- 3 robberies of person: 12/22, 9 p.m., at 1905 3rd Ave in which a person who arranged to meet someone at this location to sell his shoes was robbed at gunpoint; 1/7, 9 p.m., at Franklin & Nicollet in which a person was assaulted and robbed by two suspects; 1/15, 7:40 p.m., at 18th & 3rd in which known suspects punched and robbed a person of her purse.
- 1 theft from person: 1/21, 4:10 p.m. at 18th & Nicollet in which a suspect stole a phone from a person who was sitting at a bus stop and looking at it.
- 2 assaults: 12/29, 2:55 p.m., at 1816 Nicollet, Village Center Mall for which the suspect was arrested later; 1/11, 11:45 p.m., at 1801 1st Ave in which a suspect who harassed a person on a bus followed the person home and attempted to assault him.

Rape was down 57.2% compared to 2015 and down 75% compared to 2000 and 2011 (the years with the highest number).

Robbery was up 75% compared to 2015 and down 57.6% compared to 1999 (the year with the highest number).

Aggravated assault was down 12.5% compared to 2015 and down 36.4% compared to 2013 (the year with the highest number).

Total violent crimes were up 10.6% compared to 2015 and down 48% compared to 1999 (the year with the highest number).

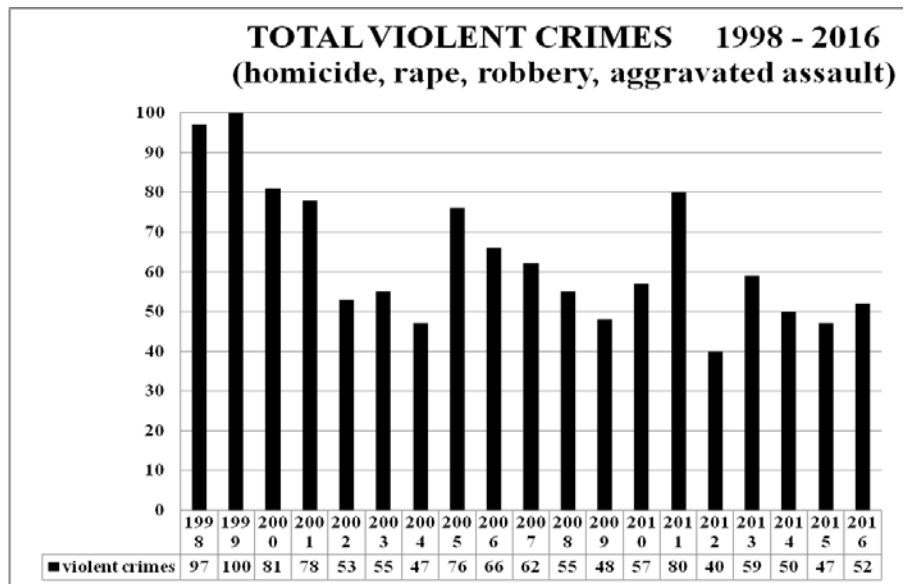
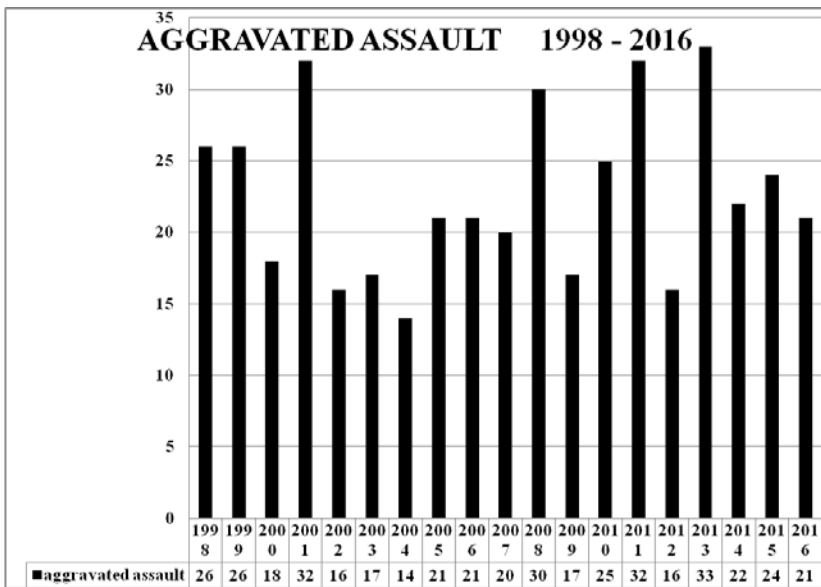
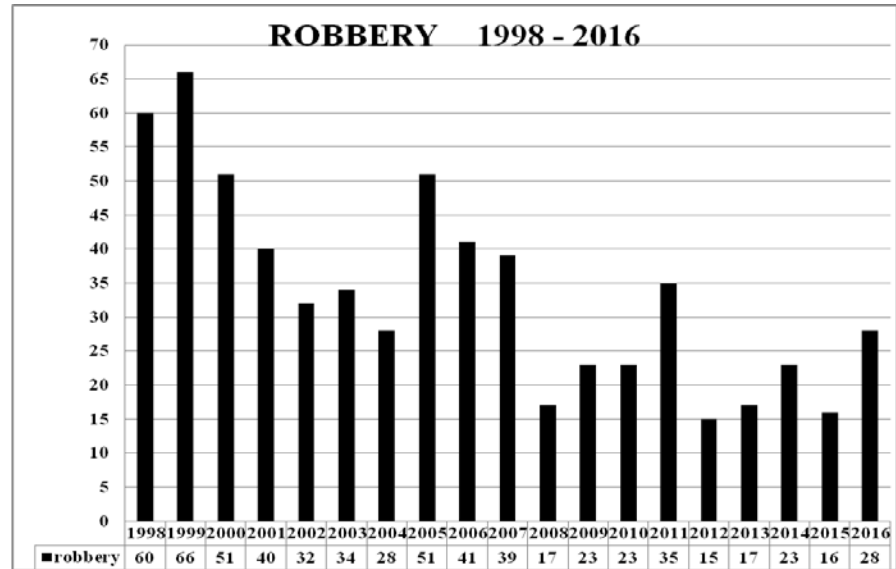
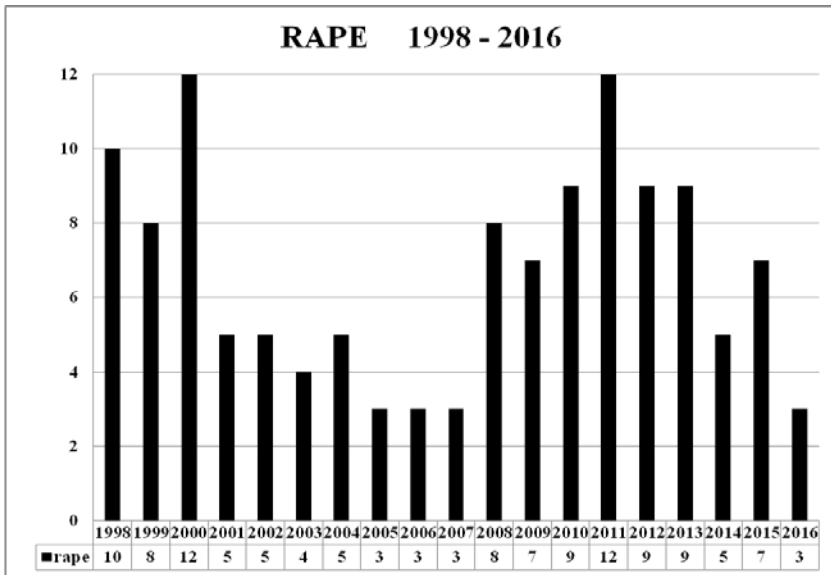
Burglary was down 2.8% compared to 2015 and down 41.7% compared to 1998 (the year with the highest number).

