- Sharee Barrett (7/10/81) is out of prison and on parole until 2/7/19 for 3rd degree burglary at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave. She is in a work release program.
- Armondo Day (10/5/74) is being screened for participation in HOMES Court and has two trespassing cases from Starbucks, 2000 Nicollet Ave, pending.
- Ahmed Abdi Hired (1/1/86) is still in Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) custody.
- Rachael O'Gorman (12/24/76) has an active bench warrant for failing to appear in court for a trespassing case from Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave.

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

Melvin Dickerson (7/3/66) 18 prior convictions in Hennepin County since 1985 for attempted 4th degree criminal sexual conduct, aggravated robbery using a dangerous weapon, 3rd degree assault causing substantial bodily harm, 2nd degree assault with a dangerous weapon, disorderly conduct (2), criminal damage to property, attempted theft from person, possession / sale of a small amount of marijuana, disorderly conduct, 5th degree felony possession of a controlled substance (2), domestic assault (2), possession of drug paraphernalia, aggressive panhandling, open bottle, and open bottle in a motor vehicle.

Case 5/29/17, 4th degree felony assault of a police officer causing demonstrable bodily harm, trespassing, and open bottle at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave, arrested by Franklin Nicollet beat officers. (17-196087)

Outcome On 3/12/18, pled guilty to 4th degree felony assault of a police officer causing demonstrable bodily harm. Sentence: 366 days, stayed for one year, with credit for 33 days served. Conditions of release: probation to the court; remain law abiding. Pay \$78 court fees. Additional \$75 court fees waived.

Jason Dan Tarnowski (10/31/75) 7 prior convictions in Hennepin and Sherburne Counties since 2015 for aggressive panhandling, open bottle (2), and trespassing (4).

Case 12/19/17, shoplifting at Wedge Community Co-op, 2105 Lyndale Ave, cited by Franklin Nicollet beat officers. (17-478035)

Outcome On 3/1/18, this case was dismissed. Pled guilty to disorderly conduct from 2/24/18. Sentenced on 3/13/18: 90 days, 84 days stayed for one year, serve 6 days, with credit for 6 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; no same or similar offenses; no assault; no disorderly conduct; no interfering with 911 calls; no violation of orders for protection and no contact orders; no use of alcohol or controlled substances; no theft; stay away from Wedge Community Co-op; domestic abuse counseling / treatment; psychological evaluation / treatment. Serve one day of sentence-to-service in lieu of \$78 fine. Pay \$78 court fees. Additional \$75 court fees waived.
