

SSCO Community Safety information sheet, May 26, 2016

Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, April 29 to May 26 (source: Crime Prevention Specialist Chelsea Adams)

- 2 robberies of person: 5/23, 6:50 a.m., at Franklin & Harriet in which a male suspect got out of a car, approached a person waiting at a bus stop, asked for directions to SuperAmerica, and then yanked the purse off of her arm (which caused severe bruising), and fled in the car; 5/24, 4:10 p.m. at Franklin & Nicollet in which a female suspect approached a person who was at a bus stop with children, stole the phone out of the person's hand, entered a nearby business, and while the person was using someone else's phone to call 911, came out of the business and assaulted the person in an attempt to steal her purse – a bus driver interrupted the incident and the suspect fled.
- 2 burglaries: 5/4 to 5/9 at 1800 LaSalle Ave in which a bike was stolen from an underground garage; 5/12, overnight, at 1918 2nd Ave in which an unknown suspect entered an unlocked garage, stole tools, took the keys to a vehicle, and then stole the vehicle which ended up being recovered at the City Impound Lot after being towed from a No Parking zone on the 1700 block of Clinton on 5/13.
- 1 theft from person: 5/13, 9:20 p.m., at Franklin & Nicollet in which a suspect took a wallet from a person's back pocket and fled on a bike.
- 3 thefts from motor vehicles: 5/10, overnight, at 1815 Clinton Ave in which items were taken from the trunk of a vehicle and the hood and side of the vehicle were scratched; 5/11, morning, at 326 East 18th St in which a wallet containing credit cards was stolen from a vehicle; 5/13, overnight, at 19th & 1st in which an unknown suspect tried to steal a parked vehicle by bypassing the ignition, instead took the remote starter unit from the engine compartment and left the hood open.
- 2 bike thefts: 5/2, overnight, at 601 Ridgewood Ave in which an older bike was left at the scene; 5/14 at 20 Groveland Ave in which a chain securing the bike to a post was cut.

CLEAN list update, April 29 to May 26 (source: Community Attorney Nikki Appelbaum)

- **Sharee Barrett** (7/10/81) is in custody on \$20,000 bail pending a court appearance for 11 cases (two felony 3rd degree burglary, nine misdemeanors); found to be unamenable to probation and therefore is not eligible for Mental Health court.
- **Patrick Addy** (3/6/77) is in custody on \$1,000 bail for two gross misdemeanor trespassing cases set for Felony Mental Health court on 5/31.
- **Dahir Yussuf Aden** (1/1/85 or 1/1/82) is in custody on \$1,000 bail for a gross misdemeanor trespassing case set for court on 5/26 and is on unsupervised probation for a gross misdemeanor trespassing conviction out of Bloomington; he is trespassed from 1925 Nicollet Ave and the Mall of America.
- **Lavell Love** (6/13/63) had his probation revoked for a gross misdemeanor trespassing case and is in the workhouse until 9/13 pending furlough to treatment.
- **Sharmake Abdullahi Mohamed** (1/1/90) is on unsupervised probation for two gross misdemeanor trespassing cases and has a new gross misdemeanor trespassing case set for court on 6/15.
- **Farid Yusuf Suleiman** (7/4/72), who has been found incompetent to stand trial, is on unsupervised probation for gross misdemeanor trespassing and has two more gross misdemeanor trespassing cases set for Mental Health court on 10/26.

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included a case involving:



Mohamed Ahmed Farah (1/1/84) 5 arrests in the area in 2015. 21 prior convictions in Hennepin County for 5th degree assault, terroristic threats, fleeing police in a motor vehicle, loitering with intent to solicit, disorderly conduct (7), 5th degree felony possession of a controlled substance, driving while intoxicated, open bottle (3), possession of liquor in a park, and trespassing (4).

Case 12/11/15, 5th degree assault (two charges) and disorderly conduct at Loring Nicollet Alternative School, 1925 Nicollet Ave. (15-450157)

Outcome On 4/20/16, pled guilty to 5th degree assault (inflict or attempt to inflict bodily harm). The other 5th degree assault charge (fear of bodily harm or death) and the disorderly conduct charge were dismissed. Sentence: 90 days, with credit for 40 days served. Also pled guilty to gross misdemeanor refusal to leave upon lawful demand from 10/31/15. Sentence: 180 days, with credit for 40 days served, to be served concurrently with the sentence for the 12/11/15 case. A disorderly conduct and consuming alcohol in public case from 2/9/16 was dismissed. Released from custody and ordered to report to the workhouse on 5/4/16. Failed to report to the workhouse on 5/4/16; warrant issued. Warrant served on 5/6/16. Received credit for an additional 8 days served for new offenses since he was sentenced on 4/20. Workhouse release date: 7/16/16.

SSCO submitted community impact statements to the court for the following cases:

Rachael O'Gorman (12/24/76, 5 arrests in the area in the past seven months) – 4/30/16 consuming alcohol in public in Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave. SSCO asked the court to order chemical dependency evaluation / treatment if O'Gorman is convicted of any crimes or to restrict her from the area if she is conditionally released.

Armando Day (10/5/74, ten arrests in the area in the past seven years, 37 prior convictions in Minnesota) – 12/30/15 trespassing at McDonald's Restaurant, 2400 Nicollet Ave. SSCO asked the court to sentence Day to serve the maximum amount of time in custody if he is convicted of any crimes or to restrict him from the area if he is conditionally released.