Incidents of theft were down 24.2% compared to 2015 and down 63.4% compared to 1999 (the year with the highest number).

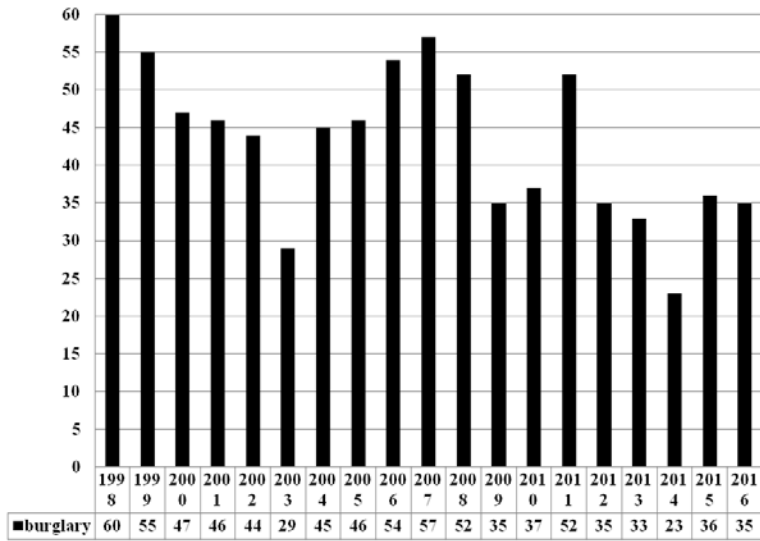
Motor vehicle thefts were up 30.7% compared to 2015 and down 63.9% compared to 2001 (the year with the highest number).

Total property crimes were down 15.4% compared to 2015 and down 41.8% compared to 1999 (the year with the highest number).

