

## SSCO Community Safety information sheet, November 19, 2015

### **Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, September 25 to November 11, 2015** (source: Crime Prevention Specialist Chelsea Adams)

- 1 robbery: 10/27, 9 p.m., at Franklin & 1<sup>st</sup> in which two suspects robbed a person at knifepoint.
- 1 theft from person: 11/1, 7 a.m., at 18<sup>th</sup> & Nicollet in which a known suspect stole keys from a person's pocket.
- 10 apartment burglaries: 8/29 at 610 West Franklin Ave for which Dexter Alexander Crockett (11/22/69) has been charged; 9/29 at 116 Groveland Ave in which a suspect who had cut a screen and opened an unlocked window was stopped from entering by a resident; 10/3 at 1920 Stevens Ave in which a suspect cut a screen and entered through an unlocked window; 10/17 at 1816 Stevens Ave in which a suspect who had removed a screen and attempted to enter through an unlocked window was stopped by a resident; 10/27 at 1817 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave in which a suspect with keys entered an apartment; 10/17 at 1912 Stevens Ave in which a suspect entered through a window; 11/4 at 1808 Stevens Ave in which a suspect entered through an open window; 11/4 at 1827 LaSalle Ave in which a suspect entered through an open window; 11/6 at 1825 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave in which a suspect entered through an unlocked door; 11/7 at 1927 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave in which a suspect cut a window screen and smashed a window.

