

SSCO Community Safety information sheet, December 18, 2014

Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, November 21 to December 18, 2014 (source: Crime Prevention Specialist Chelsea Adams)

- 2 sexual assaults: reports are restricted, both involved acquaintances of some sort, not strangers.
- 2 robberies of person: 12/5, 6 p.m., at Franklin & 1st in which one of three suspects punched a person who was walking and texting, demanded the person's phone, and threatened to assault her if she did not comply; 12/17, 4 a.m., 18th & Stevens in which a person set up a meeting with someone at this location and time, suspects appeared instead and assaulted the person and stole unlisted items.
- 1 aggravated assault: 11/26, 6 a.m., 1827 LaSalle Ave in which two extremely intoxicated persons who were acquainted got into a fight, severely cut each other with broken glass, and were transported to a hospital.
- 3 burglaries: 11/23 – 25, 1926 Pleasant Ave in which two bikes were stolen from an underground garage; 12/4, overnight at an apartment in 1707 3rd Ave, no sign of forced entry; 12/4 – 7, 600 West Franklin Ave in which an unknown suspect forced entry to a storage unit and took unlisted items.
- 1 motor vehicle theft: 12/17, 18th & 3rd, in which an unknown suspect stole a vehicle which was parked on the street – the passenger side door was unlocked due to a key being broken off inside the lock.
- 9 other incidents of theft.

