

## SSCO Community Safety information sheet, July 28, 2016

---

### **Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, June 24 to July 28** (source: Crime Prevention Specialist Chelsea Adams)

- 2 robberies of person: 7/6, 9:30 p.m., in Stevens Square Park in which two male suspects assaulted a person and stole his backpack; 7/28, 2:40 a.m. at 209 East 19<sup>th</sup> St in which three male suspects stole a person's phone.
- 1 aggravated assault: 7/4, 6:20 p.m., at 18<sup>th</sup> & Nicollet in which Shandra Maria Gardner (12/10/80) was arrested for 2<sup>nd</sup> degree assault for stabbing a person with a knife – while being transported to jail, Gardner was uncooperative and kicked the door windows and partition in the squad and broke the rear squad camera.
- 1 apartment burglary: 6/26 at 1900 Clinton Ave in which a known suspect entered an apartment through an unlocked window.
- 1 business burglary: 7/16 to 7/18 at Twin Cities Wireless, 1841 Nicollet Ave, in which a suspect broke out the front window of the shop and stole cell phones.
- 2 motor vehicle thefts: 6/24 at Franklin & Clinton; 6/27 at 19<sup>th</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in which a male suspect loitering nearby stole a vehicle which was parked on the street and left running with the key in the ignition while the driver went to a store.
- 2 thefts from motor vehicles: 7/5 at 1831 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave in which a checkbook was stolen from an unlocked vehicle; 7/9 at 1819 Nicollet Ave in which a wallet and parking permit were stolen from an unlocked vehicle.
- 2 other incidents of theft: 6/27 at Family Dollar Store, 1816 Nicollet Ave, in which Robert Hall (9/8/75) was apprehended with stolen merchandise and found to be in possession of drug paraphernalia; 6/29 at 18<sup>th</sup> & Nicollet in which a known suspect stole cash from the pockets of a person who was heavily intoxicated and passed out on the sidewalk.

- **Sharee Barrett** (7/10/81), who was conditionally released to treatment, has 12 warrants for failure to appear in court on 7/26: theft and disorderly conduct from 5/9/15; consuming alcohol in public from 9/25/15; 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault and disorderly conduct from 9/26/15; theft and trespassing from 10/3/15; consuming alcohol in public from 10/3/15; theft and trespassing from 10/6/15; open bottle from 10/28/15; open bottle from 11/16/15; trespassing from 12/5/15; 3<sup>rd</sup> degree burglary from 12/12/15; 3<sup>rd</sup> degree burglary from 1/17/16; 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault and disorderly conduct from 5/12/16.
- **Darryl Brooks** (8/29/64) is on probation for gross misdemeanor trespassing and has a new consuming alcohol in public and disorderly conduct case pending.
- **William Ernst** (11/22/65) is set for court on 8/8 and 8/22 for a 4<sup>th</sup> degree assault case and has a new trespassing case pending.
- **Farid Yusuf Suleiman** (7/4/72), who was found incompetent to stand trial on 4/27, is on probation for gross misdemeanor trespassing and in jail for a new theft case.
- **Robert Yellow Wolf** (10/29/68) is in HOMES Court and on probation for open bottle.
- **Patrick Addy** (3/6/77), who is in Felony Mental Health Court, is on probation for gross misdemeanor obstructing the legal process and has been released to treatment.

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

**SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:**



**Mohamed Ali Elmi** (1/1/90) 5 prior convictions in Hennepin and Ramsey Counties for theft (2), trespassing, and motor vehicle theft (2).

**Case** 8/4/15, 1<sup>st</sup> degree criminal sexual conduct (two charges), 2<sup>nd</sup> degree criminal sexual conduct, kidnapping, 1<sup>st</sup> degree aggravated robbery (two charges) at 1831 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave. (15-290627)

**Outcome** On 6/9/16, convicted of all charges. Sentenced on 7/22/16: Life in prison without parole for 1<sup>st</sup> degree criminal sexual conduct (one charge). No sentence was pronounced for the other five charges; the sentences were combined with the first charge. Pay restitution of \$4,532.71. Do not register to vote.

**Dahir Yussuf Aden** (1/1/85) 7 arrests in the area in the past eight months. 40 prior convictions in Minnesota for giving police false information, open bottle (4), trespassing (11), disorderly conduct (12), loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, unlawfully obtaining transit services, aiding / abetting unauthorized use of a motor vehicle, 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault, possession of liquor in a park (2), consuming alcohol in public, fleeing police, aggressive panhandling, tampering with a motor vehicle, and giving police a false name (2).

**Case** 5/23/16, gross misdemeanor trespassing at Loring Nicollet Alternative School, 1925 Nicollet Ave, arrested by day beat officers. (16-183779)

**Outcome** On 6/28/16, pled guilty. The following cases were dismissed: disorderly conduct from 5/17, open bottle from 5/23, prohibited language from 6/16, and gross misdemeanor trespassing from 6/24. Sentence: 365 days, with 180 days stayed for two years, served 185 days, with credit for 20 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; chemical dependency evaluation / treatment; no use of alcohol or controlled substances; remain law-abiding; no contact with 1925 Nicollet Ave; no trespassing; no same or similar offenses. Pay \$78 court fees. Additional \$75 court fees waived. Workhouse release date: 10/8/16.

**Sharmake Abdullahi Mohamed** (1/1/90) 8 arrests in the area in the past eight months. 14 prior convictions in Hennepin County since 2008 for 1<sup>st</sup> degree aggravated robbery (2), possession of liquor in a park, trespassing (8), littering, and consuming alcohol in public (2).

**Case** 5/10/16, trespassing and disorderly conduct at Loring Nicollet Alternative School, 1925 Nicollet Ave, cited by day beat officers. (16-166257)

**Case** 5/11/16, trespassing at Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave, cited by squads 561, 571. (16-168159)

**Case** 5/17/16, tresapssing at Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave, cited by day beat officers. (16-175434)

**Outcome** On 6/22/16, pled guilty to gross misdemeanor trespassing for the 5/11/16 case at Starbucks; the 5/10 and 5/17 cases were dismissed along with five other cases involving consuming alcohol in public, open bottle (2), and unlawfully obtaining transit services (2). Sentence: 365 days, stayed for two years. Conditions of release: supervised probation; chemical dependency evaluation / treatment; cognitive skill training; psychiatric evaluation / treatment. Pay \$78 court fees. Additional \$75 court fees waived.
