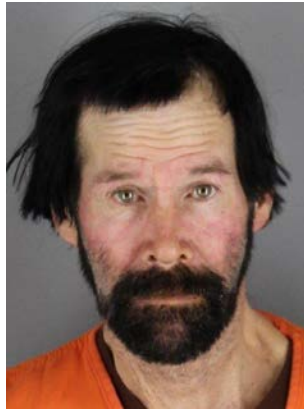
Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:



Herman Walter Rusch (2/11/62) Rusch has 87 prior convictions in Minnesota since 1997 for possession of liquor in a park (2), theft (21), consuming alcohol in public (9), disorderly conduct (16), trespassing (20), obstructing the legal process, terroristic threats, open bottle (9), aggressive panhandling, vagrancy (2), 5th degree assault (2), possession of drug paraphernalia, negligent fire, and littering.

Case 12/13/16, gross misdemeanor trespassing at Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave, arrested by Franklin Nicollet beat officers. (16-446524)

Case 1/2/17, gross misdemeanor trespassing at Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave. (17-001510)

Outcome On 2/27/17, pled guilty to the case from 12/13/16. The case from 1/2/17 was dismissed. Sentence: 365 days, 335 days stayed for two years, serve 30 days, with credit for 17 days served. Conditions of release: probation to the court; no assault; no disorderly conduct; no trespassing; stay away from Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave. Pay \$78 court fees. Pled guilty to 5th degree assault from 12/16/16. Sentence: 30 days, 20 days stayed for two years, serve 10 days, with credit for 10 days served. Same conditions of release as above. Pled guilty to disorderly conduct from 2/27/17; a 5th degree assault charge was dismissed. Sentence: 30 days, 20 days stayed for two years, serve 10 days, with credit for 10 days served. Same conditions of release as above. All three of these sentences were ordered to be served concurrently. Released from the workhouse on 3/5/17.

Sentencing judge – Mark Wernick



Jane Marie Bringsthem (2/25/57) 19 arrests in the area since 2007. 50 prior convictions in Hennepin County since 1992 for driving while intoxicated (3), consuming alcohol in public (10), giving police false information, indecent conduct, open bottle (15), trespassing (7), public urination (6), liquor in a park (3), riding public transit without paying the fare, 5th degree assault, obstructing the legal process, and interfering with traffic.

Case 3/4/17, consuming alcohol in public at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave, cited by Franklin Nicollet beat officers. (17-077305)

Outcome On 3/8/17, pled guilty to misdemeanor consuming alcohol in public. The conviction was then deemed a petty misdemeanor pursuant to State law regarding rules of criminal procedure. The defendant was ordered to serve 1 day of Sentence to Service in lieu of a \$50 fine and \$78 court fees.

Rachael Anne O'Gorman (12/24/76) 6 arrests in the area in the past two years. 3 prior convictions in Hennepin County for consuming alcohol in public, trespassing, and open bottle.

Case 4/30/16, consuming alcohol in public in Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave, cited by Park police. (16-152176)

Outcome On 9/21/16, failed to appear in court; warrant issued. Arrested for the warrant on 9/26/16. On 10/5/16, failed to appear in court; warrant issued. Arrested for the warrant on 10/6/16. On 11/2/16, failed to appear in court; warrant issued. Arrested for the warrant on 11/4/16. On 3/7/17, failed to appear in court; warrant issued. Arrested for the warrant on 3/9/17. On 3/14/17, pled guilty. Sentence: 90 days, stayed for one year, with credit for 32 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; no loitering; no same or similar offenses; treatment at Bell Hill for six months. \$75 court fees waived. Additional \$78 court fees deemed uncollectible.
