- Sharee Barrett (7/10/81) is in prison for 3rd degree burglary from 9/24/16 at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave, until 3/8, and then is on parole until 2/7/19.
- Corey Harges (12/27/90) is in jail for felony escape from custody – he failed to return to the workhouse to serve four days remaining on his current sentences for robbery and theft; on 2/23.
- Rachael O'Gorman (12/24/76) will complete her sentence for trespassing at Plymouth Church, 1900 Nicollet Ave, from 9/1/17 and be released from the workhouse – another trespassing case from 11/25/17 at Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave, is set for court on 2/28.
- David Brenner (7/5/75) is on supervised probation for open bottle from 7/20/17 and trespassing from 9/25/17.

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:



Kenneth Charles Bellanger (6/2/55) Arrested in the area 10 times since 2009. 85 prior convictions in Minnesota for unauthorized use of a motor vehicle, robbery, motor vehicle theft, disorderly conduct (12), disorderly house, theft (20), 5th degree assault, trespassing (23), consuming alcohol in public (3), public urination (2), obstructing the legal process, domestic assault, open bottle (6), giving police a false name (8), aggressive panhandling, criminal damage to property, riding public transit without paying the fare, and unlawful smoking.

Case 11/9/17, giving police a false name at Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave, cited by squad 562. (17-431584)

Outcome On 12/5/17, this case was dismissed. Pled guilty to giving police a false name from 11/19/17. Sentence: 90 days, with credit for 7 days served. No work release. No electronic home monitoring. \$75 court fees waived. Additional \$78 court fees deemed uncollectible. Released from the workhouse on 1/26/18.

Dashon James Johnson (3/12/95) 2 prior convictions in Hennepin County for tampering with a motor vehicle and unlawful smoking.

Case 8/24/17, motor vehicle theft (MPD bait vehicle) at 1920 LaSalle Ave, arrested by squads 122, 110. (17-321826)

Outcome On 1/16/18, this case was dismissed. Pled guilty to theft from 4/4/17. Sentence: 90 days, with credit for 90 days served. The defendant's probation was revoked for a 2nd degree burglary, theft, and 5th degree drug possession case from 4/9/17. Amended sentence: 365 days, with credit for 214 days served. The defendant's probation was also revoked for a motor vehicle theft case from 4/19/17. Amended sentence: 15 months, with credit for 211 days served. The two sentences were ordered to be served concurrently. Prison release: 6/18/18.

Case 1/14/17, murder at 2101 3rd Ave. (17-016800)

Outcome Pled guilty to 2nd degree unintentional murder on 12/12/17. Sentenced on 2/16/18: 110 months, with credit for 399 days served. Prison release date: 2/21/23