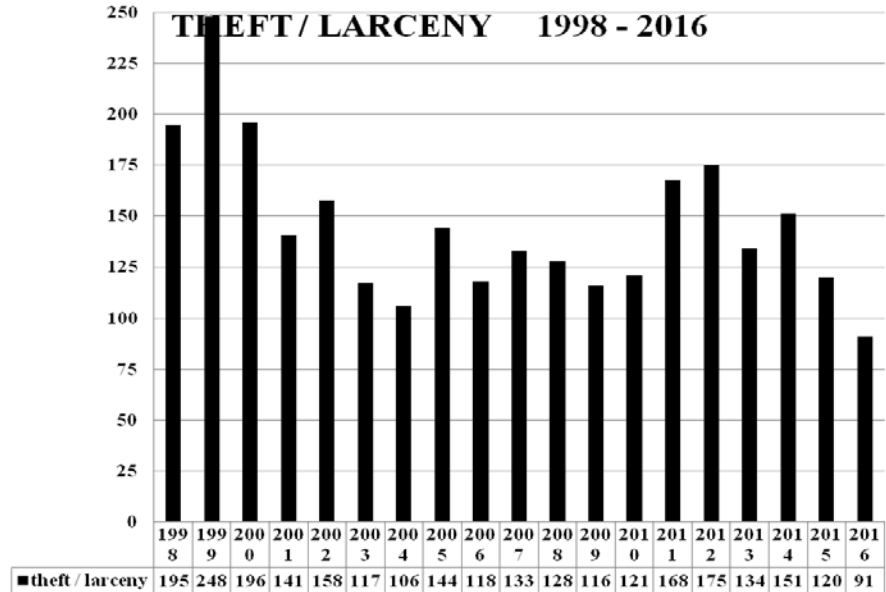

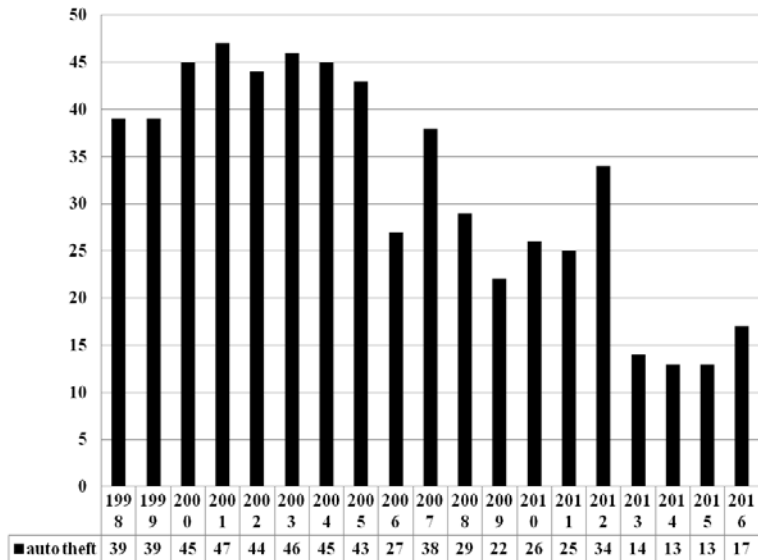
BURGLARY 1998 - 2016



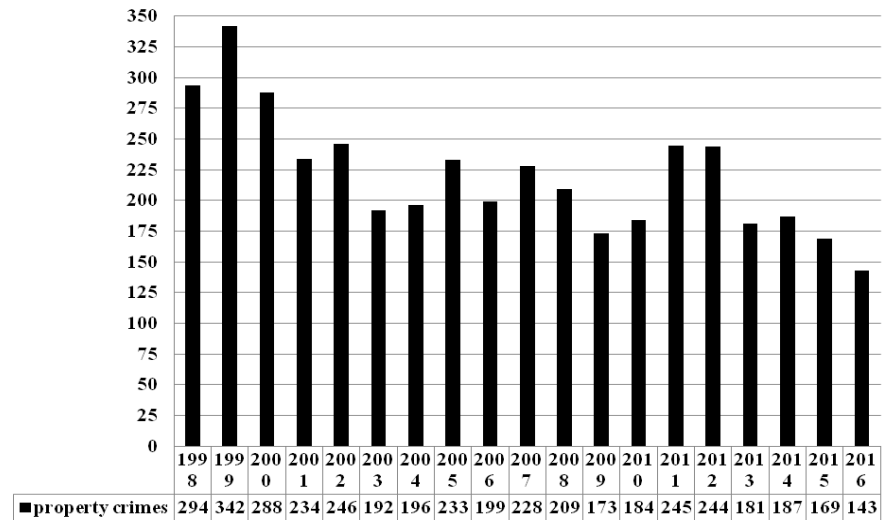
THEFT / LARCENY 1998 - 2016

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

2016 alcohol-related arrests are down 36.4% compared to 2015 and down 80.5% compared to 2009.

