### Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, June 26 to July 23, 2015 (source: Crime Prevention Specialist Chelsea Adams)

- 1 sexual assault: 7/4, in which a male suspect, who is known to the victim, was arrested.
- 1 aggravated assault: 7/12, 209 East 19<sup>th</sup> St, in which a group of suspects assaulted two male victims – anyone with information about this incident should contact Adams at [chelsea.adams@minneapolismn.gov](mailto:chelsea.adams@minneapolismn.gov)
- No motor vehicle thefts.
- 1 robbery: 7/21, 7:14 p.m. at Plymouth Church, 1900 Nicollet Ave in which a male suspect stole items from a juvenile female victim.
- 4 burglaries: 6/28, 102 East 19<sup>th</sup> St, in which a suspect gained entry to an apartment through a broken window; 2 incidents on 6/29 at 20 Groveland Ave in which a male suspect entered two unlocked apartments and was confronted by residents who returned home; 7/10, 137 East 17<sup>th</sup> St, in which a suspect stole clothing from the laundry room and escaped from a resident and then from responding officers.

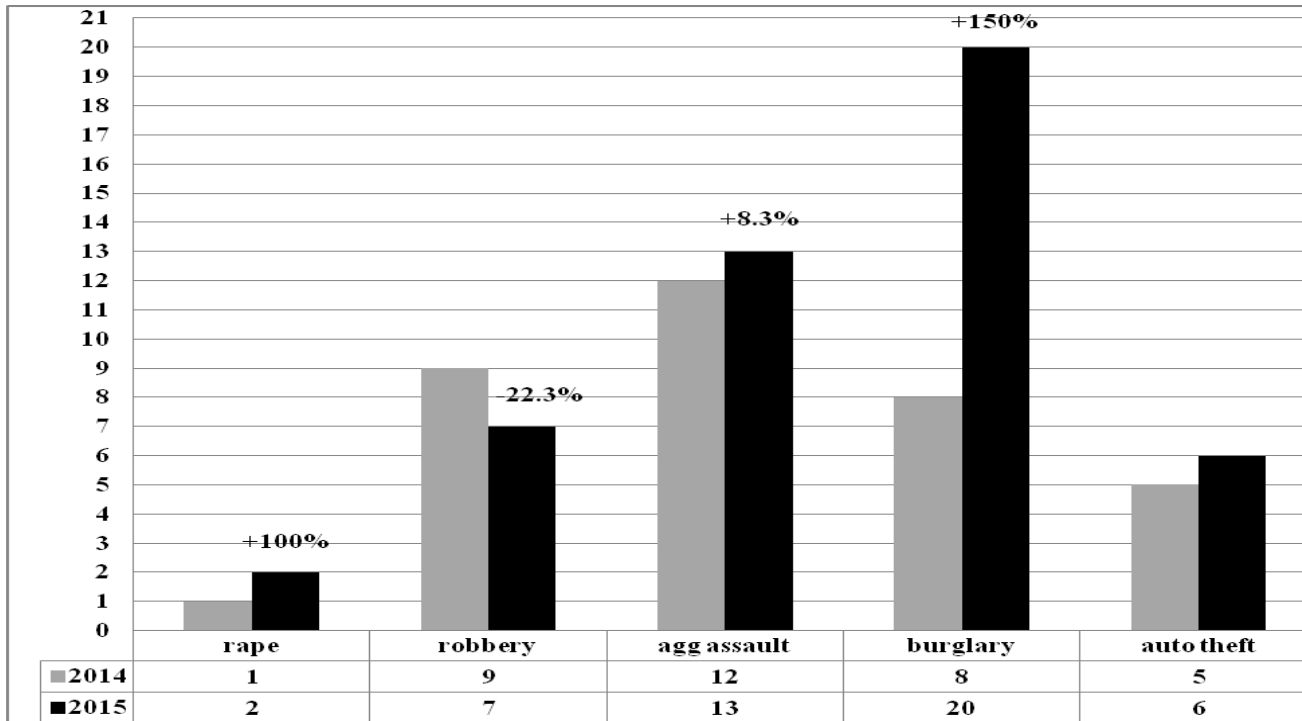
- [David Omurwa](#) – doing well in HOMES court, on supervised probation for trespassing and disorderly conduct, restricted from the area as a condition of release.

