Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, February 27 to March 26, 2015 (source: Crime Prevention Specialist Chelsea Adams)

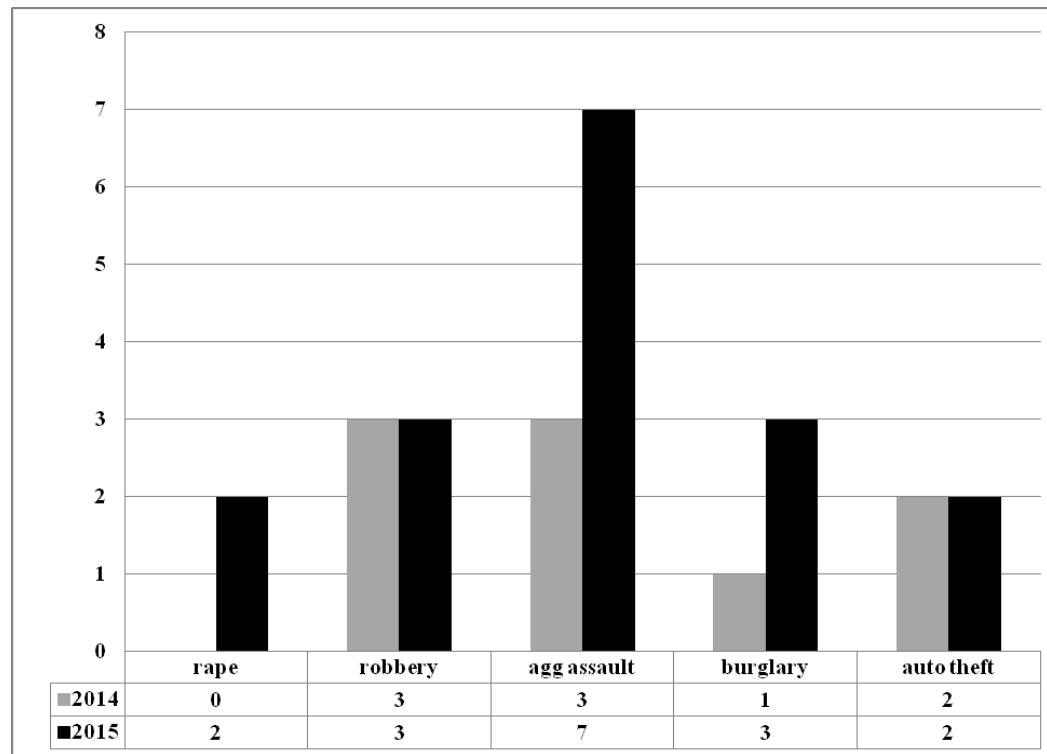
- 1 sexual assault: 2/17, involving a suspect known to the victim, under investigation.
- 2 robberies of person: 3/1, 9:40 p.m., at 18th & 2nd in which a suspect believed to be armed with a gun robbed a person riding a bike; 3/9, 2:45 a.m., in which two suspects robbed and assaulted a person who was walking home from a bar.
- 1 aggravated assault: 3/20, 10:50 p.m., in the parking lot at 1922 Clinton Ave in which shots were fired which damaged Cala Fry & Grill. A person was injured – although not by gunshots – and transported to a hospital. The incident is under investigation.
- 2 burglaries: 3/14 to 3/21, laundry room at 1901 Stevens Ave; 3/24, 3:35 p.m., at an apartment in 1806 LaSalle Ave in which a resident confronted a suspect in the kitchen, struggled with him, and took the suspect's wallet – containing an i.d. – from the suspect's pocket.
- 1 motor vehicle theft: 3/4, 6:45 p.m., at 1915 2nd Ave in which an unknown suspect stole a food delivery vehicle which was left unlocked and running – the vehicle was recovered on 3/6 at 18th & 3rd.
- 2 thefts from motor vehicle: 3/4 at 1930 Clinton Ave in which a suspect broke a window and stole a phone; 3/20 in a shared garage at 441 Ridgewood Ave in which an unknown suspect broke a window and took unlisted items.