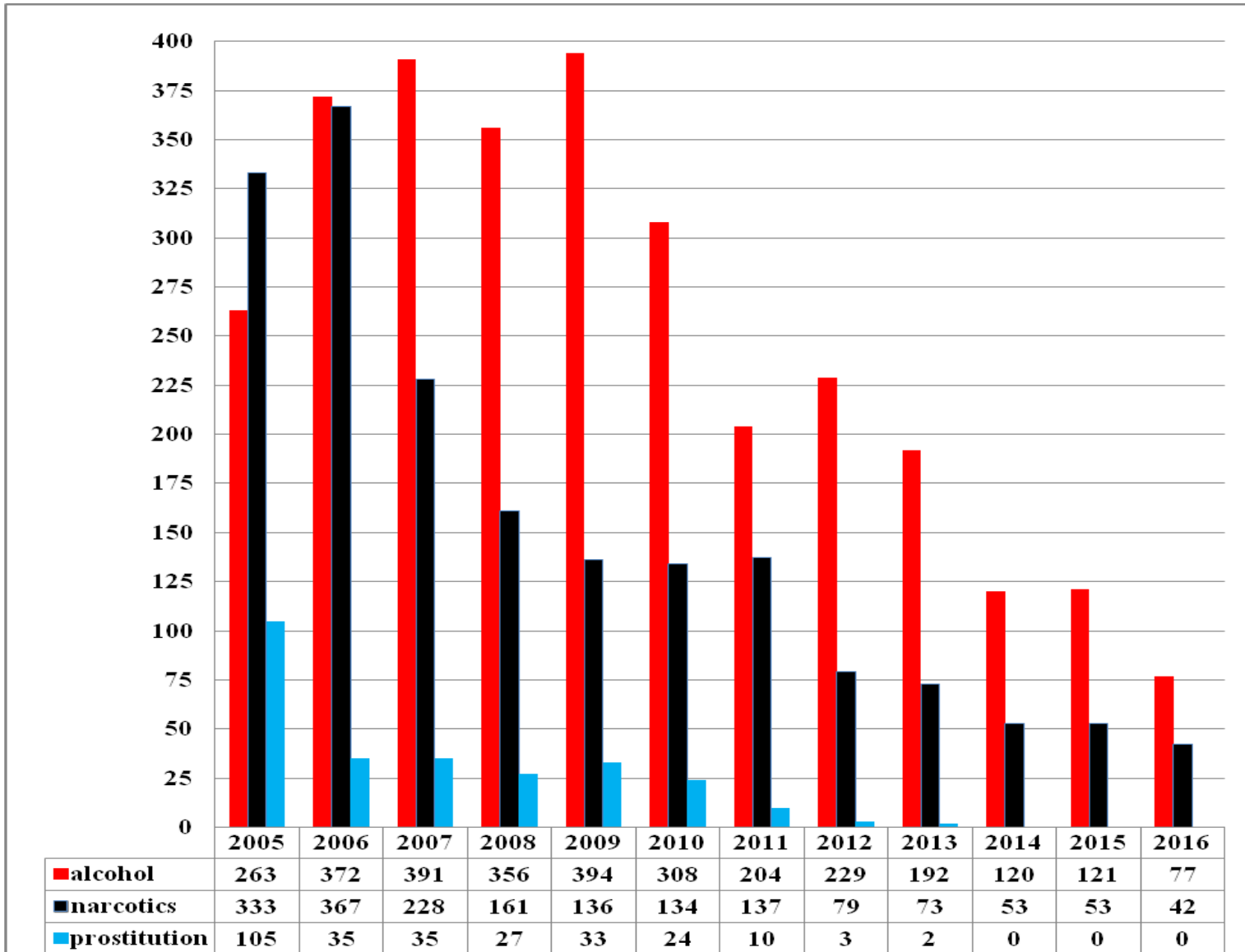
2016 narcotics-related arrests are down 20.8% compared to 2015 and down 88.6% compared to 2006.

Prostitution-related arrests are down from 105 in 2005 to 0 in 2014, 2015, and 2016.

