Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included a case involving:



Rovon Bernard Shambley (4/10/76) 2 prior convictions in Hennepin County for disorderly conduct and 2nd degree felony possession of a controlled substance.

Case 12/8/16, 2nd degree felony sale of drugs and 3rd degree felony possession of drugs at 1806 3rd Ave, arrested by 5th Precinct CRT. (16-440406)

Outcome On 6/19/17, pled guilty to 3rd degree felony possession of drugs; the 2nd degree sale of drugs charge was dismissed. Stay of imposition: serve 180 days in the workhouse effective 7/10/17, with credit for 2 days served. Serve as electronic home monitoring or work release, if eligible. Conditions of release: supervised probation for 3 years; follow all state and federal criminal laws; do not use or possess firearms; no use of alcohol or controlled substances. Pay \$78 court fees and \$1,500 fine; additional \$6,000 fine stayed for 3 years.
