

## SSCO Community Safety information sheet, February 25, 2016

---

### Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, January 29 to February 25, 2016 (source: Crime Prevention Specialist Chelsea Adams)

- 1 aggravated assault: 2/7, 2:45 a.m., at Franklin & Clinton in which a driver brandished a gun and ordered a pedestrian to get into his vehicle – the pedestrian yelled for help, called 911 on a phone provided by a passerby, and then fled from the area.
- 1 laundry room burglary: 2/4 at 1810 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave.
- 1 motor vehicle theft: 2/2 at 1800 Stevens Ave, perhaps involving lost keys belonging to the owner.
- 1 theft from motor vehicle: 2/4 at 1826 LaSalle Ave.
- 3 other incidents of theft.
- No robberies, sexual assaults, home burglaries, or shoplifting incidents were reported.

### CLEAN list update, January 29 to February 25 (source: Community Attorney Nikki Appelbaum)

- **David Omurwa** and **Nathaniel Roby** are doing well on supervised probation and have not reoffended.
- There is a bench warrant out for the arrest of **Mohamed Ahmed Farah**, who has been charged for an incident involving the assault of a student at Loring Nicollet Alternative School. Farah has been prohibited from being within a three-block radius of the school.
- **Robert Yellow Wolf** is set for court on 4/25 for a felony assault which occurred at Franklin & Nicollet.
- **Ahmed Abdi Hired**, who is in custody on \$30,000 bail, was scheduled for court today for a felony domestic assault in St Louis Park.
- **Jules Chomilo** is in jail for a probation violation plus two new cases.
- **Dahir Yussuf Aden** is on supervised probation for gross misdemeanor trespassing at the Mall of America.
- **Ellery Charging Thunder** is in the workhouse until 5/29 for gross misdemeanor trespassing.
- **Harry Left Bear** is ordered to report to the workhouse on 3/3 to serve part of a sentence for gross misdemeanor trespassing, and will serve 365 days if he fails to report.
- **Lavell Love** is set for court on 3/9 for violating his conditions of release – he is restricted from the area.

### Update on 8/4/15 incident:

**Mohamed (or Mohammed) Ali Elmi** (1/1/90) is charged with kidnapping, three counts of 1<sup>st</sup> degree criminal sexual conduct, and two counts of 1<sup>st</sup> degree aggravated robbery for an incident on the 1800 block of 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave on 8/4/15. Elmi is in custody on \$1,000,000 bail plus a Department of Corrections hold without bail – he was on supervised release from prison at the time of this incident. Elmi has been in custody since 8/5/15; a pretrial hearing is set for 4/8 and a jury trial is scheduled for 5/31.

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

**SSCO submitted a community impact statement to the court for the following cases:**

**Sharee Barrett** (7/10/81, 9 arrests in the area during a three-month period in 2015, 13 prior convictions in Hennepin County) – 9/25/15 open bottle at Franklin & Nicollet; 10/3/15 consuming alcohol in public at Franklin & Nicollet; 10/3/15 theft and trespassing at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave; 10/6/15 theft and trespassing at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave; 11/16/15 open bottle at Franklin & Nicollet; 12/5/15 trespassing at Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave; 12/12/15 3<sup>rd</sup> degree burglary at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave. SSCO asked the court to sentence Barrett to the maximum amount of time in custody or to restrict her from the area if she is conditionally released.

**SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:**



**Ellery Reginald Charging Thunder** (2/20/54) 22 arrests in the area since 2004. 34 prior convictions in Hennepin County for interfering with traffic (3), obstructing the sidewalk, criminal damage to property, theft, disorderly conduct, consuming alcohol in public (7), open bottle (2), carrying weapons, domestic assault (2), trespassing (13), interfering with the operator of a transit vehicle, and aggressive panhandling.

**Case** 8/21/15, consuming alcohol in public at Franklin & Nicollet, cited by day beat officers. (15-315416)

**Outcome** On 1/19/16, this case was dismissed along with the following cases: two separate trespassing cases from 8/14/15; fare evasion and open bottle from 9/4/15; interfering with traffic from 11/3/15; open bottle from 11/12/15; open bottle from 1/6/16. Pled guilty to gross misdemeanor trespassing from 9/5/15. Sentence: 365 days, 185 days stayed for two years, serve 180 days, with credit for 16 days served. Report to the workhouse on 2/2/16. Conditions of release: supervised probation; chemical dependency assessment; furlough to treatment or aftercare; no trespassing; no loitering; no open bottle; stay a reasonable distance away from a certain address. Pay \$78 court fees. Additional \$75 court fees waived. Failed to report to the workhouse on 2/2; warrant issued. Arrested for the warrant on 2/7. Workhouse release date: 5/29/16.

**Dahir Yusuf Aden** (1/1/85) 4 arrests in the area in 2015. 39 prior convictions in Minnesota for giving police false information, disorderly conduct (13), open bottle (3), issuing a dishonored check, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, unlawfully obtaining transit services, trespassing (9), aiding / abetting unauthorized use of a motor vehicle, 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault, possession of liquor in a park (2), consuming alcohol in public, fleeing police on foot, aggressive panhandling, tampering with a motor vehicle, and giving police a false name (2).

**Case** 9/15/15, disorderly conduct at Fair Oaks Park, 2200 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave, cited by Park police. (15-348364)

**Case** 9/24/15, consuming alcohol in public at Fair Oaks Park, 2200 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave, cited by Park police. (15-359851)

**Outcome** On 2/22/16, these cases were dismissed. Pled guilty to gross misdemeanor trespassing at the Mall of America in Bloomington. Sentence: 180 days, 161 days stayed for two years, serve 19 days, with credit for 19 days served. Conditions of release: probation to the court; no same or similar offenses; stay away from Mall of America; no trespassing. \$75 court fees waived. Pay \$50 fine and additional \$78 court fees.
