- 2 robberies of person: 10/27, 7:45 a.m., at 18<sup>th</sup> & Nicollet in which a person was robbed at knifepoint; 11/6, 7:30 p.m., at 137 East 17<sup>th</sup> St in which a person was robbed by two female suspects who fled in a vehicle.
- 1 theft from person on 11/17, 7 p.m., at Franklin & Nicollet in which a suspect grabbed a plastic bag containing four new iPhones from a person who had just exited from a Metro Transit bus.
- No aggravated assaults.

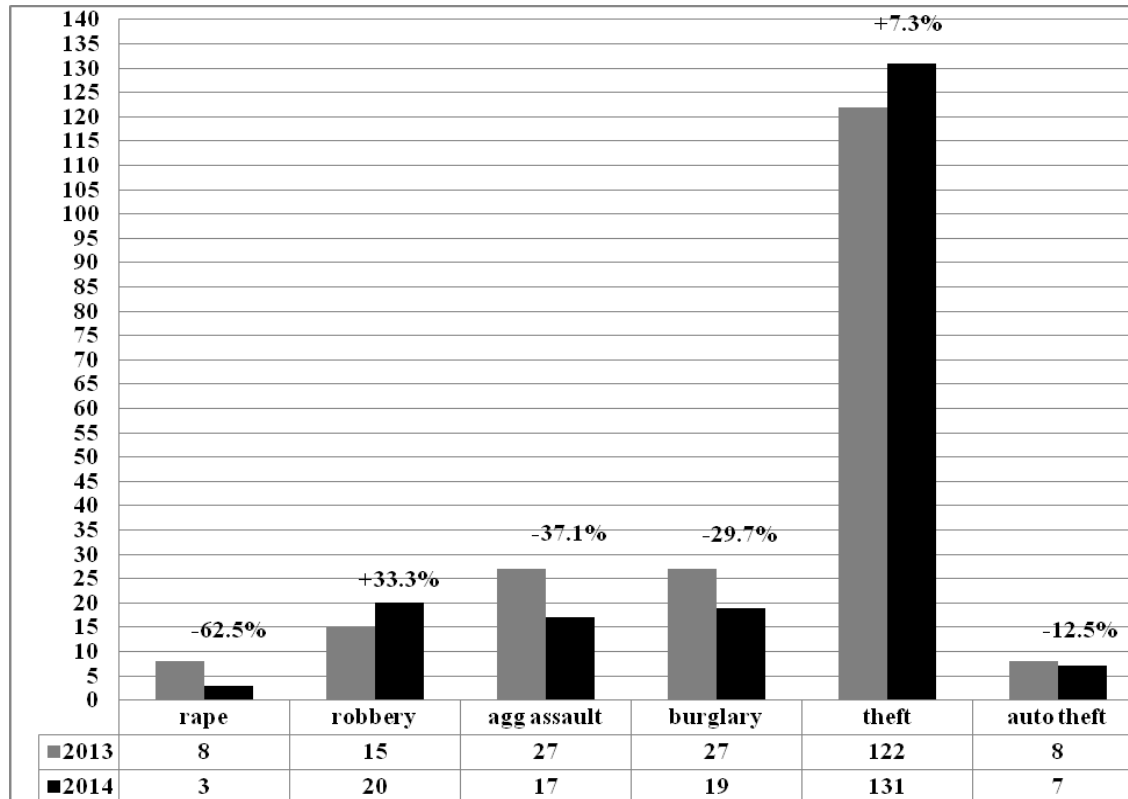

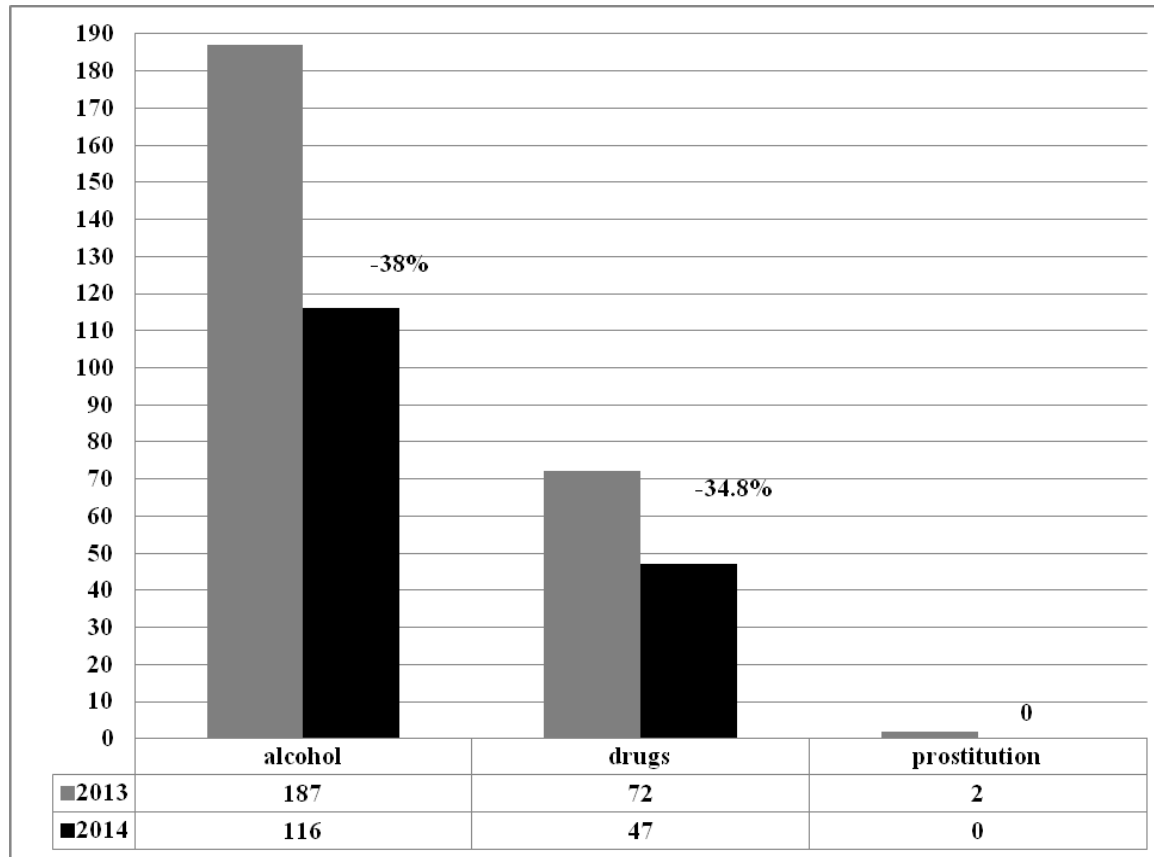

**SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:**

<b><a href="#">Eddie B Joiner</a> (2/7/56)</b> 12 prior convictions in Hennepin County for open bottle (2), disorderly conduct, 5 <sup>th</sup> degree felony possession of a controlled substance (2), 5 <sup>th</sup> degree assault (3), domestic assault, giving police a false name, and consuming alcohol in public (2).
<b>Case</b> 8/7/14, trespassing at 1721 3 <sup>rd</sup> Ave, cited by day beat officers. (14-277365)
<b>Outcome</b> On 11/10/14, pled guilty. Sentence: 30 days, stayed for one year, with credit for 1 day served. Conditions of release: probation to the court; no same or similar offenses; no trespassing; stay a reasonable distance away from 1721 3 <sup>rd</sup> Ave. \$50 fine and \$78 court fees waived as credit for time served. Additional \$75 court fees waived.

**Lavell Love (6/13/63)** 16 arrests in the area in the past ten years. 39 prior convictions in Hennepin County for disorderly conduct (15), trespassing (8), aggressive panhandling, crimes against Metro Transit (2), unlawfully obtaining transit services, open bottle (2), consuming alcohol in public (3), public urination (3), loitering with intent to solicit, aiding/abetting theft from person, domestic assault, and 5<sup>th</sup> degree felony possession of a controlled substance.

**Case** 4/29/14, consuming alcohol in public at 22<sup>nd</sup> & Nicollet, cited by day beat officers. (14-139346)

**Case** 7/16/14, disorderly conduct at Franklin & Nicollet, arrested by squads 580, 510. (14-245860)

**Case** 10/21/14, aggressive panhandling at Starbucks Coffe, 2000 Nicollet Ave, cited by day beat officers. (14-374136)

**Outcome** On 11/4/14, these cases were