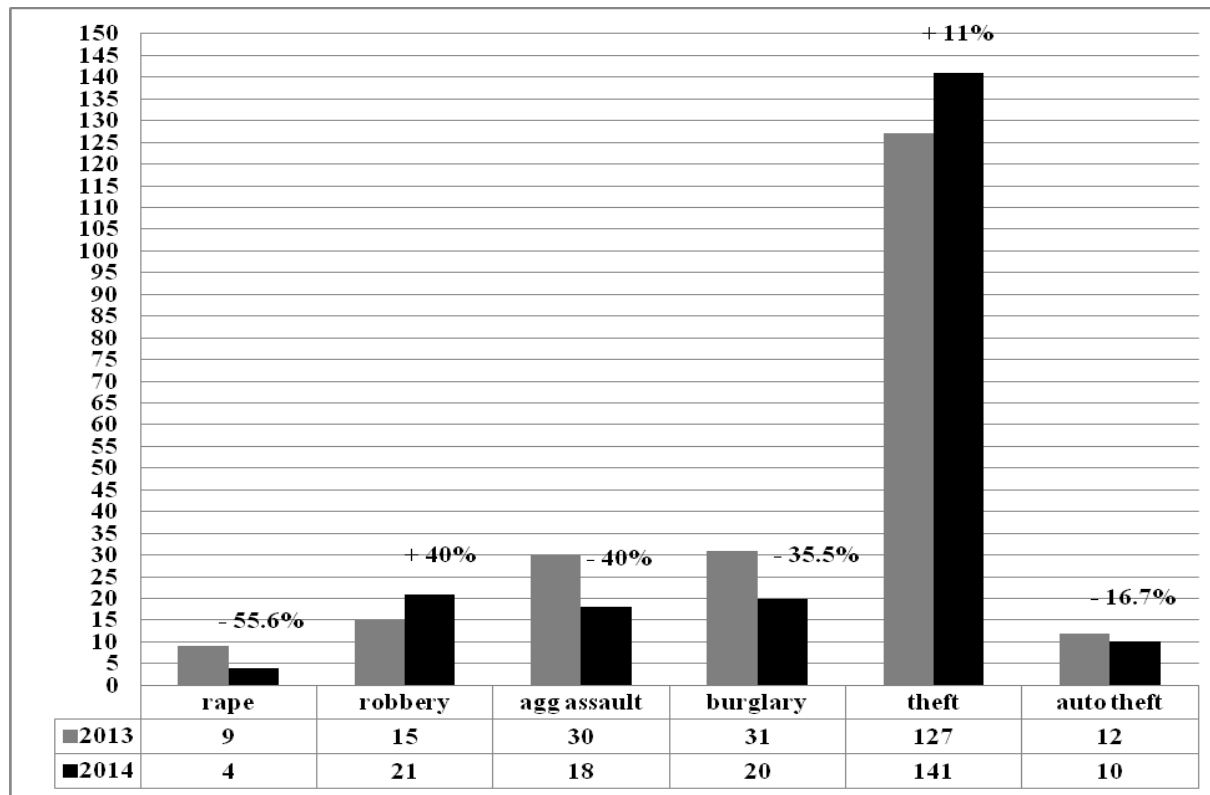

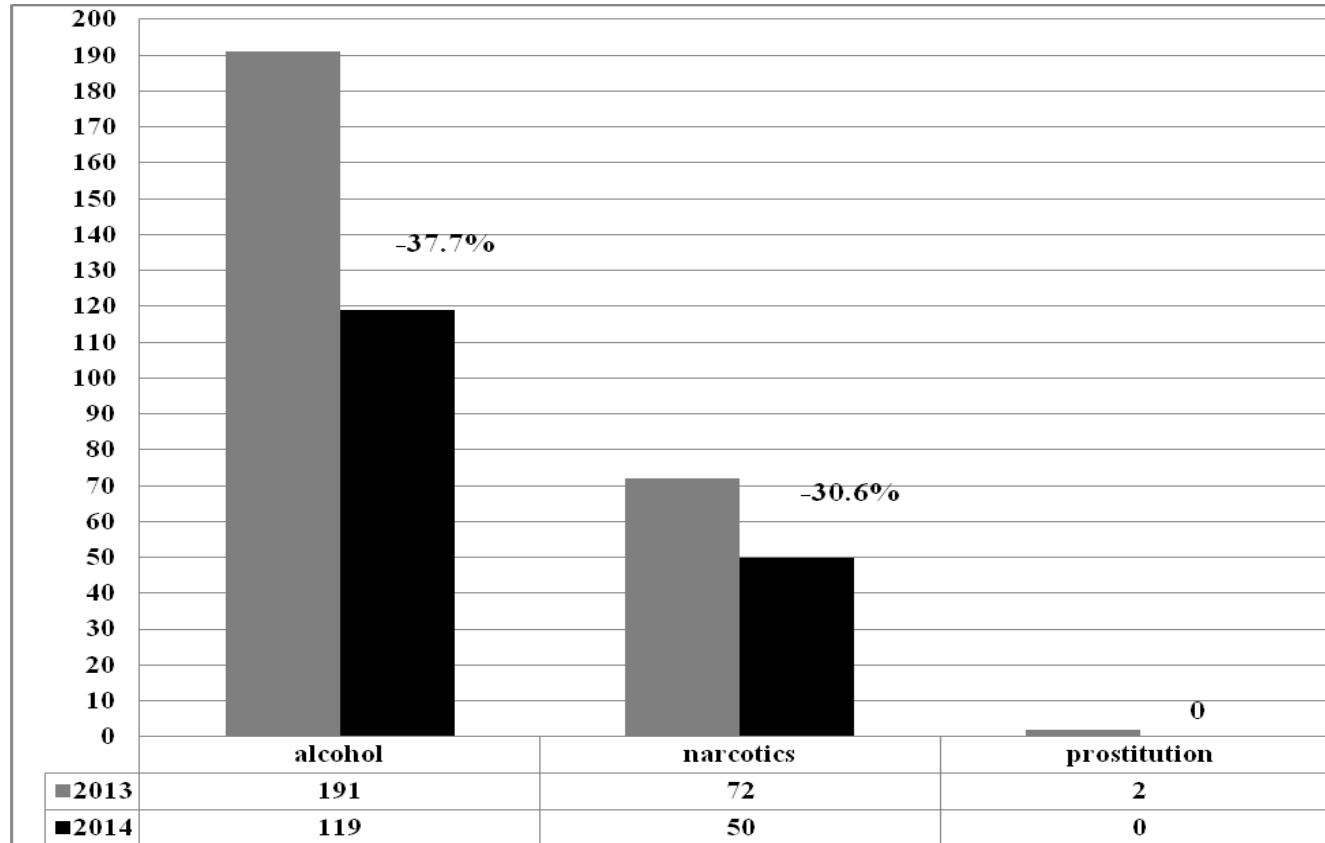

| Case 9/18/14, gross misdemeanor 4 th degree assault motivated by bias, 5 th degree assault, disorderly conduct at Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave, arrested by Park police. (14-331975) |
| Outcome On 11/24/14, pled guilty to 5 th degree assault. The other charges were dismissed. Sentence: 90 days, 85 days stayed for one year, serve 5 days, with credit for 5 days served, perform 24 hours of community work service. Conditions of release: supervised probation; no same or similar offenses; no assault; no disorderly conduct; no use of alcohol and controlled substances; no theft; no lurking with intent to commit a crime; no open bottle; no consuming alcohol in public. \$50 fine stayed for one year. \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$78 court fees. |

Case 11/18/14, trespassing at St Stephen's Human Services, 2309 Nicollet Ave, arrested by a day beat officer. (14-470327)

Outcome On 12/1/14, pled guilty. Sentenced on 12/5/14: 90 days, 72 days stayed for one year, serve 18 days, with credit for 18 days served. Conditions of release: probation to the court; no disorderly conduct; no trespassing; stay away from St Stephen's Human Services, 2309 Nicollet Ave. \$50 fine stayed for one year. \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$78 court fees.

Sentencing judge – Jay Quam