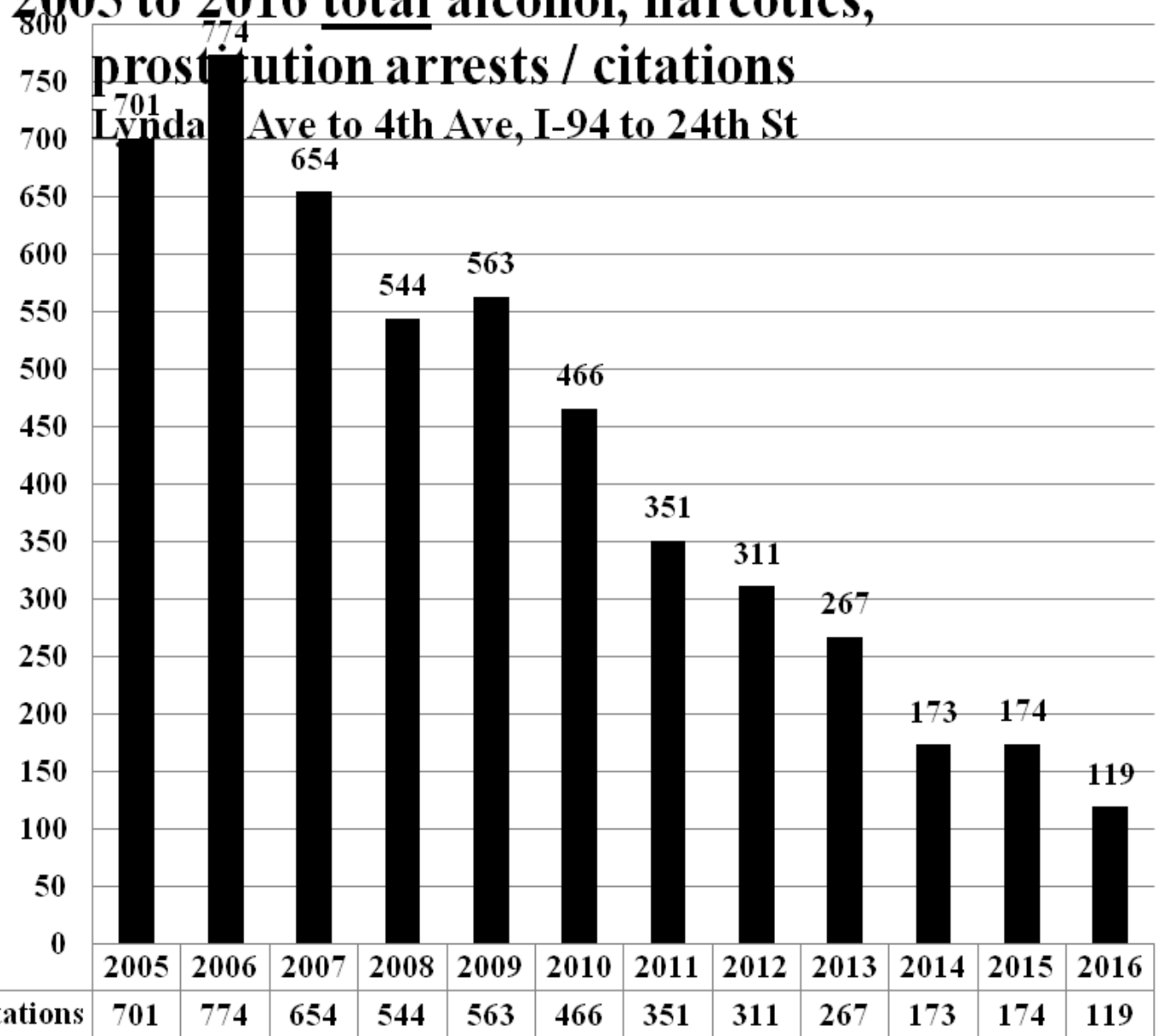
2016 arrests for all three categories combined are down 31.7% compared to 2015 and down 84.7% compared to 2006.

