- 4 robberies of person: 5/30, 9:05 a.m., at gunpoint at the bus stop near 1905 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave in which two suspects took a person's wallet and cell phone; 6/3, 1 p.m., at Franklin & Nicollet in which a suspect took an item out of a person's bag and stabbed the person in the arm; 6/7, 7:20 p.m., at gunpoint at 1808 Stevens Ave in which a person's phone was taken; 6/10, 9:30 a.m., at 1902 4<sup>th</sup> Ave for which Mitae Poe Elm (4/29/87) was arrested and charged.
- 3 aggravated assaults: 5/29, 9:05 a.m., at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave, for which Melvin Dickerson (7/3/66) was arrested and charged with felony 4<sup>th</sup> degree assault of a police officer; 6/7, 6:45 p.m., at 110 East 18<sup>th</sup> St for which Edsimon Willie (6/8/78) was arrested and charged with felony domestic assault plus misdemeanor 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault of a witness; 6/9, 9:45 a.m., felony 2<sup>nd</sup> degree domestic assault at a location on LaSalle Ave.
- 2 burglaries: 5/30, between 5:30 and 8:30 p.m., at 308 East 18<sup>th</sup> St in the underground parking garage in which a bike was stolen; 6/15 at 1800 Clinton Ave in which a suspect attempted to pry open the main entry door by was interrupted by residents.
- 1 motor vehicle theft: 6/8 at 19<sup>th</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup>.

- Patrick Addy (3/6/77) – no open cases and not on probation, recently completed an intensive in-patient treatment program.
- David Brenner (7/5/75) – active warrant for a probation violation on a trespassing case.
- Ellery Charging Thunder (2/20/54) – in HOMES Court and continues to offend in the neighborhood; he was cited this week for consuming alcohol in public at Plymouth Church, 1900 Nicollet Ave.
- Corey Harges (12/27/90) – arrested in the area this week for a warrant for a probation violation on a robbery case.
- Ahmed Abdi Hired (1/1/86) – released from prison on 5/30, on parole until 11/27, in custody in Freeborn County on an ICE (Immigration and Customs Enforcement) hold.
- Abdullahi Yasin Muse (1/1/82) – on probation for three gross misdemeanor trespassing cases, active warrants for failure to appear in HOMES Court on three additional cases.
- Robert Yellow Wolf (10/29/68) – conditionally released pending sentencing after being convicted of felony domestic assault, subsequently arrested for having contact with the victim and then released again pending charges – charges of violating a domestic no contact order were filed today and there is a warrant out for his arrest.
- William Ernst (11/22/65) – serving a 13-month sentence for felony 4<sup>th</sup> degree assault of hospital staff from 3/23/16, due to be released from prison on 7/17, currently being screened for intensive supervised release until his sentence expires on 11/22.

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

**SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:**



**Sharee Lanette Barrett** (7/10/81) Arrested in the area 17 times between September 2015 and February 2017. 19 prior convictions in Minnesota for possession of marijuana in a motor vehicle, 5<sup>th</sup> degree felony possession of a controlled substance, giving police a false name (2), receiving stolen property, disorderly conduct (4), open bottle (2), consuming alcohol in public, 2<sup>nd</sup> degree burglary of dwelling, 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault (3), trespassing (2), and 3<sup>rd</sup> degree butglary.

**Case** 9/24/16, 3<sup>rd</sup> degree burglary at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave. (16-348561)

**Case** 2/9/17, disorderly conduct and gross misdemeanor trespassing at AM Food Market, 1814 Nicollet Ave, arrested by Franklin Nicollet beat officers. (17-047020)

**Outcome** On 6/13/17, was convicted of 3<sup>rd</sup> degree burglary from 9/24/16 and gross misdemeanor trespassing from 2/9/17. The following cases were dismissed: open bottle from 6/30/15; open bottle from 7/7/15; open bottle from 9/8/15; trespassing and disorderly conduct from 3/11/17. Sentence for felony 3<sup>rd</sup> degree burglary: 27 months in prison, with credit for 217 days served. Sentence for gross misdemeanor trespassing: 365 days, with credit for 88 days served. The sentences were ordered to be served concurrently. Prison release date: 5/10/18

**Willis Tomichael Taylor** (8/28/74) Arrested in the area 7 times from 2008 to 2012. 91 prior convictions in Hennepin and Ramsey Counties since 1997 for disorderly conduct (15), robbery, trespassing (46), 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault (5), 5<sup>th</sup> degree felony possession of a controlled substance, theft from person, assault on a police horse, open bottle (4), consuming alcohol in public, unlawfully obtaining transit services (2), public urination (5), transit fare evasion, interfering with traffic, crossing a street against a red light (2), criminal contempt of court, fleeing police on foot, theft (2), and falsely using the name of another person.

**Case** 4/18/17, open bottle at Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave, cited by squad 513. (17-139993)

**Outcome** On 5/30/17, this case was dismissed. Pled guilty to trespassing from 4/10/17 and to theft from 4/25/17. Sentence for each conviction, ordered to be served concurrently: 90 days, 45 days stayed for one year, serve 45 days, with credit for 4 days served. Conditions of release: probation to the court; no same or similar offenses; no trespassing; comply with geographic restriction; no new offenses. \$50 fine and \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$78 court fees. Workhouse release: 6/24/17.

**Tyrone Parrish Douglas** (7/11/69) 26 prior convictions in Minnesota since 1992 for theft (11), attempted theft (2), motor vehicle theft, 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault (2), disorderly conduct, 5<sup>th</sup> degree felony possession of a controlled substance, trespassing (2), giving police false information, open bottle, 2<sup>nd</sup> degree burglary of dwelling, escape from custody, giving police a false name, and consuming alcohol in public.

**Case** 3/24/17, possession of drug paraphernalia at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave, cited by squad 510. (17-104174)

**Outcome** On 6/6/17, pled guilty without appearing in court. Ordered to pay \$50 fine and \$78 court fees, with penalties added for late payment.