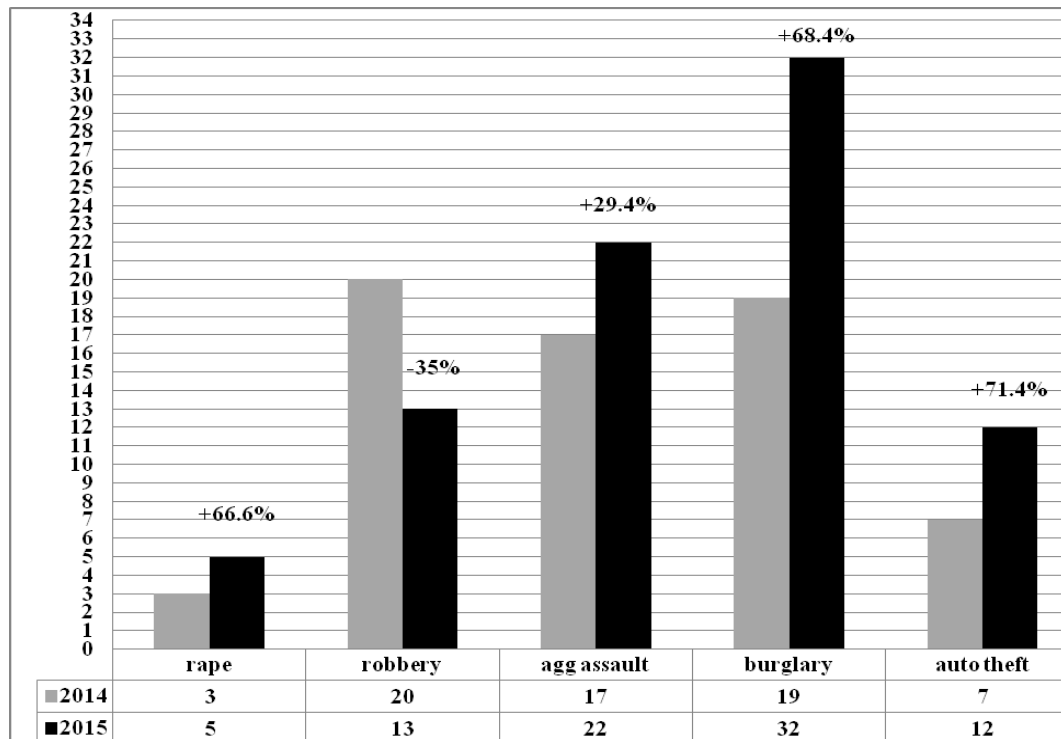

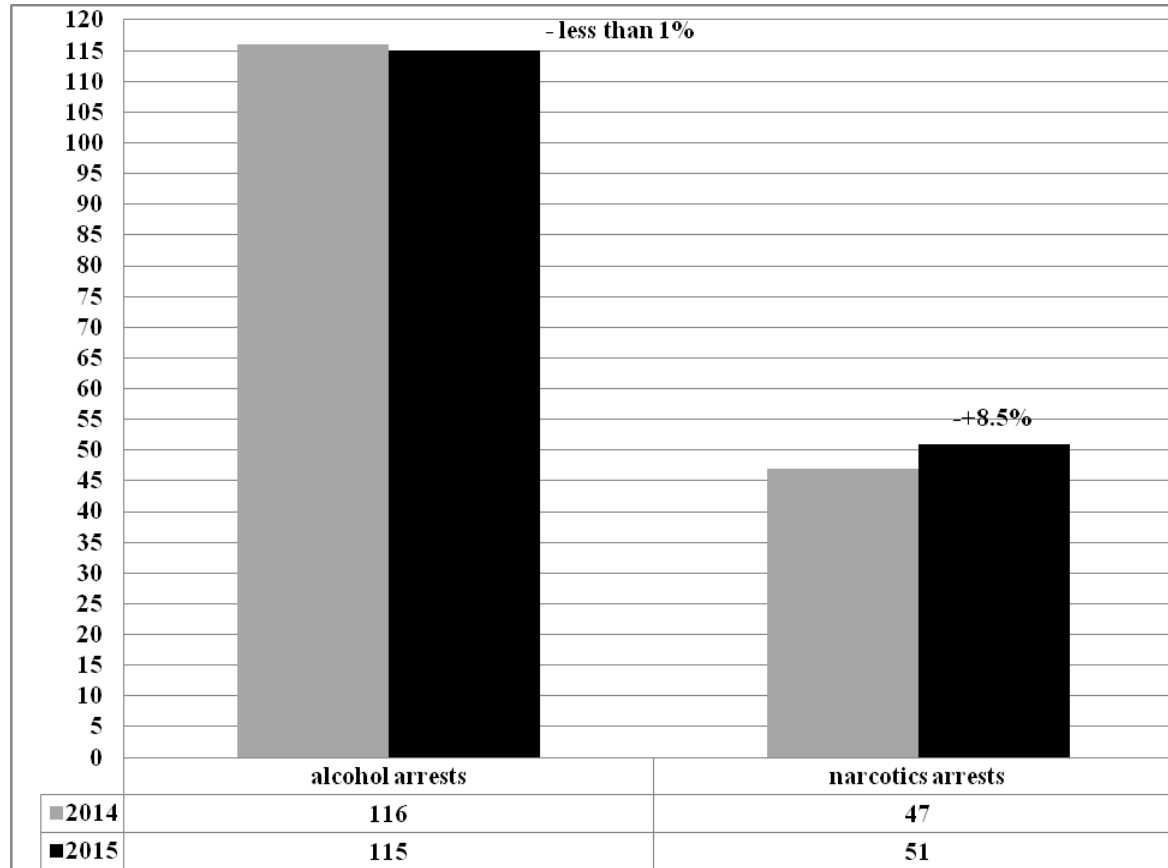

<b>Robert Charles Fleming</b> (4/5/59) Prior conviction in Hennepin County for disorderly conduct.
<b>Case</b> 9/1/15, open bottle in Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave, cited by Park police. (15-330144)
<b>Case</b> 10/2/15, consuming alcohol in public in Stevens Square Park, cited by Park police. (15-370324)
<b>Outcome</b> On 10/5/15, pled guilty to open bottle from 9/1/15. The 10/2/15 case was dismissed. Sentence: 30 days, stayed for one year, with credit for 4 days served. Conditions of release: unsupervised probation; no same or similar offenses; no alcohol offenses. \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$78 court fees.

<b>Omar Abdirahman Ibrahim</b> (1/1/89) 8 prior convictions in Hennepin and Ramsey Counties for driving while intoxicated (3), trespassing, underage consumption of liquor, 1 <sup>st</sup> degree aggravated robbery, 1 <sup>st</sup> degree attempted aggravated robbery, and disorderly conduct.
<b>Case</b> 6/22/15, aggressive panhandling at 24 <sup>th</sup> & 4 <sup>th</sup> , cited by day beat officers. (15-229148)
<b>Case</b> 7/28/15, robbery of person at Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave, arrested by squad 510. (15-281230)
<b>Case</b> 8/25/15, trespassing at LaSalle Community Gardens, 1801 LaSalle Ave, cited by day beat officers. (15-320302)
<b>Case</b> 9/11/15, 5 <sup>th</sup> degree assault at Giant Laundromax, 1922 Clinton Ave, arrested by squad 510. (15-343710)
<b>Outcome</b> On 10/21/15, pled guilty to felony theft from 7/28/15 – the initial robbery charge was amended; the other three cases were dismissed. Sentence: 21 months, with credit for 45 days served. Anticipated release date: 11/7/16.

