

SSCO Community Safety information sheet, May 25, 2017

Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, April 28 to May 24, 2017 (source: Community Attorney Matt Wilcox)

- 4 robberies of person: 4/28, 10:10 p.m., at 1811 1st Ave in which a suspect took a person's phone at gunpoint; 5/8, 4:15 a.m., at 110 East 18th St in which a suspect implied a handgun and attempted to rob a person; 5/19, 11:10 p.m., at Groveland & Nicollet in which a cell phone was taken; 5/20, 12:40 p.m., at 1915 Clinton Ave in which suspect stole a person's wallet while the person was unloading groceries from a vehicle – officers arrived within a minute of dispatch but were unable to locate the suspect.
- 4 aggravated assaults: 5/2, 11:30 p.m., at 1707 3rd Ave involving a friend of a friend who argued with and assaulted a victim – a suspect has been identified but no charged yet; 5/7, 12:10 a.m., at 1915 2nd Ave in which a male suspect stabbed a person, reportedly in self-defense – no criminal charges filed; 5/10, 5:45 p.m., at an address on the 1900 block of 1st Ave, a domestic assault involving a knife in which a suspect was not charged due to an uncooperative victim and lack of corroborating evidence; 5/15, 7:10 p.m., at Franklin & Nicollet in which a bus driver was hit with food.
- 1 theft from person: 5/17, 10:05 p.m., at 19th & Clinton in which a suspect took a purse off a victim's shoulder and ran away.
- 2 burglaries: 5/14 at 102 East 19th St in which a suspect forced entry to an apartment; 5/16 at 1920 3rd Ave in which a suspect (seen on surveillance video) stole a bike from a storage room .
- 2 motor vehicle thefts: 4/29 at 19th & 1st; 5/20 at 18th & 2nd.
- 5 other incidents of theft.

- Sharee Barrett (7/10/81) – convicted by a jury of 3rd degree burglary from 9/24/16 at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave, in jail pending sentencing on 6/13.
- Ahmed Abdi Hired (1/1/86) – due to be released from prison on 5/30, then on parole until 11/27 for two felony violations of a no contact order.
- William Ernst (11/22/65) – serving a 13-month sentence for felony 4th degree assault of hospital staff from 3/23/16, due to be released from prison on 7/17 and then on parole until 11/22, also on probation for gross misdemeanor trespassing from 9/26/16.

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

Patrick Addy (3/6/77) 15 arrests in the area since 2010. 69 prior convictions in Hennepin and Ramsey Counties for trespassing (22), theft (6), disorderly conduct (14), open bottle (6), amplified sound violation, public urination (2), 5th degree assault (2), riding public transit without paying the fare, consuming alcohol in public (4), criminal damage to property (2), littering (2), unlawfully obtaining transit services, possession of liquor in a park (4), unlawful smoking, and obstructing the legal process.

Case 8/1/16, theft, trespassing, public urination at African Market, 1823 Nicollet Ave. (16-278550)

Outcome On 5/1/17, this case was dismissed. Pled guilty to trespassing from 6/7/16. Sentence: 90 days, with credit for 90 days served. Pay \$128 court fees.

Luis Alberto Cuevas (2/9/90) 12 prior convictions in Minnesota for 1st degree burglary in possession of a dangerous weapon (3), 1st degree burglary of an occupied dwelling, 4th degree felony assault of a police officer, theft (6), and unlawfully obtaining transit services.

Case 4/27/17, theft at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave, arrested by squad 531. (17-153048)

Outcome On 5/1/17, pled guilty. Sentence: 90 days, 79 days stayed for 1 year, serve 11 days, with credit for 5 days served. Conditions of release: stay away from CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave; no theft. Pay \$78 court fees.

Ahmeddahir Mohamed Areis (1/1/89) 9 arrests in the area in the past two years. 33 prior convictions in Hennepin County for theft (2), attempted 1st degree aggravated robbery, terroristic threats, tampering with a motor vehicle (2), obstructing the legal process (2), disorderly conduct (6), trespassing (10), aiding / abetting burglary of a government, religious, historic, or school property, 5th degree assault (2), theft from person, giving police the false name of another person (2), interfering with a 911 call, consuming alcohol in public, and public urination.

Case 3/21/17, 5th degree assault and disorderly conduct at Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave, arrested by squad 520. (17-100245)

Outcome On 4/11/17, pled guilty. Sentence: 90 days, 89 days stayed for 1 year, with credit for 23 days served, serve 1 day. Report to the workhouse on 4/11/17 and release to treatment on 4/12/17. Conditions of release: supervised probation; no same or similar offenses. Conditions of release amended on 4/25/17: supervised probation; remain law abiding; chemical dependency evaluation / treatment; complete treatment. Pay \$78 court fees.

Dahir Yussuf Aden (1/1/85) 9 arrests in the area in the past two years. 42 prior convictions in Minnesota for giving police false information, open bottle (4), trespassing (12), disorderly conduct (12), loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, unlawfully obtaining transit services, aiding / abetting unauthorized use of a motor vehicle, 5th degree assault, possession of liquor in a park (2), consuming alcohol in public, fleeing police, aggressive panhandling, tampering with a motor vehicle, giving police a false name (2), and possession / sale of a small amount of marijuana.

Case 1/18/17, disorderly conduct and open bottle at Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave, arrested by squad 530. (17-020597)

Case 2/14/17, gross misdemeanor trespassing at Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave, arrested by Franklin Nicollet beat officers.

Outcome On 4/19/17, pled guilty to gross misdemeanor trespassing from 2/14/17. The case from 1/18/17 was dismissed, along with a driving with revoked license case from 2/12/17. Sentence: 93 days, with credit for 48 days served, serve one day of Sentence to Service in lieu of \$78 court fees. This sentence was ordered to be served consecutively to a sentence of 365 days for gross misdemeanor trespassing from 5/23/16, with credit for 94 days served. Probation for that case was revoked on 2/17/17. Workhouse release date: 8/8/17.
