

SSCO Community Safety information sheet, February 23, 2017

Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, January 27 to February 23, 2017 (source: Crime Prevention Specialist Chelsea Adams)

- 1 aggravated robbery of person: 2/12, midnight, at 1912 3rd Ave in which a female victim was robbed at gunpoint by a male suspect outside this apartment building.
- 1 aggravated assault: 2/1, 3:40 p.m., at Franklin & Lyndale in which a male suspect became non-compliant while an officer assisted him out of the roadway – the suspect kicked and bit the officer and spit on the officer, paramedics, and Fire department responders. Gustavo James Best (5/27/89) was charged with felony 4th degree assault of a police officer and is in jail on \$20,000 bail pending a court appearance on 4/17.
- 4 burglaries: 1/29 and 2/16 at MetroPCS, 1812 Nicollet Ave; 2/6 at 1700 3rd Ave which is under construction and not occupied; 2/14 at 1915 1st Ave in which officers responded to an apartment burglary and domestic assault – a 23-year-old male was arrested.
- 4 motor vehicle thefts: 2/11 at 1827 Nicollet Ave in which a suspect, who found keys to a vehicle, stole it; 2/11 to 2/16 at 242 West Franklin Ave in which a possibly unlocked vehicle parked in a lot at this apartment building, with a spare key in the glove box, was stolen – the vehicle was recovered by police on 2/17 on the 3300 block of Knox Ave North and a 19-year-old male and a 16-year-old male were arrested; 2/21 at 516 West Franklin Ave in which a suspect, who found keys to a vehicle, stole it; 2/16 to 2/19 at 102 East 19th St in which a vehicle parked on the street was stolen.
- 1 theft from motor vehicle: 2/17 at 1728 2nd Ave in which a purse and electronics were stolen.
- 2 shoplifting incidents: 1/27 and 2/19 at Family Dollar Store, 1816 Nicollet Ave.
- 3 other incidents of theft.

No Part 1 (serious) crime numbers are available yet for January.

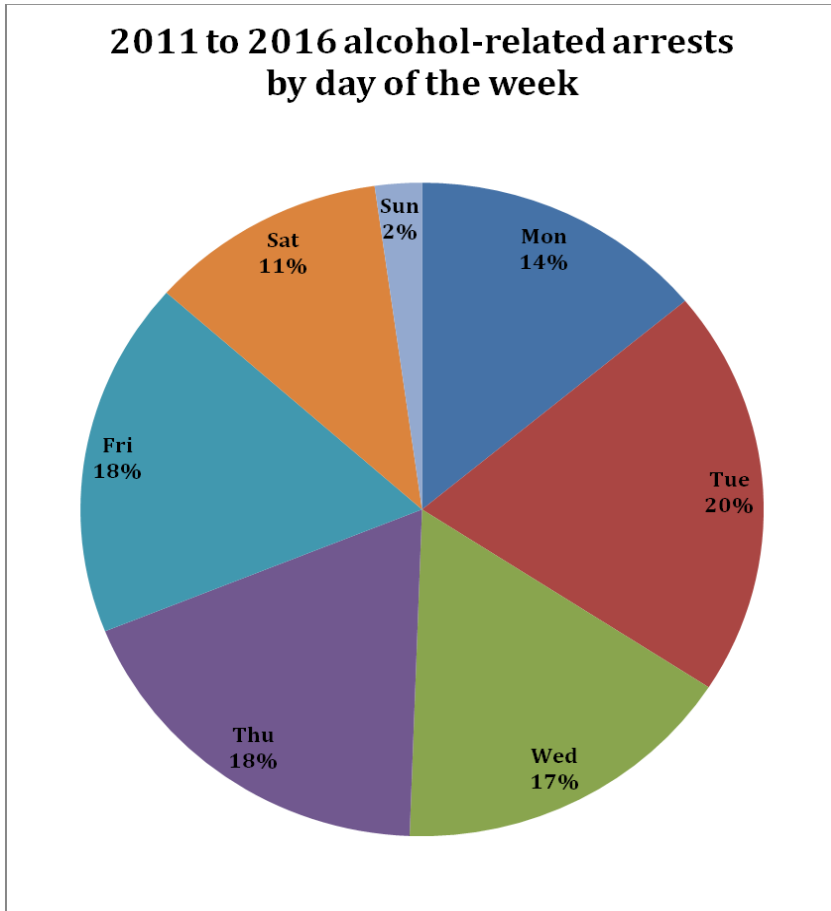

SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:



Ahmed Hassan Ali (1/1/73) 4 arrests in the area in the past seven months. 5 prior convictions in Hennepin County in 2016 for consuming alcohol in a park, disorderly conduct (2), unlawful assembly, and trespassing.

Case 11/17/16, carrying a weapon without a permit at 1801 Nicollet Ave, arrested by Franklin Nicollet beat officers and squads 510 and 514. (16-416061)

Outcome On 12/30/16, this case was dismissed. Pled guilty to obstructing the legal process from 12/28/16. Sentence: 90 days, stayed for one year, with credit for 3 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; no same or similar offenses; no obstructing; no disorderly conduct; chemical dependency evaluation / treatment. \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$78 court fees.

James Joseph King (10/24/83) 2 prior convictions in Washington and Ramsey Counties for disorderly conduct and theft.

Case 1/27/16, 3rd degree felony possession of drugs and 5th degree felony possession of drugs at 1900 Clinton Ave, arrested by Southwest Hennepin Drug Task Force. (HCSO 16-000908)

Outcome On 9/8/16, pled guilty to 3rd degree felony possession of drugs, 3 or more grams of cocaine / heroin/ methamphetamine; the 5th degree felony possession charge was dismissed. Sentenced on 12/20/16: 21 months in prison, stayed for 3 years, serve 45 days in the workhouse, with credit for 6 days served. Report to the workhouse on 1/24/17. Serve as home detention / electronic monitoring (with the 50-mile radius restriction waived), if eligible, with furloughs to take children to and from school. Conditions of release: supervised probation; follow all state and federal criminal laws; no use of alcohol or controlled substances; complete chemical assessment and follow recommendations; complete cognitive skills training; obtain employment or pursue educational training. \$50 fine and \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$78 court fees.

Shane Michael Svobada (a.k.a. Shannon Michael Svoboda, 6/8/81) 7 prior convictions in Minnesota for theft from person, domestic assault (2), theft, trespassing, terroristic threats, and disorderly conduct.

Case 12/29/16, 5th degree assault at the Village Center Mall, 1816 Nicollet Ave, arrested by squad 514. (16-465590)

Case 1/3/17, trespassing at Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave, cited by squad 510. (17-002569)

Outcome On 1/30/17, pled guilty to misdemeanor 5th degree assault from 12/29/16; the 1/3/17 trespassing case was dismissed. Sentence: 90 days, 60 days stayed for one year, serve 30 days concurrently with the sentence below, with credit for 10 days served. Conditions of release: probation to the court; no contact with victim(s); no assault. Also pled guilty to misdemeanor 5th degree assault from 8/28/15; additional charges of trespassing, disorderly conduct, and gross misdemeanor 5th degree assault were dismissed. Sentence: same as above, to be served concurrently. Conditions of release: same as above. Workhouse release: 2/8/17