dismissed. Pled guilty to gross misdemeanor trespassing from 8/6/14; charges of disorderly conduct and unlawfully obtaining transit services were dismissed. Sentenced on 11/14/14: 365 days, stayed for two years, with credit for 40 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; no same or similar offenses; no new arrests; no use of alcohol or controlled substances; chemical dependency evaluation/treatment; complete the Diversion and Recovery Team (DART) program; restricted from 5<sup>th</sup> Precinct Area 2 (LaSalle Ave/Blaisdell Ave to 4<sup>th</sup> Ave, I-94 to 28<sup>th</sup> St). \$50 fine and \$78 court fees waived as credit for one day served. Additional \$75 court fees waived.

**Sentencing judge** – Janet Poston

**Nathaniel Roby (1/1/62)** Level 3 sex offender. 11 arrests in the area in the past seven years. 43 prior convictions in Hennepin County for 3<sup>rd</sup> degree criminal sexual conduct, consuming alcohol in public (6), disorderly conduct, giving police a false name, theft by swindle, failure to notify authorities of changes in predatory offender registration, trespassing (2), aggressive panhandling (3), open bottle (17), public urination (5), loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, possession of drug paraphernalia, interfering with traffic, and criminal contempt of court (2).

**Case** 8/16/14, indecent conduct at Urban League Academy, 2201 Blaisdell Ave, cited by squad 510 (14-288956)

**Case** 10/28/14, public urination at Franklin & Nicollet, cited by squads 506, 508. (14-383646)

**Outcome** On 11/5/14, convicted of gross misdemeanor indecent exposure from 8/16/14. The public urination case was dismissed. Sentence: 365 days, 335 days stayed for two years, serve 30 days on Sentenced to Service in lieu of confinement. Conditions of release: supervised probation; attend Higher Ground daily with verification; comply with HOMES court; attend Spectrum meetings as directed; comply with curfew restrictions, 5 p.m. to 6 a.m.; restricted from 5<sup>th</sup> Precinct Area 2 (LaSalle Ave/Blaisdell Ave to 4<sup>th</sup> Ave, I-94 to 28<sup>th</sup> St). \$50 fine stayed for two years. \$75 court fees waived. Pay an additional \$78 court fees.

**Sentencing judge** – Bruce Peterson
