- David Brenner (7/5/75) – two warrants for probation violations.
- Jane Bringsthem (2/25/57) – not on probation, no cases pending.
- Ellery Charging Thunder (2/20/54) – in jail on \$1,000 bail pending HOMES Court review on 11/7 after he was charged with five new cases of violating geographic restrictions over the past month.
- Armondo Day (10/5/74) – not on probation, no cases pending.
- Lamar Lee Jones (4/16/78) – arrested on 10/26 for three misdemeanor warrants for trespassing (2) and 5th degree assault, public urination case set for court on 11/16.
- Harry Leftbear (11/25/60) – failed to appear in HOMES Court and has 16 misdemeanor warrants for trespassing (9), interfering with traffic (5), 5th degree assault, consuming alcohol in public, and open bottle.
- Rachael O'Gorman (12/24/76) – in jail for a probation violation.
- Brian Whitebird (12/8/68) – misdemeanor warrant for trespassing.

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:



Valerie Marie Foote (1/15/83) 28 prior convictions in Minnesota since 2001 for driving while intoxicated (2), underage consumption of liquor (2), giving police false information, tampering with a motor vehicle, motor vehicle theft (2), domestic assault, obstructing the legal process, receiving stolen property, consuming alcohol in public (2), giving police a false name (2), disorderly conduct (3), theft, trespassing (3), open bottle (4), and riding public transit without paying the fare (2).

Case 2/23/17, open bottle at Franklin & Nicollet, cited by Franklin Nicollet beat officers. (17-065803)

Outcome On 9/26/17, pled guilty. Sentence: 60 days, with credit for 27 days served. Also pled guilty to riding public transit without paying the fare from 2/20/17. Sentence: 60 days, with credit for 30 days served. The sentences were ordered to be served concurrently. \$75 court fees waived. Additional \$78 court fees deemed uncollectible. Released from the workhouse on 10/8/17.

Eloy James Stier (8/4/87) 30 prior convictions in Minnesota since 2005 for trespassing (7), 1st degree aggravated robbery, theft (12), driving while intoxicated, underage consumption of liquor (2), obstructing the legal process, disorderly conduct (2), fleeing police in a motor vehicle, felony 4th degree assault, 5th degree assault, and giving police a false name.

Case 4/16/17, shoplifting at Wedge Community Co-op, 2105 Lyndale Ave, cited by squad 510. (17-136655)

Outcome On 9/29/17, this case was dismissed. The following cases were also dismissed: disorderly conduct from 3/14/17; consuming alcohol in public from 4/10/17; theft from 4/12/17; trespassing from 6/28/17; trespassing from 7/19/17. Pled guilty to disorderly conduct from 8/15/16. Sentence: 90 days, with credit for 90 days served. Pled guilty to gross misdemeanor trespassing from 12/6/16. Sentence: 365 days, 275 days stayed for two years, serve 90 days, with credit for 90 days served. Conditions of release: remain law abiding; stay away from Hilton Hotel, 1001 Marquette Ave. Pled guilty to felony domestic assault from 5/17/17. Sentence: 18 months, stayed for three years, with credit for 97 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; no contact with the victim; no use of alcohol or controlled substances; cognitive skill training; domestic abuse counseling / treatment; obtain and maintain employment and / or educational programming; follow all state and federal laws. This sentence was ordered to be served concurrently with the sentence for trespassing above. A stay of imposition for a theft case from 7/10/16 was amended. Sentence: 90 days, with credit for 90 days served.
