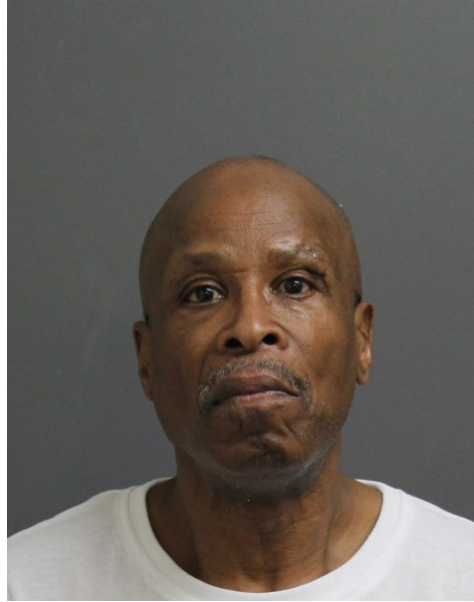

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:



James Wesley Latimore a.k.a. Ralph Young (5/3/55) 45 prior convictions in Hennepin and Ramsey Counties since 1992 for attempted 3rd degree burglary (2), disorderly conduct (8), theft (11), obstructing the legal process (2), trespassing (7), consuming alcohol in public (2), giving police a false name (3), 5th degree felony possession of a controlled substance (2), public urination, terroristic threats, open bottle, interfering with the operation of a transit vehicle, felony 4th degree assault, possession of drug paraphernalia, criminal damage to property, and criminal contempt of court.

Case 9/1/16, 3rd degree burglary at Clausen's Service Center, 22 East Franklin Ave, arrested by squads 525, 531, 953, 511, 561.

Outcome On 3/9/17, pled guilty to three cases: 1) Theft from 7/27/16. Sentence: 90 days, with credit for 90 days served. 2) Theft from 8/19/16; a trespassing charge was dismissed. Sentence: 90 days with credit for 90 days served. 3) Tampering with a motor vehicle from 8/19/16; a trespassing charge was dismissed. Sentence: 90 days, with credit for 90 days served. The following seven cases were dismissed: criminal sexual conduct from 4/10/16; disorderly conduct from 8/16/16; theft from 8/31/16; disorderly conduct and obstructing the legal process from 1/23/17; theft from 2/1/17; criminal sexual conduct from 2/18/17; theft from 2/22/17. On 3/16/17, pled guilty to 3rd degree burglary from 9/1/16 at Clausen's Service Center. Sentence: 23 months, with credit for 162 days served. Pled guilty 5th degree criminal sexual conduct from 4/10/16. Sentence: 365 days, with credit for 204 days served, to be served concurrently with the burglary sentence. Pled guilty to theft from 2/22/17; a trespassing charge was dismissed. Sentence: 90 days, with credit for 22 days served, to be served concurrently with the burglary sentence. Anticipated prison release date: 1/16/18.

Darryl Brooks (8/29/64) 53 arrests in the area since 2004. 45 prior convictions in Hennepin County for 5th degree assault (3), open bottle (5), disorderly conduct (6), trespassing (10), loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, consuming alcohol in public (3), theft, loitering with intent to solicit (3), littering (2), possession of drug paraphernalia (2), motor vehicle theft, 5th degree felony possession of a controlled substance, fleeing police on foot, giving police a false name, public urination, interfering with traffic, criminal contempt of court (2), and felony possession of simulated drugs with intent to sell as a controlled substance.

Case 12/17/16, gross misdemeanor trespassing at Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave, arrested by Franklin Nicollet beat officers. (16-451263)

Outcome On 3/22/17, pled guilty. Sentence: 365 days, stayed for two years, with credit for 4 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; stay away from Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave; remain law abiding; no trespassing; no use of alcohol or controlled substances; complete treatment. \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$78 court fees.

Sentencing judge – Christian Sande



Erin Anna Larson (6/7/71) 7 prior convictions in Minnesota for 5th degree felony possession of a controlled substance, 5th degree assault, disorderly conduct, theft, possession of drug paraphernalia, consuming alcohol in public, and prohibited act in skyway system or on pedestrian mall.

Case 6/7/16, trespassing at MN Adult & Teen Challenge, 1717 2nd Ave, cited by squad 510. (16-204920)

Outcome On 7/19/16, failed to appear in court; warrant issued. Arrested for the warrant on 8/3/16. On 10/4/16, failed to appear in court; warrant issued. Arrested for the warrant on 10/25/16. On 3/14/17, failed to appear in court; warrant issued. Arrested for the warrant on 3/23/17. On 3/28/17, pled guilty. Sentence: 90 days, stayed for one year, with credit for 13 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; no same or similar offenses; no indecent conduct; no livability offenses; chemical dependency evaluation / treatment; comply with HOMES Court. \$75 court fees waived. Additional \$78 court fees deemed uncollectible.

Sentencing judge – Toddrick Barnette



Gustavo James Best (5/27/89) 2 prior convictions in Hennepin County in 2016 for 3rd degree assault causing substantial bodily harm and tampering with a motor vehicle.

Case 2/1/17, felony 4th degree assault of a police officer causing demonstrable bodily harm at Franklin & Lyndale, arrested by Franklin Nicollet beat officers. (17-037404)

Outcome On 4/17/17, pled guilty. Sentence: 366 days in prison, stayed for 3 years, with credit for 61 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; follow all State and Federal criminal laws; no use of alcohol or controlled substances; complete chemical assessment; mental health evaluation.
