- Ellery Charging Thunder (2/20/54), who failed to appear in HOMES Court on 8/22, was arrested for ten misdemeanor warrants on 8/24. He is scheduled to appear in court on 8/31.
- David Brenner (7/5/75) will be released from the workhouse on 8/26 and will not be on probation.
- William Ernst (11/22/65) was released to the Department of Corrections on 8/24 to serve the rest of his felony assault sentence after violating parole conditions; his sentence expires on 12/10.
- Rachael O’Gorman (12/24/76), who is no longer in HOMES Court, had her court appearance on two cases (loitering, trespassing, obstructing the legal process) which was scheduled for today postponed.

Alcohol-related offenses include consuming alcohol in public, open bottle, and possession of liquor in a park.

Narcotics-related offenses include narcotics violation, loitering with intent to buy or sell narcotics, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Prostitution-related offenses include prostitution, loitering with intent to commit prostitution.

SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:



Alexander Andre Lanier (7/26/91) 6 prior convictions in Hennepin and Kanabec Counties for aiding / abetting 1st degree aggravated robbery, unlawful smoking, 2nd degree assault with a dangerous weapon (2), disorderly conduct, and theft.

Case 2/20/17, motor vehicle theft (MPD bait vehicle) at Franklin & Nicollet, arrested by squads 512, 560, 954, 545, 6525, 850. (17-061913)

Outcome On 8/7/17, pled guilty. Sentence: 19 months, stayed for three years, serve 57 days, with credit for 56 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; follow all state and federal laws; obtain / maintain employment / educational programming; mental health evaluation; cognitive skills training; no use of alcohol or controlled substances; complete treatment. \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional \$78 court fees.

Steven Lashawn Bates (10/16/81) 11 prior convictions in Minnesota for passing a worthless check, domestic assault by strangulation, 5th degree assault, disorderly conduct, theft (3), trespassing, giving police a false name, consuming alcohol in public, and obstructing the legal process.

Case 5/8/17, theft at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave, cited by Franklin Nicollet beat officers. (17-166856)

Outcome On 8/21/17, this case was dismissed. Pled guilty to 3rd degree assault causing substantial bodily harm from 10/20/16. Sentence: 15 months, stayed for three years, serve 66 days, with credit for 66 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; no use of alcohol or controlled substances; anger management class; chemical dependency evaluation / treatment; mental health evaluation; cognitive skills training; follow all state and federal laws; do not use or possession firearms. Pay \$78 court fees. Also pled guilty to gross misdemeanor 5th degree possession of drugs; charges of counterfeiting of money, loitering with intent to solicit, possession of drug paraphernalia, and possession / sale of a small amount of marijuana were dismissed. Sentence: 365 days, stayed for two years, serve 53 days, with credit for 53 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; remain law abiding; no drug related offenses; chemical dependency evaluation / treatment. Pay \$78 court fees.