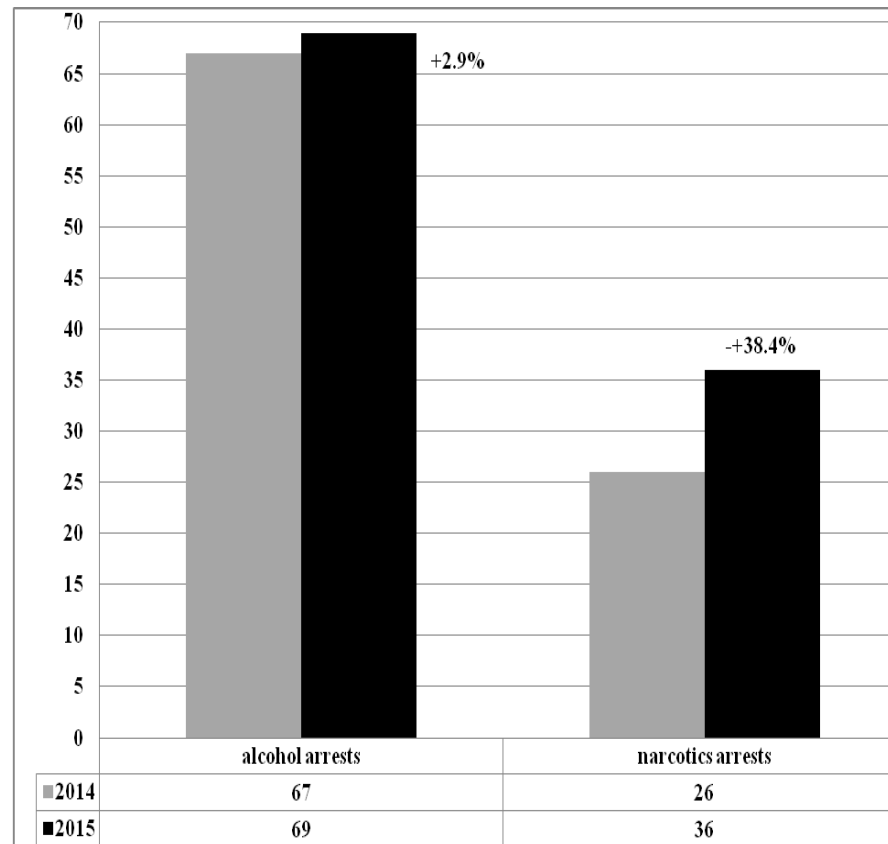

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

**SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:**

**Robert John Yellow Wolf** (10/29/68) 32 arrests in the area in the past eleven years. 45 prior convictions in Hennepin County for 2<sup>nd</sup> degree assault with a dangerous weapon (3), aiding/abetting 3<sup>rd</sup> degree burglary, aiding/abetting 3<sup>rd</sup> degree assault causing substantial bodily harm, possession of drug paraphernalia, obstructing the legal process, trespassing (8), disorderly conduct (6), criminal damage to property (2), interfering with traffic (2), open bottle (9), consuming alcohol in public (2), fleeing police on foot (2), domestic assault, giving police a false name, unlawfully obtaining transit services, riding public transit without paying the fare, falsely reporting a crime, theft, and 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault.

**Case** 3/11/15, open bottle at Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave, cited by Park police. (15-083225)

**Outcome** On 6/18/15, this case was dismissed along with the following cases: gross misdemeanor trespassing from 9/18/14, open bottle from 3/18/15, and open bottle from 4/22/15. Pled guilty to gross misdemeanor trespassing from 9/13/14. Sentence: 365 days, with credit for 365 days served. Pled guilty to consuming alcohol in public from 4/16/15. Sentence: 90 days, with credit for 90 days served.

