

SSCO Community Safety information sheet, December 17, 2015

Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, November 12 to December 17, 2015 (source: Crime Prevention Specialist Chelsea Adams)

- 1 robbery: 12/14, midnight, at Franklin & Nicollet – a Metro Transit case for which further information is not available.
- 2 aggravated assaults: 11/26, 2 a.m., at 1933 Lyndale Ave in which a victim who had been transported to a hospital with non-life threatening stab wounds provided limited information to police and refused to press charges; 12/14, 9:50 p.m., in the parking lot of the Village Center Mall, 1816 Nicollet Ave, in which a male stranger assaulted a person with a dangerous weapon.
- 1 sexual assault: 12/7 in which a female was assaulted by a known male suspect – further information is not available due to Data Privacy laws.
- 2 thefts from motor vehicles: 11/25 to 11/27 in the parking lot behind 203 East 19th St; 12/12 at 18th & 1st in which a bike concealed inside a vehicle was stolen.
- 2 bike thefts: 12/9 at 1811 1st Ave; 12/14 to 12/17 at 1830 Stevens Ave.
- 5 other incidents of theft.
- No burglaries or motor vehicle thefts were reported.

Robert Yellow Wolf (10/29/68) is in custody on \$3,000 bail for gross misdemeanor 5th degree assault, gross misdemeanor 3rd degree riot, and disorderly conduct for an incident at Franklin & Nicollet on 12/10. The case is set for court on 12/18.

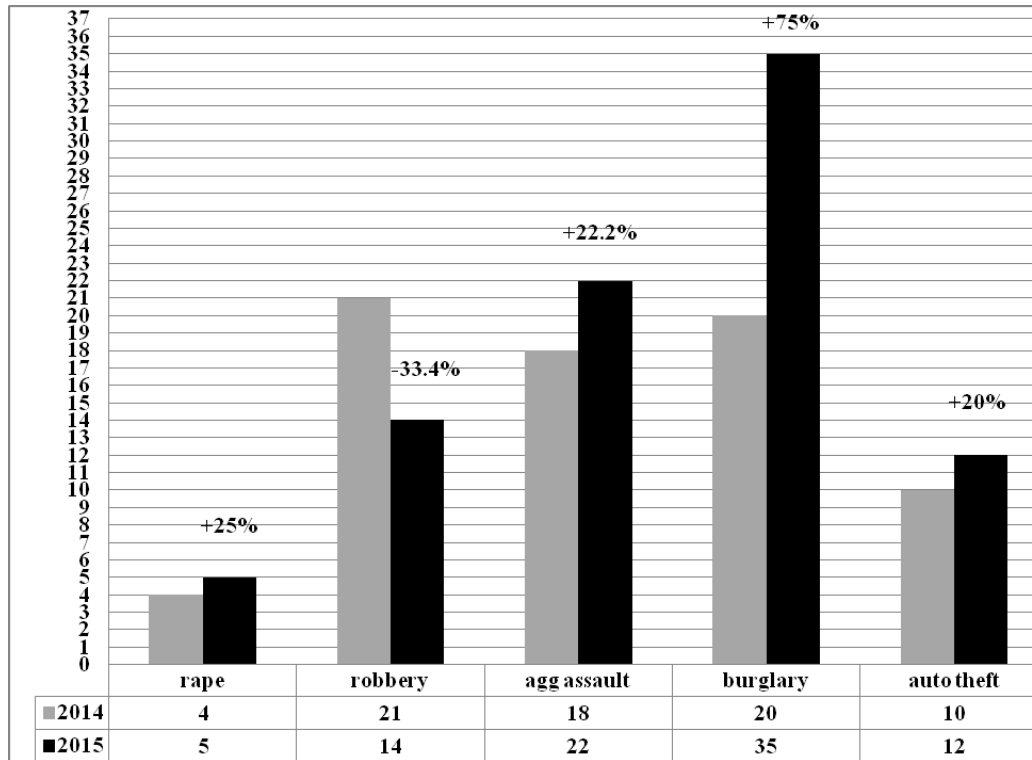

SSCO submitted a community impact statement to the court for the following case:

Patrick Addy (3/6/77, 13 arrests in the area in the past five years, 54 prior convictions in Hennepin County) – 9/2/15 gross misdemeanor trespassing at African Market, 1823 Nicollet Ave. SSCO asked the court to sentence Addy to the maximum amount of time in custody if convicted or to restrict him from the area if he is conditionally released.

