

SSCO Community Safety information sheet, April 23, 2015

Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, March 27 to April 23, 2015 (source: Crime Prevention Specialist Chelsea Adams)

- No sexual assaults.
- No aggravated assaults.
- 1 robbery of person: 4/5, 3:20 p.m., at a bus stop at 18th & Nicollet in which one suspect began talking to a person while another suspect stole cash from his pocket.
- 3 burglaries: 4/13 at 610 West Franklin Ave in which items were stolen from multiple vehicles parked in an underground garage; 4/13 at 601 Ridgewood Ave in which tools were stolen from the boiler room; 4/17 at 1901 Stevens Ave in which items were stolen from an unlocked condo unit.
- 2 motor vehicle thefts: 4/13 at Franklin & Harriet; 4/21 at 209 East 19th St – in both incidents, the owners had lost their keys.
- 10 other incidents of theft, including 6 at the Public Housing high rise at 1707 3rd Ave between 4/4 and 4/16 which constitute a clear trend.

Follow-up on a previous case: Joseph Javon Williams (7/18/94), arrested for robbing a pizza delivery driver at 440 Ridgewood Ave on 1/27, has a court hearing set for 4/27 and a jury trial scheduled for 5/11.

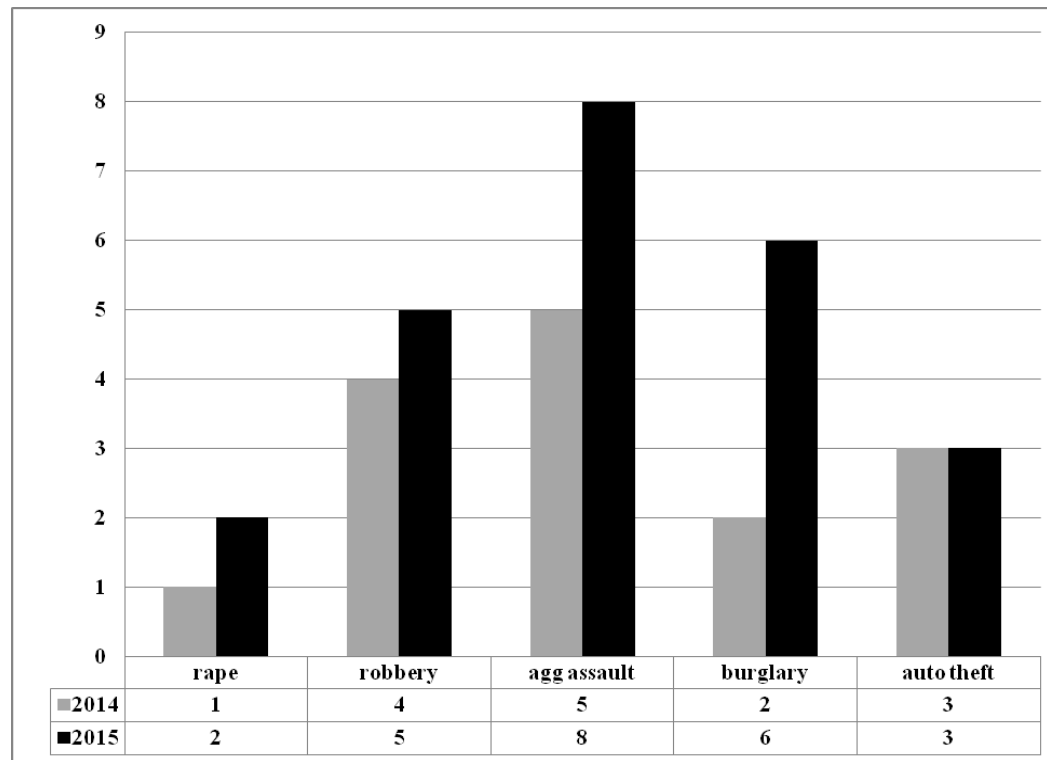
- [Lavell Love](#) – on supervised probation for gross misdemeanor trespassing from 8/6/14, in treatment and abiding by his conditions of release.