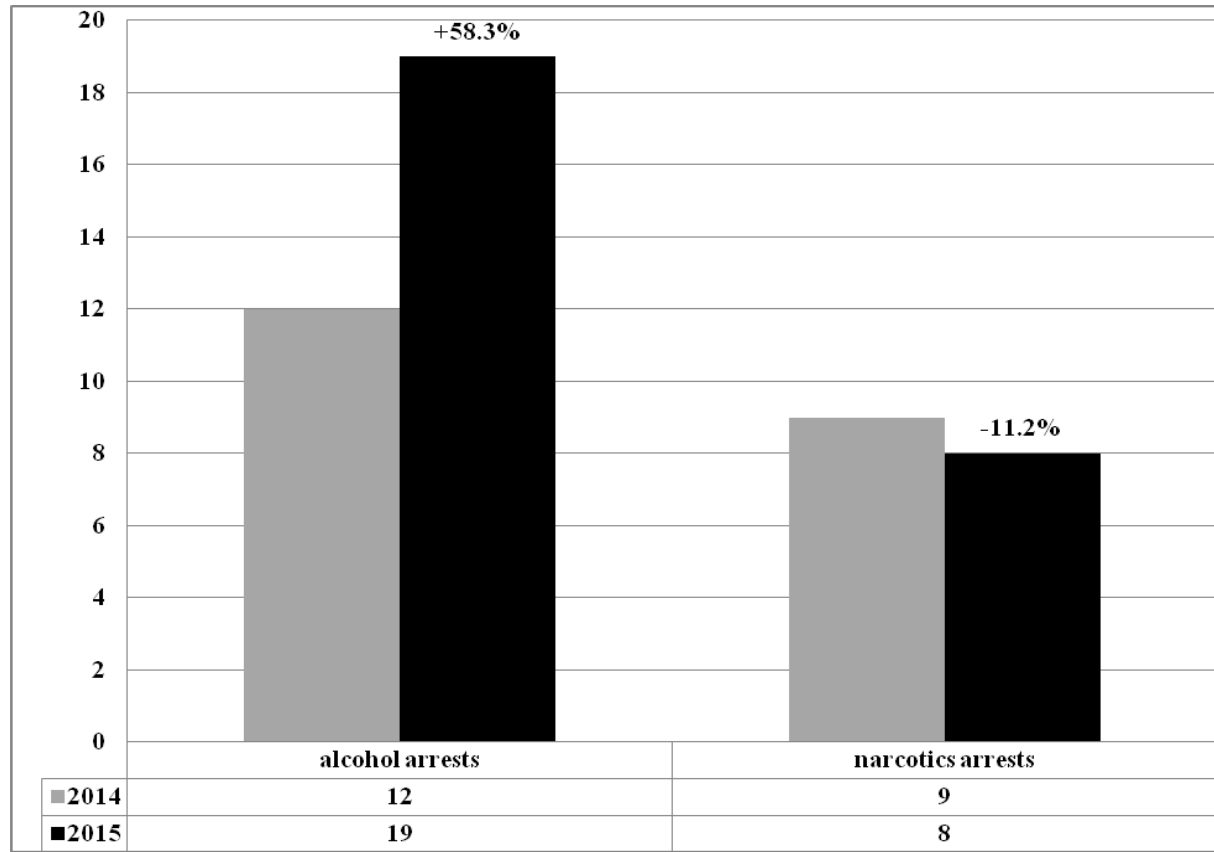

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park. Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia. Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

- [Darryl Brooks](#) – no open cases, not on probation.
- [Frank Killright](#) – on probation and in treatment.
- [Ronald King](#) – no open cases, not on probation, receiving help for mental health issues.
- [Lavell Love](#) – on supervised probation and in treatment, consuming alcohol in public and criminal contempt of court case set for court on 4/19.
- [Carl LeMans Williams](#) – no open cases, not on probation.
- [Patrick Addy](#) – in custody for probation violations, hold without bail, set for court on 3/31.
- [Harry Leftbear](#) – in the workhouse until 4/1 for trespassing and disorderly conduct, then on probation for two other cases.
- [Nathaniel Roby](#) – Level 3 sex offender, out of jail and in a locked facility, probation violation hearing set for 4/1 for two gross misdemeanor indecent conduct cases, restricted from the area as a condition of release.
- [Farid Suleiman](#) – in custody on \$1,000 bail, gross misdemeanor trespassing case set for court on 4/10.
- [James Wilkins](#) – active warrant for failing to report to the workhouse.

SSCO submitted community impact statements to the court for the following cases:

- [Robert Yellow Wolf](#) (10/29/68, 32 arrests in the area in the past ten years, 45 prior convictions in Hennepin County) – 3/11/15 consuming alcohol in public in Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave. SSCO asked the court to sentence Yellow Wolf to the maximum amount of time in custody if convicted or to restrict him from the area if he is conditionally released.
- [Deanna Lynn Smith](#) (11/14/72, 10 arrests in the area in the past eight years, 26 prior convictions in Hennepin and Anoka Counties) – 3/11/15 consuming alcohol in public in Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave. SSCO asked the court to sentence Smith to the maximum amount of time in custody if convicted or to restrict her from the area if she is conditionally released. Smith is currently on supervised probation for five years for felony 3rd degree assault causing substantial bodily harm.

SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included the following case:

Jeffrey Thomas Blake (1/10/58) 4 arrests in the area in the past six months. 2 prior convictions in Hennepin County for consuming alcohol in public.
Case 2/16/15, disorderly conduct at 1912 3 rd Ave, cited by day beat officers. (15-056668)
Outcome On 3/3, failed to appear in court; warrant issued. Arrested for the warrant on 3/8. On 3/20 pled guilty. Sentence: 60 days, 55 days stayed for one year, serve 4 days sentence to service, with credit for 1 day served in custody. Conditions of release: probation to the court; no same or similar offenses; no assault; no disorderly conduct; stay out of the area from LaSalle Ave / Blaisdell Ave to 4 th Ave South, I-94 to 22 nd St. \$50 fine stayed for one year. \$75 court fees waived. Paid an additional \$78 court fees.
