

SSCO Community Safety information sheet, December 15, 2016

Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, November 18 to December 15, 2016 (source: Crime Prevention Specialist Chelsea Adams)

- 4 robberies of person: 11/20, 7 p.m., at 1900 1st Ave in which a male responding to a backpage.com ad was robbed at gunpoint by a male suspect; 11/24, 4:20 a.m. at 19th & Stevens in which a person wearing headphones was robbed at gunpoint while walking on the sidewalk; 11/26, 3 a.m. at Franklin & LaSalle in which a person driving a car who stopped at a red light was distracted by female suspect and pulled out of the car and assaulted by a male suspect who then stole the person's car; 11/27, 6:30 p.m. at 17th & 1st in which a suspect approached a male who was getting out of his vehicle and then stole the male's phone when he tried to call 91.
- 1 robbery of business: 12/4, 7 p.m. at Net Supermarket, 1845 Nicollet Ave in which a suspect armed with a knife tried – but failed – to rob this business.
- 3 burglaries: storage locker room at 1904 1st Ave on 11/19; laundry room at 1920 3rd Ave on 11/25; 1921 1st Ave on 11/28.
- 3 motor vehicle thefts: 11/20 at Franklin & 1st – recovered on 12/1 on East 18th St with a peeled steering column; 11/28 at 1800 LaSalle Ave; 12/10 at 1707 3rd Ave – recovered the next day at 14th & 1st with the ignition punched and the license plates stolen.
- 1 theft from motor vehicle: 11/18 at 209 East 19th St in which a window was broken and a wallet stolen.
- 4 other incidents of theft.

- David Vincent Brenner (7/5/75) – just added to the list, active in the area where Lyndale and Hennepin merge, east of Stevens Square – Loring Heights, seven cases (indecent exposure, public urination, obstructing the legal process, trespassing) set for review in HOMES Court on 1/3/17.
- Patrick Addy (3/6/77) – released from treatment, not on probation, a case at a business in the neighborhood from 8/1 involving theft, public urination, and gross misdemeanor trespassing set for court on 1/20/17.

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:



Mohamed Hassan Ali (1/1/79) 13 arrests in the area since 2010. 27 prior convictions in Hennepin County for driving while intoxicated, open bottle (3), unlawfully obtaining transit services (3), trespassing (12), criminal vehicular operation, 5th degree criminal sexual conduct, disorderly conduct (3), theft, consuming alcohol in public, and 4th degree assault of a police officer.

Case 9/2/16, giving police false information at LaSalle Community Garden, 1801 LaSalle Ave, cited by Franklin-Nicollet beat officers and squad 8519. (16-320454)

Outcome On 11/23/16, pled guilty. Sentence: 90 days, with 45 days stayed for one year, serve 45 days, with credit for 12 days served, furlough to treatment. Also pled guilty to criminal damage to property from 10/8/16. Sentence: same as the previous case, ordered to be served concurrently. The following cases were dismissed: being in a park after hours and open bottle from 8/5/16; consuming alcohol in public from 9/30/16; being in a park after hours from 10/13/16. Conditions of release: supervised probation; remain law abiding; complete treatment; no use of alcohol or non-prescription drugs. \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$78 court fees. Workhouse release date: 12/10/16.

Farid Yusuf Suleiman (7/4/72) 15 arrests in the area since 2008. 29 prior convictions in Hennepin and Sherburne Counties since 2003 for disorderly conduct (7), theft (2), trespassing (6), domestic assault, possession of liquor in a park, open bottle in a motor vehicle, open bottle (7), obstructing the legal process, motor vehicle theft, 5th degree assault, and criminal damage to property.

Case 5/17/16, gross misdemeanor trespassing at Loring Nicollet Alternative School, 1925 Nicollet Ave, arrested by Franklin-Nicollet beat officers. (16-175849)

Case 7/22/16, consuming alcohol in public at 315 West Franklin Ave, cited by squad 514. (16-266589)

Outcome On 11/23/16, these cases were dismissed. A theft case from 7/27/16 was also dismissed. Pled guilty to gross misdemeanor trespassing from 3/3/16. Sentence: 365 days, stayed for two years. Conditions of release: supervised probation; remain law abiding; comply with HOMES Court. Also pled guilty to consuming alcohol in public from 5/28/16. Sentence: 90 days, stayed for one year, same conditions of release as above.

Darryl Brooks (8/29/64) 52 arrests in the area since 2004. 44 prior convictions in Hennepin County for 5th degree assault (3), open bottle (4), disorderly conduct (6), trespassing (10), loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, consuming alcohol in public (3), theft, loitering with intent to solicit (3), littering (2), possession of drug paraphernalia (2), motor vehicle theft, 5th degree felony possession of a controlled substance, fleeing police on foot, giving police a false name, public urination, interfering with traffic, criminal contempt of court (2), and felony possession of simulated drugs with intent to sell as a controlled substance.

Case 7/19/16, consuming alcohol in public and disorderly conduct at 22nd & Lyndale, cited by squad 510. (16-262503)

Outcome On 12/6/16, pled guilty to open bottle. The disorderly conduct charge was dismissed. Sentence: 90 days, 80 days stayed for one year, serve 10 days, with credit for 4 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; complete chemical dependency assessment and follow recommendations; remain law abiding. \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$78 court fees. Report to the workhouse on 12/13/16. Workhouse release date: 12/15/16.
