

SSCO Community Safety information sheet, June 23, 2016

Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, May 27 to June 23 (source: Crime Prevention Specialist Chelsea Adams)

- 1 sexual assault: 6/14, in which a person told police that she believed she had been raped by an acquaintance – no further public information is available.
- 2 robberies of person: 5/30, 4:30 p.m., at 18th & Nicollet in which four males robbed a person – Abdi Kani Salad (3/6/87) was later arrested; 6/7, 4 p.m., at 1830 Stevens Ave in which a male suspect, who met a person via craigslist to sell an iPhone, chased and assaulted the person and stole the person's phone.
- 3 aggravated assaults: 5/29, 4:15 p.m., at Franklin & Clinton in which three unknown females assaulted a person and fled after he called 911; 6/13, 9:35 p.m., at 1833 Nicollet Ave in which officers responding to a report of a person with a gun found a victim who had been assaulted – no gun was involved – after an argument between him and some females; 6/15, 11:40 p.m., at 18th & 1st in which a person was assaulted and refused to give information to police or paramedics about what happened.
- 1 apartment burglary: 6/12, 8 p.m., at 1816 Stevens Ave for which Daryn Dashawn Kennedy (3/8/73) was subsequently arrested.
- 2 thefts from motor vehicle: 5/30 at 19th & Clinton in which a license plate was stolen from a motorcycle; 6/16 at 18th & 1st in which items were stolen from an unlocked car.

- **Sharee Barrett** (7/10/81) is in custody on \$20,000 bail pending a court appearance on 6/27 for 11 cases (two felony 3rd degree burglary, nine misdemeanors).
- **Patrick Addy** (3/6/77) has a gross misdemeanor warrant for a probation violation, has serious medical issues, and may be considered for civil commitment or possibly treatment outside Hennepin County.
- **Ellery Charging Thunder** (2/20/54) was released from the workhouse on 5/25 and is on supervised probation.
- **Ahmed Abdi Hired** (1/1/86) is in jail on \$100,000 bail for another felony domestic assault case which is set for court on 8/1

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:



Robert Eugene Schmit (4/27/80) 11 prior convictions in Hennepin and Anoka Counties for theft (4), vagrancy, disorderly conduct, trespassing (4), and 5th degree assault.

Case 3/8/16, felony 4th degree assault of a police officer and gross misdemeanor obstructing the legal process at 2017 Garfield Ave, arrested by day beat officers and squad 506. (16-081173)

Outcome On 3/31/16, pled guilty to gross misdemeanor obstructing the legal process; the felony 4th degree assault charge was dismissed. Sentenced on 5/27/16: 365 days, stayed for two years, with credit for 56 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; no use of alcohol or controlled substances; complete chemical dependency assessment; psychological and psychiatric evaluation / treatment; remain law abiding. \$153 court fees waived.

Michael Dean Rowell (5/22/52) 9 arrests in the neighborhood since 2009. 52 prior convictions in Hennepin County for theft (3), 5th degree assault (8), crime against Metro Transit, disorderly conduct (21), indecent conduct, consuming alcohol in public (2), possession of marijuana, unlawful smoking, interfering with transit operations, trespassing (5), illegal possession of a knife with a blade over 4 inches, obstructing the legal process, open bottle (2), loitering with intent to buy narcotics, and public urination (3).

Case 2/29/16, open bottle at 2124 Garfield Ave, cited by day beat officers. (16-070532)

Outcome On 5/25/16, pled guilty without making a court appearance and paid \$50 fine and \$128 court fees.
