### **CLEAN list update, September 25 to October 22, 2015** (source: Community Attorney Nikki Appelbaum)

- Patrick Addy – in custody on \$10,000 bail for 4<sup>th</sup> degree felony assault of a police officer and two gross misdemeanor trespassing cases, set for court on 11/4.
- Paul Vernon Clock – in HOMES court, on supervised probation, pled guilty to trespassing from 10/5/15.
- Frank Killright – on supervised probation, sober, in school, doing well.
- David Ayoti Omurwa – on supervised probation, in HOMES court, doing well in treatment.

### **SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:**



**Mohamed Hassan Ali** (1/1/79) 6 arrests in the area in the past eight months. 24 prior convictions in Hennepin County for driving while intoxicated, open bottle (3), unlawfully obtaining transit services (3), trespassing (10), criminal vehicular operation, 5<sup>th</sup> degree criminal sexual conduct, disorderly conduct (3), theft, and consuming alcohol in public.

**Case** 3/27/15, consuming alcohol in public in Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave, cited by Park police. (15-105705)

**Case** 5/23/15, consuming alcohol in public in Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave, cited by Park police. (15-186116)

**Case** 6/12/15, public urination in Fair Oaks Park, 2200 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave, cited by Park police. (15-214835)

**Case** 8/25/15, trespassing and open bottle at LaSalle Community Gardens, 1801 LaSalle Ave, cited by day beat officers. (15-320302)

**Outcome** On 9/24/15, these cases were dismissed. Pled guilty to trespassing from 8/13/15. Sentence: 90 days, 88 days stayed for one year, serve 2 days, with credit for 2 days served. Conditions of release: probation to the court; no trespassing; no public urination; stay a reasonable distance away from the victim's residence. \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$78 court fees.

**Sentencing judge** – Paul Scoggin



**David Ayoti Omurwa** (12/10/84) 16 prior convictions in Hennepin and Ramsey Counties for driving while intoxicated (2), trespassing (4), disorderly conduct (2), consuming alcohol in public (3), open bottle (3), lurking with intent to commit a crime, and fleeing police on foot.

**Case** 4/27/15, disorderly conduct at 22<sup>nd</sup> & Clinton, cited by day beat officers. (15-150237)

**Outcome** On 9/16/15, this case was dismissed. Pled guilty to open bottle from 5/9/15; a 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault charge was dismissed. Sentence: supervised probation for one year; no same or similar offenses; comply with HOMES Court. \$153 court fees waived.

**Sentencing judge** – Bruce Peterson



**Omar Abdirahman Ibrahim** (1/1/89) 7 prior convictions in Hennepin and Ramsey Counties for driving while intoxicated (3), trespassing, underage consumption of alcohol, 1<sup>st</sup> degree aggravated robbery, and attempted 1<sup>st</sup> degree aggravated robbery.

**Case** 3/31/15, open bottle at Loring Nicollet Alternative School, 1925 Nicollet Ave, cited by day beat officers. (15-111194)

**Outcome** On 5/6/15, this case was dismissed. Pled to disorderly conduct from 1/28/15; a 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault charge was dismissed. Sentence: 60 days, stayed for one year, with credit for 15 days served. Conditions of release: probation to the court; remain law abiding; comply with HOMES Court; stay away from the victim's residence. \$153 court fees waived.

**Sentencing judge** – Bruce Peterson



**Anthony Deangelo Jackson** (7/19/81) Prior conviction in Hennepin County for disorderly conduct.

**Case** 4/28/15, felony 4<sup>th</sup> degree assault of a police officer (four counts) and gross misdemeanor obstructing the legal process at Franklin & 3<sup>rd</sup>, arrested by squads 521, 525, 513 (15-152066)

**Outcome** On 9/28/15, pled guilty to two counts of gross misdemeanor 4<sup>th</sup> degree assault of a police officer; the other charges were dismissed. Sentence: 365 days, 345 days stayed for two years, serve 20 days on Sentence to Service, with credit for 3 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; follow all State and Federal criminal laws.

**Sentencing judge** – Elizabeth Cutter



**Paul Vernon Clock** (6/27/54) 10 arrests in the area in the past three years. 16 prior convictions in Minnesota for disorderly conduct (6), 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault, criminal damage to property, consuming alcohol in public, open bottle (5), giving police a false name, and trespassing.