**Sentencing judge:** Marta Chou

**Lester Allen Cloud** (10/8/60) 16 arrests in the area in the past seven years. 15 prior convictions in Hennepin County for disorderly conduct, domestic assault, consuming alcohol in public (4), open bottle (5), public urination, refusal to leave upon lawful demand, criminal contempt of court, and trespassing.

**Case** 5/7/15, gross misdemeanor trespassing at Franklin & Nicollet, arrested by Metro Transit police. (MT 15-013652)

**Outcome** On 6/23/15, pled guilty. Sentence: 365 days, 355 days stayed for one year. Serve 10 days, with credit for 10 days served. Serve one day Sentenced to Service in lieu of \$78 court fees. Conditions of release: probation to the court; no trespassing; no same or similar offenses; no alcohol-related offenses. \$50 fine and \$75 court fees waived.

**Eric Vaughn Robinson** (10/6/62) 17 arrests in the area in the past seven years. 32 prior convictions in Hennepin County for 2<sup>nd</sup> degree burglary, disorderly conduct (5), 5<sup>th</sup> degree felony possession of a controlled substance, domestic assault, interfering with traffic, trespassing (7), public urination (4), consuming alcohol in public (2), peddling without a permit, open bottle (5), theft, criminal damage to property, driving while intoxicated, and felony crime against transit operator.

**Case** 1/15/15, gross misdemeanor trespassing, 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault, and open bottle at Wedge Community Co-op, 2105 Lyndale Ave, arrested by day beat officers. (15-016202)

**Case** 3/8/15, trespassing at 2215 Blaisdell Ave, arrested by squad 510. (15-079953)

**Outcome** On 6/29/15, pled guilty to gross misdemeanor trespassing from 1/15/15. The other charges and the other case were dismissed. Sentence: 365 days, 340 days stayed for two years, serve 25 days, with credit for 15 days served, the remaining 10 days to be served as Sentence to Service in lieu of confinement. Conditions of release: unsupervised probation; remain law abiding; no new offenses; no contact with Wedge Community Co-op. \$75 court fees waived. \$78 additional court fees reduced by judicial order.

**Sentencing judge** Philip Bush

**Randy Patrick McNellis** (12/6/55) 30 arrests in the area in the past eleven years. 75 prior convictions in Minnesota for 2<sup>nd</sup> degree criminal sexual conduct, domestic assault, disorderly conduct (13), driving while intoxicated (2), 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault (4), littering, consuming alcohol in public (12), obstructing the legal process (2), attempted theft by swindle, open bottle (13), aggressive panhandling (2), trespassing (16), public urination (3), and criminal contempt of court (4).

**Case** 6/22/15, consuming alcohol in public at Franklin & Nicollet, cited by day beat officers. (15-225928)

**Outcome** On 7/7/15, failed to appear in court; warrant issued. Arrested for the warrant on 7/10/15. On 7/13/15, pled guilty. Sentence: 90 days, stayed for one year. Serve 1 day Sentence to Service in lieu of \$78 court fees. Additional \$75 court fees waived. Conditions of release: supervised probation; remain law abiding; chemical dependency evaluation / treatment; no use of alcohol or controlled substances; no non-prescription drugs; comply with HOMES court.

**Sentencing judge** Bev Benson

**Paul Vernon Clock** (6/27/54) 9 arrests in the area in the past two years. 15 prior convictions in Minnesota for disorderly conduct (6), 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault, criminal damage to property, consuming alcohol in public, open bottle (4), giving police a false name, and trespassing.

**Case** 6/18/15, open bottle at 17 East 24<sup>th</sup> St, cited by day beat officers. (15-223090)

**Outcome** On 7/8/15, pled guilty. A prohibited language case from 6/9/15 was dismissed. Sentence: 60 days, stayed for one year. Conditions of release: supervised probation; comply with HOMES court; remain law abiding; no new offenses. \$78 court fees reduced by judicial order.

**Sentencing judge** Bruce Peterson