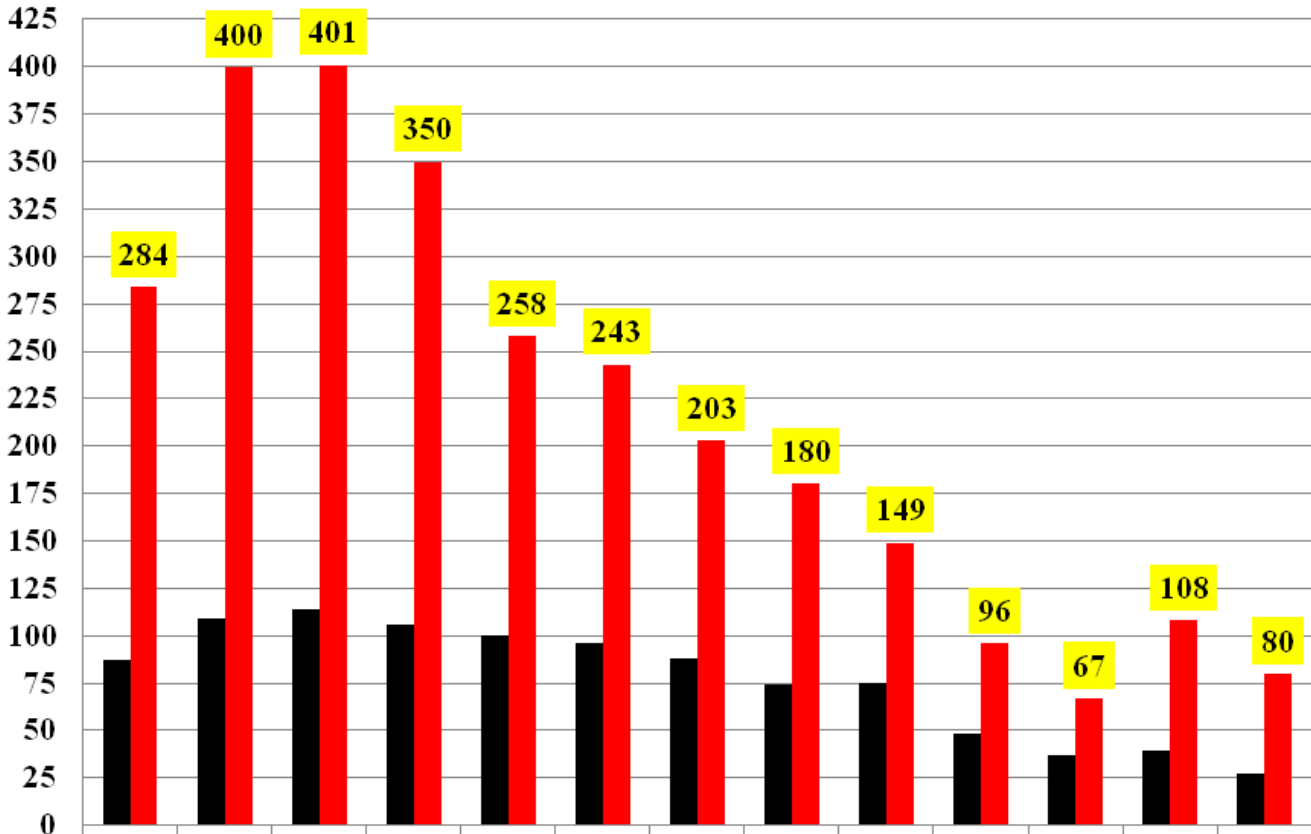
For example, 87 chronic offenders accounted for 284 arrests in the area in 2004.

250 chronic offenders have accounted for 2,819 arrests in the area from 2004 to 2016.

The number of chronic offenders arrested in 2016 is down 30.8% compared to 2015 and down 76.4% compared to 2006.

Total arrests of chronic offenders in 2016 are down 26% compared to 2015 and down 80.1% compared to 2006.