[Ahmed Hired](#) (1/1/86, 20 arrests in the area in the past five years, 19 prior convictions in Hennepin County) – 4/4/15 trespassing at 2109 Nicollet Ave. SSCO asked the court to sentence Hired to the maximum amount of time in custody if convicted or to restrict him from the area if he is conditionally released.

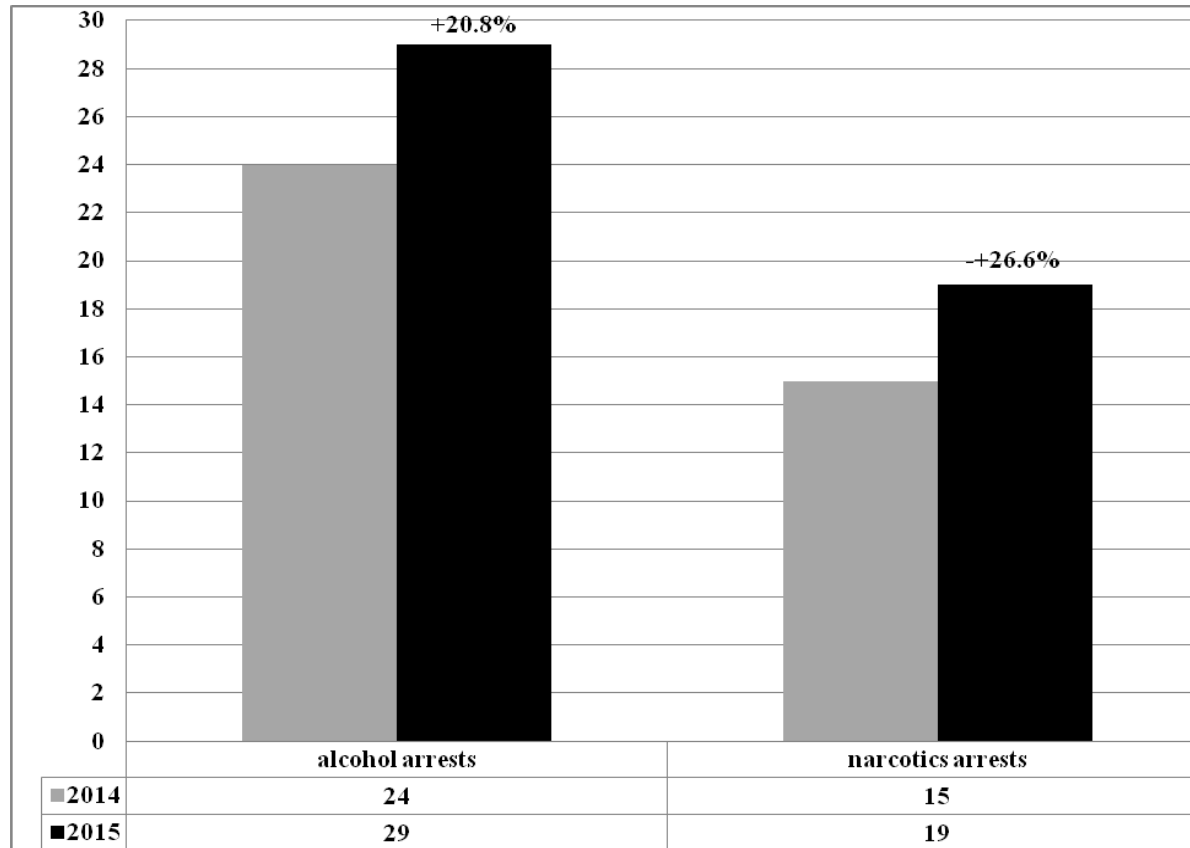

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park. Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia. Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.