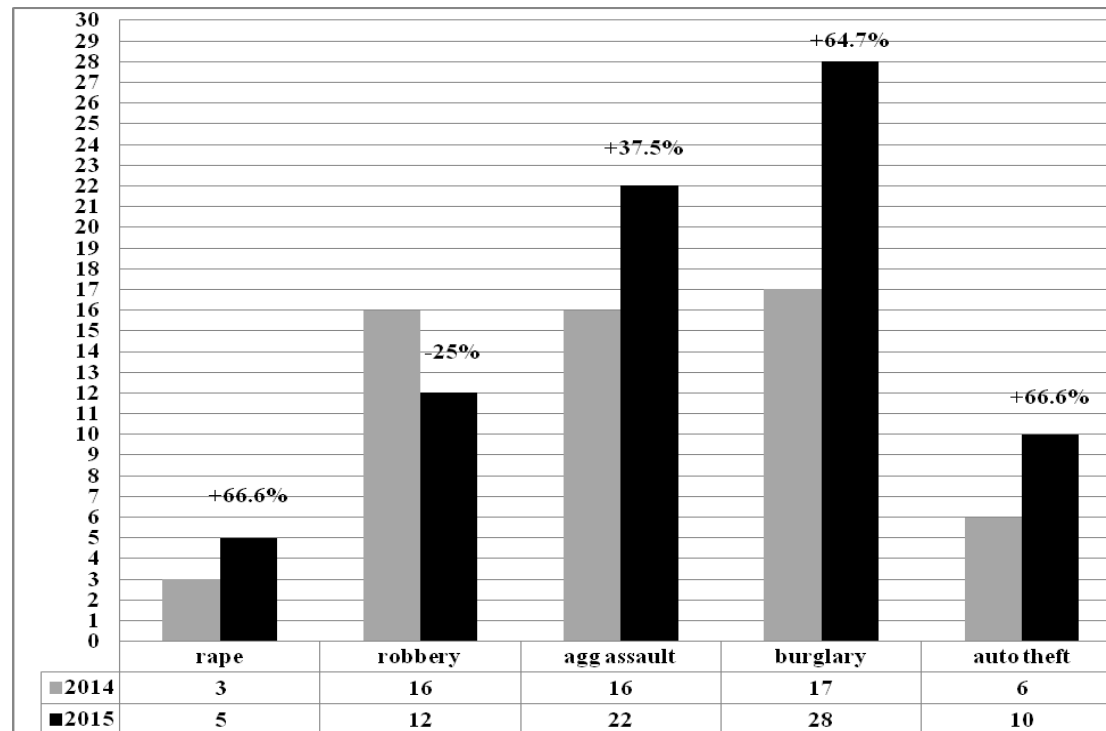
**Case** 10/5/15, trespassing and littering at McDonald's Restaurant, 2400 Nicollet Ave, arrested by day beat officers. (15-373804)

**Outcome** On 10/7/15, pled guilty to trespassing. The littering charge was dismissed. Sentence: 4 days, with credit for 4 days served. \$153 court fees waived.

**Stevens Square – Loring Heights Part 1 crimes, January through September** (source: Minneapolis Police department)

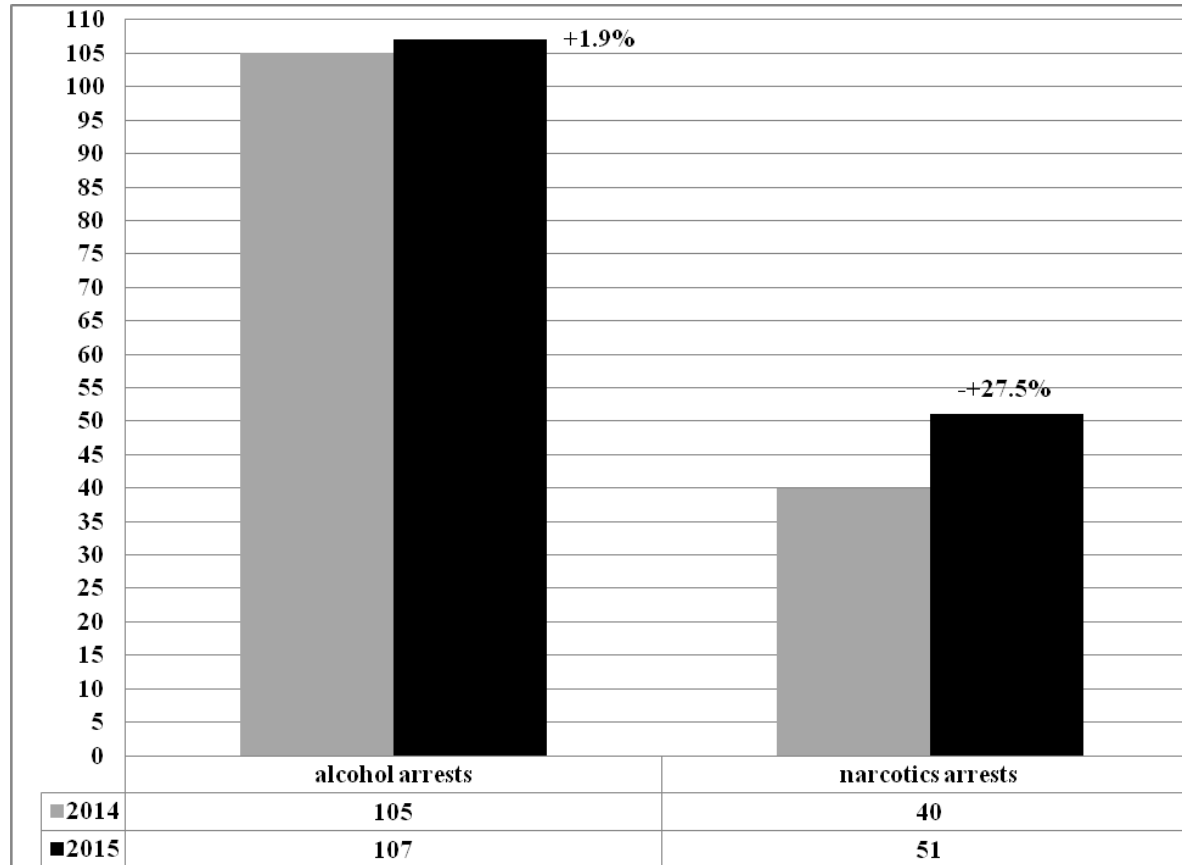

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.
