- 2 robberies of person – 10/7, noon, at Franklin & Garfield in which a person was robbed of his PlayStation at gunpoint; 10/22, 3:15 p.m., at 110 East 18th St in which a suspect hit a person from behind and robbed him.
- 1 robbery of business – 10/25, 5:20 p.m., at Family Dollar Store, 1816 Nicollet Ave, in which an employee ran after a shoplifter who left the store and was maced by a second suspect outside.
- 1 aggravated assault – 10/15, 12:20 a.m., at 19th & Nicollet in which a male suspect driving a car assaulted a person.

Outcome On 9/30/16, pled guilty to trespassing from 8/18/16; the other four cases were dismissed. Sentence: 90 days, stayed for one year, with credit for 1 day served. Conditions of release: probation to the court; no trespassing; no open bottle charges. \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$78 court fees.

Daryn Deshawn Kennedy (3/8/73) 20 prior convictions in Hennepin County since 1993 for 2nd degree assault with a dangerous weapon (3), violating an order for protection, terroristic threats, felony aiding / abetting 4th degree assault, 5th degree assault, harassing phone calls, attempted robbery, disorderly conduct, aiding / abetting robbery, 2nd degree aggravated robbery, possession of drug paraphernalia (4), 5th degree felony possession of drugs, trespassing (2), and theft.

Case 6/12/16, burglary of dwelling at 1816 Stevens Ave. (16-212425)

Outcome On 10/12/16, pled guilty to 2nd degree burglary of dwelling. Sentence: 30 months, with credit for 120 days served. \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$78 court fees and \$50 fine. Prison release date: 12/12/18.
