

SSCO Community Safety information sheet, November 17, 2016

Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, October 28 to November 17, 2016 (source: Crime Prevention Specialist Chelsea Adams)

- 2 robberies of person: 10/30, 9 p.m., Franklin & Clinton in which a group of male suspects robbed a person of his wallet; 11/10, 12:50 a.m., 19th & Nicollet in which known suspects attempted to rob a person at gunpoint.
- 1 aggravated assault: 10/30, 3:30 a.m., 1801 2nd Ave in which a known suspect stabbed a person.
- 1 business burglary: 10/31, overnight, Twin Cities Wireless, 1841 Nicollet Ave in which the front window of this business was broken out, loss was unknown at the time of report.
- 2 garage burglaries: 11/8, overnight, 1828 Clinton Ave in which unknown suspect(s) kicked open the service door of one garage and rummaged through a vehicle and attempted to break into another garage; no loss was reported.