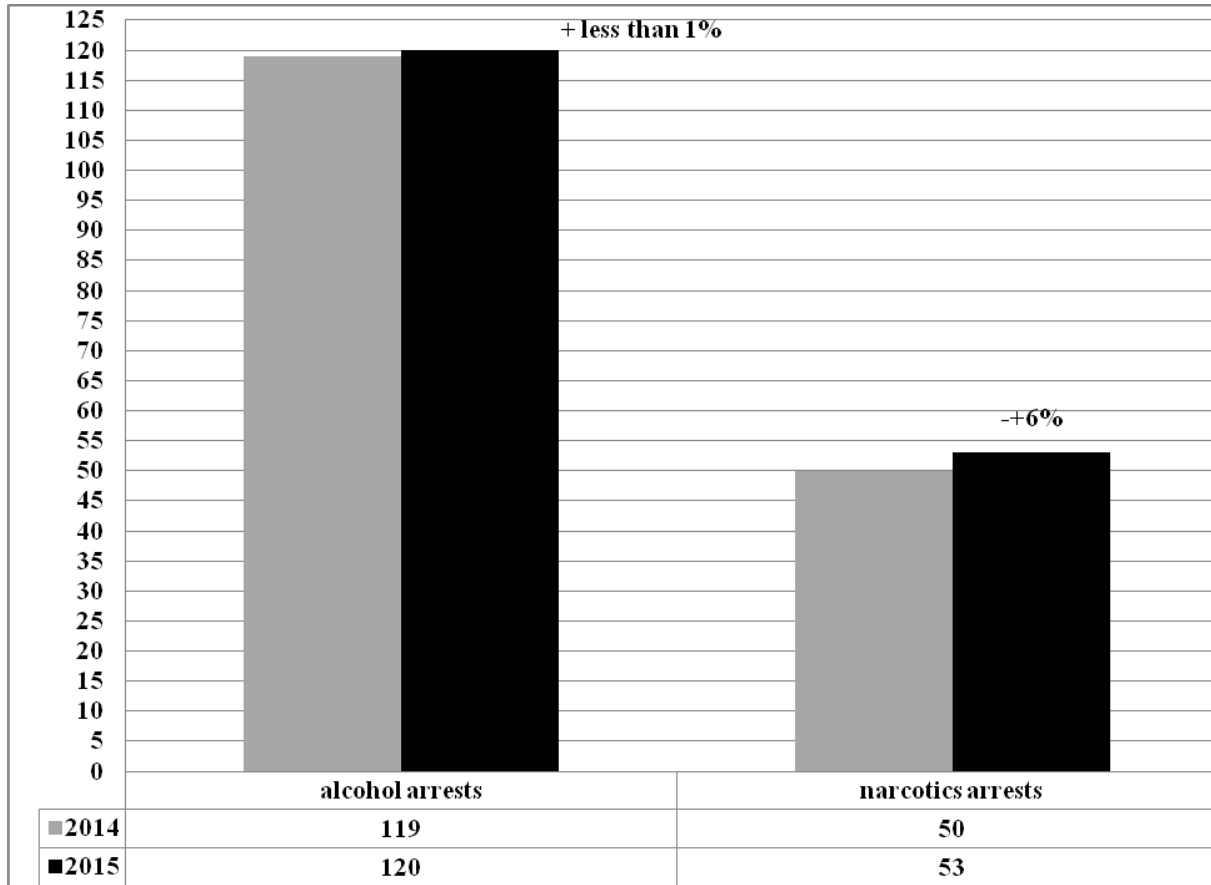

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:



Dahir Yussuf Aden (1/1/82) 39 prior convictions in Minnesota for giving police false information, disorderly conduct (13), open bottle (3), issuing a dishonored check, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, unlawfully obtaining transit services, trespassing (9), aiding / abetting unauthorized use of a motor vehicle, 5th degree assault, possession of liquor in a park (2), consuming alcohol in public, fleeing police on foot, aggressive panhandling, tampering with a motor vehicle, and giving police a false name (2).

Case 9/15/15, aggressive panhandling at the BP Service Station, 2000 3rd Ave, cited by squad 561. (15-349063)

Outcome On 11/20/15, this case was dismissed. Pled guilty to disorderly conduct from 9/4/15. Sentence: 90 days, stayed for one year, with credit for 6 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; no same or similar offenses; no disorderly conduct; chemical dependency evaluation / treatment. \$75 court fees waived. Pay an additional \$78 court fees.

Update on 8/4/15 incident:

The name of the suspect in the 8/4 robbery, kidnapping, and sexual assault incident on the 1800 block of 2nd Ave has been released:

Mohamed (or Mohammed) Ali Elmi (1/1/90). Elmi, who has been in custody since 8/5 on \$500,000 bail, has been charged with three counts of 1st degree criminal sexual conduct, two counts of 1st degree aggravated robbery, and one count of kidnapping. The case goes to trial on 1/19/16. Elmi was on supervised release from prison for 1st degree burglary when the incident occurred and is being held without bail for violating parole.