**Mohamed Ahmed Farah** (1/1/80) 19 prior convictions in Hennepin County for 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault, terroristic threats, fleeing police in a motor vehicle, loitering with intent to solicit, disorderly conduct (5), 5<sup>th</sup> degree felony possession of a controlled substance, driving while intoxicated, open bottle (3), possession of liquor in a park, and trespassing (4).

**Case** 7/19/15, consuming alcohol in public at Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave, arrested by Park police. (15-268187)

**Case** 7/23/15, giving police a false name at Franklin & Nicollet, arrested by squad 510. (15-273520)

**Case** 8/11/15, disorderly conduct at Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave, cited by Park police. (15-301713)

**Outcome** On 10/27/15, failed to appear in court; warrant issued. Arrested for the warrant on 10/28/15. On 10/29/15, pled guilty to disorderly conduct from 8/11; the other two cases were dismissed, along with an interfering with traffic case from 4/24/15. Sentence: 60 days, with credit for 60 days served. Serve 1 day on Sentence to Service in lieu of \$78 court fees. \$50 fine and additional \$75 court fees waived. Also pled guilty to disorderly conduct from 8/1/15. Sentence: 60 days, with credit for 60 days served. Serve 1 day on Sentence to Service in lieu of \$50 fine and \$78 court fees. Additional \$75 court fees waived.

**Rachael Anne O'Gorman** (12/24/76) 2 prior convictions in Itasca County for consumption of alcohol by a minor.

**Case** 10/15/15, trespassing at LaSalle Community Gardens, 1801 LaSalle Ave, cited by day beat officers. (15-386543)

**Outcome** On 10/29/15, failed to appear in court; warrant issued. Arrested for the warrant on 11/13/15. On that day, pled guilty. Sentence: 10 days, stayed for one year. Serve 1 day on Sentence to Service in lieu of \$78 court fees. Additional \$75 court fees waived. Conditions of release: probation to the court; no same or similar offenses; no trespassing; stay a reasonable distance away from 1801 LaSalle Ave.

<b>Ahmed Adan Ali</b> (1/1/80) 21 prior convictions in Minnesota for obstructing the legal process, driving while intoxicated, felony theft of a controlled substance, possession of liquor in a park (3), trespassing (4), motor vehicle theft, consuming alcohol in public (2), giving police a false name, littering, disorderly conduct (2), aggressive panhandling, theft, 5 <sup>th</sup> degree assault, and open bottle.
<b>Case</b> 6/2/15, open bottle, trespassing, and aggressive panhandling at Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave, cited by day beat officers. (15-199661)
<b>Case</b> 6/16/15, open bottle at LaSalle Community Gardens, 1801 LaSalle Ave, cited by day beat officers. (15-220401)
<b>Case</b> 6/22/15, aggressive panhandling at 24 <sup>th</sup> & 4 <sup>th</sup> , cited by day beat officers. (15-229148)
<b>Outcome</b> On 11/3/15, convicted of aggressive panhandling from 6/2/15; the open bottle and trespassing charges were dismissed, along with the other two cases. Sentence: 90 days, 85 days stayed for one year, with credit for 2 days served, serve 3 days on Sentence to Service. Conditions of release: supervised probation; no same or similar offenses; no aggressive panhandling, trespassing, loitering, theft; no alcohol-related offenses; stay away from Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave; complete treatment. \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$75 court fees.

**Sharee Lanette Barrett** (7/10/81, 5 arrests in the area in the past month, 13 prior convictions in Hennepin County) – 9/25/15 open bottle at Franklin & Nicollet; 10/3/15 consuming alcohol in public at Franklin & Nicollet; 10/3/15 theft and trespassing at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave; 10/6/15 theft and trespassing at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave. SSCO asked the court to sentence Barrett to the maximum amount of time in custody if convicted or to restrict her from the area if she is conditionally released.
