

SSCO Community Safety information sheet, April 28, 2016

Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, March 25 to April 28 (source: Crime Prevention Specialist Chelsea Adams)

- 2 robberies of person: 3/27, 6:50 a.m., at 19th & 3rd in which a person who is not a neighborhood resident reported that a known acquaintance contacted him and arranged to meet at this location – when he arrived, he was robbed by someone who seemed to be connected to the acquaintance; 3/28, 11:15 p.m., at 19th & 1st in which a person reported that he was walking on the sidewalk when a suspect placed what he believed to be a gun against his back – the suspect took the person's wallet from his back pocket and left the area.
- 1 aggravated assault: 4/8, 7:25 p.m., at 1920 Clinton Ave in which two acquaintances got into a car accident as part of an altercation, then got out of the vehicles and got into a fight with each other involving weapons – no major injuries were reported. Arrested for 2nd degree assault with a dangerous weapon: **Sharmake Mohamed Abdullahi** (1/1/91); **Abdi Ahmed Jama** (1/1/83).
- 3 apartment burglaries: 4/2 at 102 East 19th St in which a suspect pounded on an apartment door and broke in after a resident and acquaintance fled out of fear – police found and identified the suspect nearby and the case is under investigation; 4/8 at 203 East 19th St in which unknown suspect(s) pried open the door of an apartment and stole items, including car keys – the resident's vehicle was then stolen and police recovered it on 4/21; 4/9 at 1906 1st Ave in which suspects threatened a person and stole money – there are possible extenuating circumstances.
- 1 motor vehicle theft: 4/24 to 4/25, overnight, at 1818 LaSalle Ave.
- 1 shoplifting incident: 4/23 at Family Dollar Store, 1816 Nicollet Ave.
- 1 bike theft: A witness called 911 to report a person taking parts off a bike which was locked to a pole at 18th & 3rd – officers responded, found the suspect, and cited **Brian Edwin Nelson** (5/15/83) for theft after the bike owner stated that it did not belong to him. Officers found that the bike owner, **Diana Kannika Schumacher** (4/11/92), had a misdemeanor warrant for theft out of Richfield and arrested her.
- 3 other incidents of theft

- **Sharee Barrett** (7/10/81) is in custody on \$20,000 bail pending a court appearance on 5/3 for 11 cases (two felony 3rd degree burglary, nine misdemeanors).
- **Darryl Brooks** (8/29/64) is in the workhouse until 5/13 for gross misdemeanor trespassing, then on unsupervised probation, ordered to stay away from Wedge Community Co-op, 2105 Lyndale Ave.
- **William Ernst** (11/22/65) was set for court today (4/28) for a 4th degree assault case.
- **Farid Suleiman** (7/4/72) has been found incompetent to stand trial and is in custody on \$1,000 bail for a gross misdemeanor trespassing case now set for Mental Health court on 10/26.

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:



Darryl Brooks (8/29/64) 48 arrests in the area since 2004. 43 prior convictions in Hennepin County for 5th degree assault (3), open bottle (4), disorderly conduct (6), trespassing (9), loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, consuming alcohol in public (3), theft, loitering with intent to solicit (3), littering (2), possession of drug paraphernalia (2), motor vehicle theft, 5th degree felony possession of a controlled substance, fleeing police on foot, giving police a false name, public urination, interfering with traffic, criminal contempt of court (2), and felony possession of simulated drugs with intent to sell as a controlled substance.

Case 12/22/15, theft at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave, cited by day beat officers. (15-461829)

Case 3/14/16, open bottle at Franklin & Nicollet, cited by day beat officers. (16-089623)

Outcome On 4/5/16, these cases were dismissed along with a trespassing and fleeing police case from 10/7/15. Pled guilty to gross misdemeanor trespassing from 10/26/15; 5th degree assault and disorderly conduct charges were dismissed. Sentence: 365 days, 305 days stayed for two years, serve 60 days, with credit for 1 day served. Conditions of release: probation to the court; no same or similar offenses; no trespassing; no loitering; no theft; stay away from Wedge Community Co-op, 2105 Lyndale Ave, and 215 Oak Grove St. \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$78 court fees. Anticipated release date from the workhouse: 5/13/16.

Ahmed Abdulahi Mohamed (1/1/86) 3 arrests in the area in the past year. 17 prior convictions in Minnesota for giving police a false name, 5th degree felony possession of drugs, theft (2), open bottle in a motor vehicle, disorderly conduct (3), fleeing police on foot, public urination, motor vehicle theft, trespassing (4), felony 4th degree assault, and 3rd degree burglary.

Case 2/9/16, interfering with traffic at Franklin & Nicollet, cited by day beat officers. (16-045560)

Case 3/19/16, aggressive panhandling at Franklin & Nicollet, cited by day beat officers. (16-096578)

Outcome On 4/6/16, pled guilty to interfering with traffic from 2/9/16; the other case was dismissed. Sentence: 10 days, stayed for one year. Conditions of release: probation to the court; no begging or interfering with traffic. \$75 court fees waived. Pay \$75 fine and additional \$78 court fees.