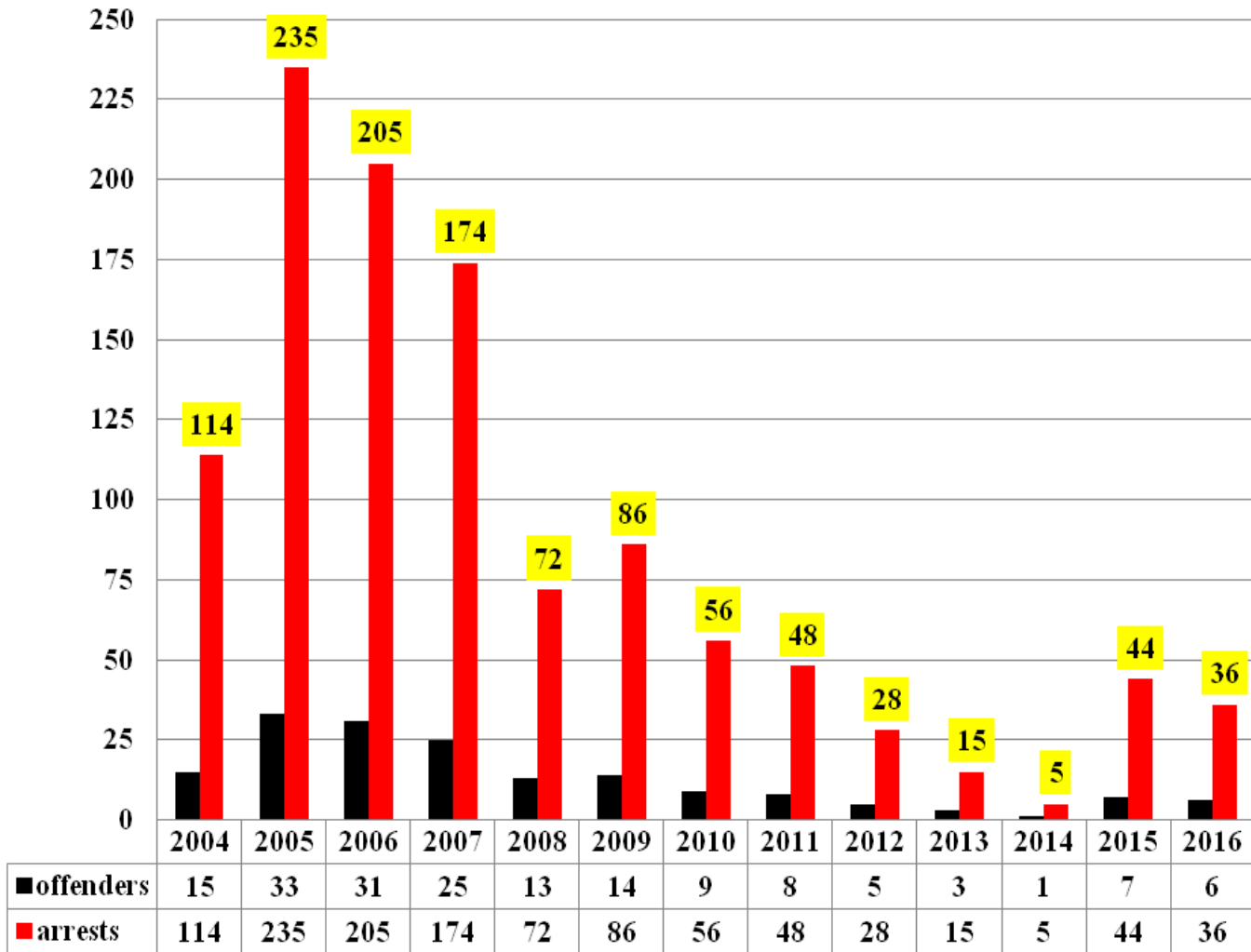
top offender = five or more arrests in the area in a calendar year

For example, 15 offenders were arrested 5 or more times in the area in 2004, accounting for 114 arrests.

There were 6 top offenders in 2016 compared to 7 in 2015 and 33 in 2005.

Total arrests of top offenders in 2016 were down 18.2% compared to 2015 and down 84.7% compared to 2005.

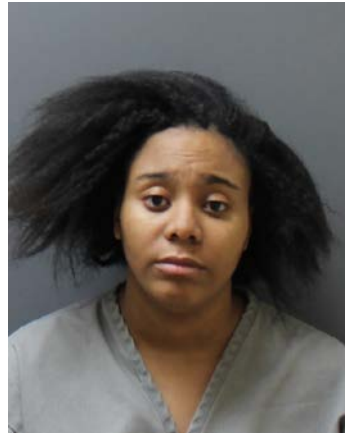
