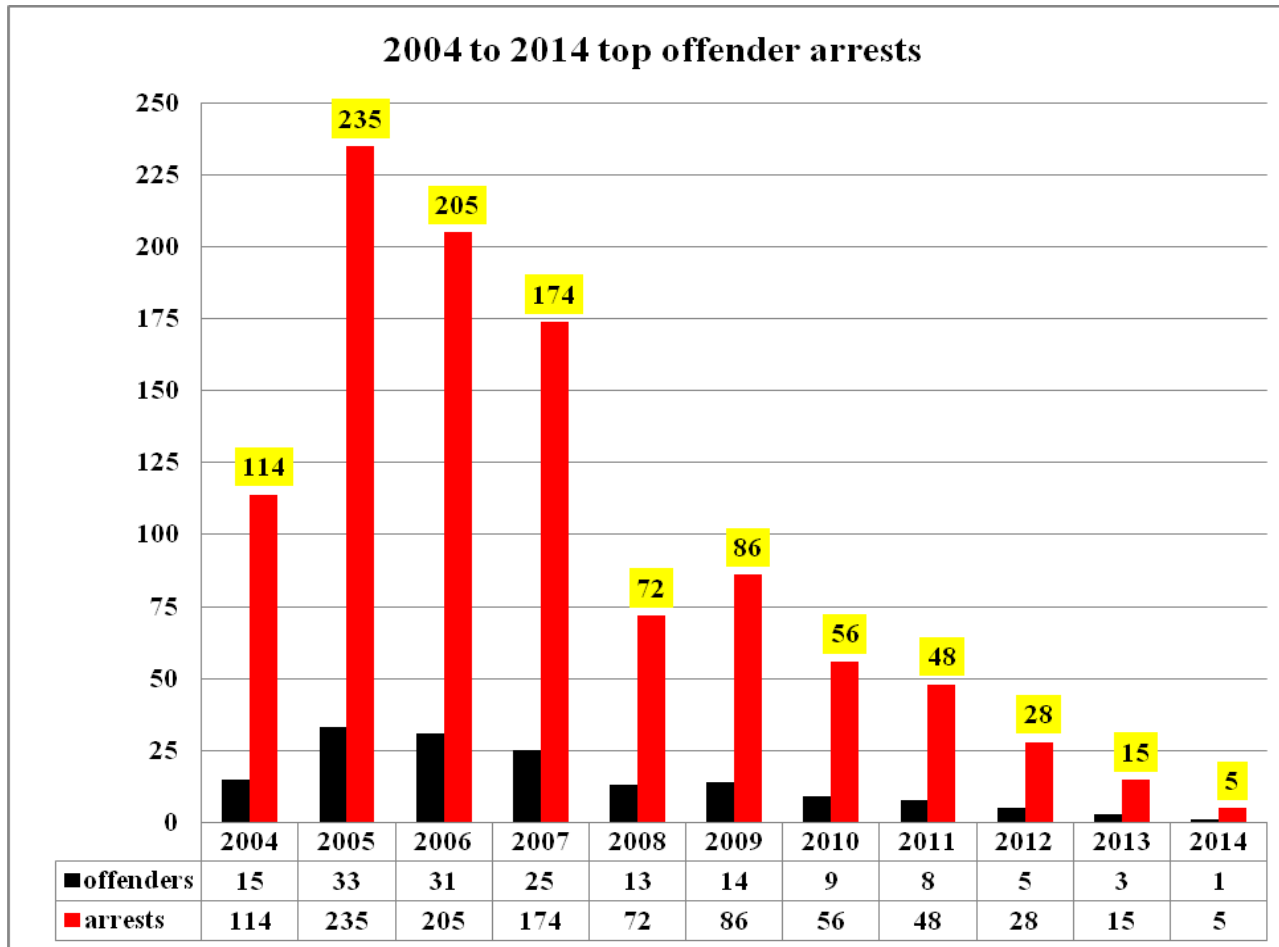

top offender = five or more arrests in the area in a calendar year

For example, 15 offenders were arrested 5 or more times in the area in 2004, accounting for 114 arrests.

There was one top offender in 2014 ([Paul Vernon Clock](#), 6/27/54) compared to 3 in 2013 and 33 in 2005. Total arrests of top offenders in 2014 were down 66.7% compared to 2013 and down 97.9% compared to 2005.



SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:

<u>John Iverson</u> (10/16/64) 2 prior convictions in Hennepin County for unauthorized use of a motor vehicle and disorderly conduct.
Case 2/3/14, criminal vehicular operation – homicide at 600 West Franklin Ave. (14-036452)
Outcome On 1/6/15, pled guilty. Sentence: 48 months, with credit for 338 days served. \$153 court fees waived. Prison release: 10/3/16.
Sentencing judge – Martha Holton Dimick

<u>Reginald Paul Shakespeare</u> (3/14/64) 7 arrests in the area in the past two years. 12 prior convictions in Minnesota for disorderly conduct (4), consuming alcohol in public (3), driving while intoxicated, 5 th degree assault (2), public urination, and trespassing.
Case 10/23/14, open bottle at Franklin & Nicollet, cited by day beat officers. (14-376921)
Outcome On 12/9/14, failed to appear in court; warrant issued. Arrested for the warrant on 12/16/14. On 12/17/14, this case and a trespassing case were dismissed. Pled guilty to trespassing from 11/24/14. Sentence: 90 days, 60 days stayed for one year, serve 30 days, with credit for 2 days served. Conditions of release: probation to the court; no same or similar offenses; no trespassing; no loitering; no consuming alcohol in public; no alcohol-related offenses; stay away from all Target Stores. \$50 fine and \$75 court fees waived. Pay \$78 additional court fees. Released from the workhouse on 1/3/15.
Sentencing judge – Gary Larson

<u>Gerald Wolf</u> (8/31/50) 18 prior convictions in Hennepin County for 5 th degree assault (2), aggressive panhandling, consuming alcohol in public (6), open bottle (7), and disorderly conduct (2).
Case 11/6/14, consuming alcohol in public at Groveland & Nicollet, cited by day beat officers. (14-394237)
Outcome On 1/9/15, pled guilty. Sentence: 90 days, stayed for one year. Conditions of release: supervised probation; chemical dependency evaluation/treatment; remain law abiding. \$50 fine stayed for one year. \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$78 court fees.
Sentencing judge – Diane Bratvold

<u>Ellery Reginald Charging Thunder</u> (2/20/54) 21 arrests in the area in the past ten years. 32 prior convictions in Hennepin County for interfering with traffic (3), obstructing the sidewalk, criminal damage to property, theft, disorderly conduct, consuming alcohol in public (7), open bottle (2), carrying weapons, domestic assault (2), trespassing (11), interfering with the operator of a transit vehicle, and aggressive panhandling.
Case 7/22/14, consuming alcohol in public at Franklin & Nicollet, cited by day beat officers. (14-254462)
Outcome On 1/13/15, this case was dismissed. Pled guilty to trespassing from 6/21/14. Sentence: 90 days, stayed for one year. Conditions of release: supervised probation; remain law abiding; chemical dependency evaluation/treatment. \$50 fine stayed for one year. &75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$78 court fees.
