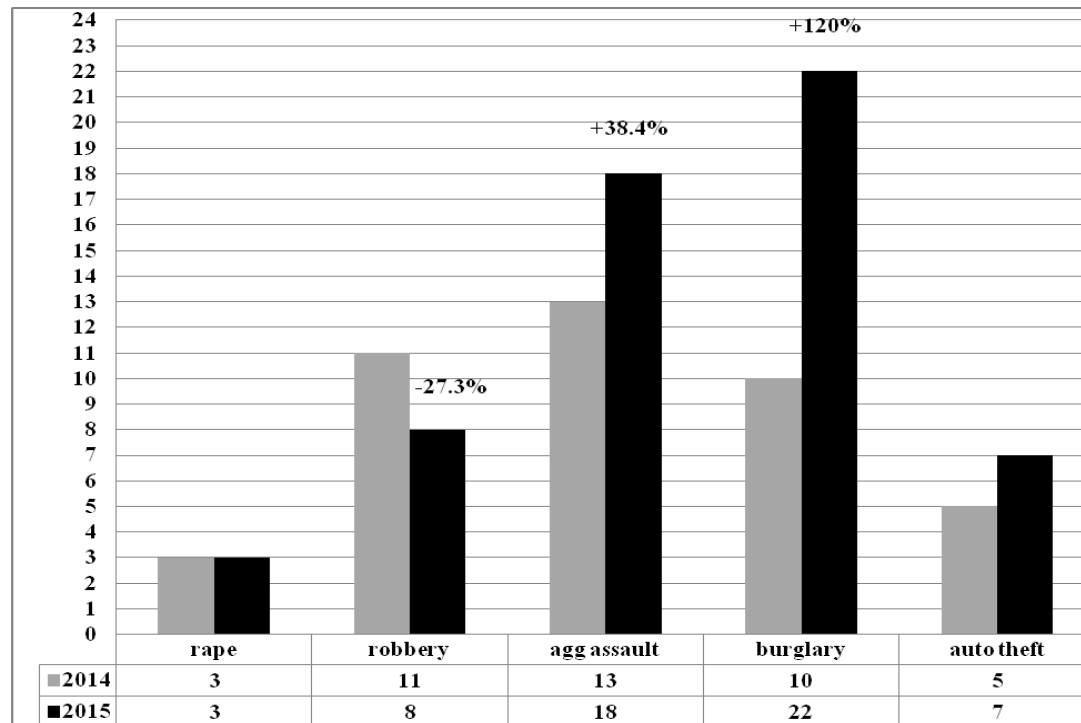

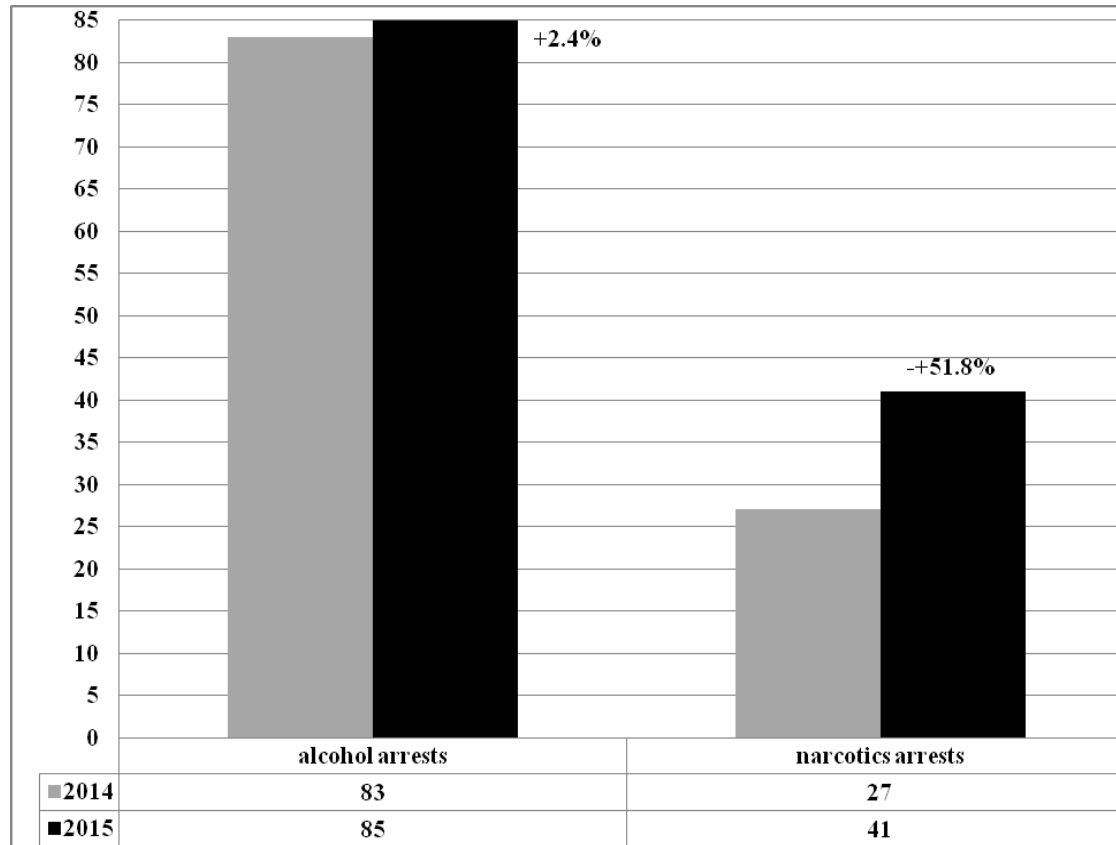

**SSCO's monthly chronic offender update included cases involving:**

<p><b>Ahmed Abdi Hired</b> (1/1/86) 24 arrests in the area in the past five years. 19 prior convictions in Hennepin County for disorderly conduct (5), underage possession of alcohol, trespassing (2), open bottle (4), consuming alcohol in public (2), obstructing the legal process, possession of liquor in a park (2), and 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault (2).</p>
<p><b>Case</b> 4/4/15, gross misdemeanor trespassing at M &amp; M Grocery Store, 2109 Nicollet Ave, arrested by squad 560. (15-117283)</p>
<p><b>Case</b> 4/23/15, interfering with traffic at Franklin &amp; Nicollet, cited by day beat officers. (15-144727)</p>
<p><b>Case</b> 5/1/15, open bottle and possession of liquor in a park at Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave, cited by day beat officers. (15-155545)</p>
<p><b>Case</b> 5/16/15, open bottle at 1728 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave, cited by day beat officers. (15-176201)</p>
<p><b>Case</b> 6/29/15, open bottle at Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave, cited by day beat officers. (15-238973)</p>
<p><b>Outcome</b> On 7/22/15, pled guilty to gross misdemeanor trespassing from 4/4/15. The four other cases were dismissed. Sentence: 365 days, serve 180 days, with credit for 10 days served. Report to the workhouse on 8/5/15. If the defendant fails to report to the workhouse or picks up a new offense, he will serve the additional 185 days (365 days total). Also pled guilty to disorderly conduct from 1/13/15. Sentence: 90 days, to be served concurrently with the gross misdemeanor case above, with credit for 15 days served. Conditions of release: remain law abiding; no new offenses. On 7/27, the defendant was arrested and booked in the jail for disorderly conduct at Starbucks Coffee, 2000 Nicollet Ave. He posted bail on 7/28 and was released. A warrant for violating the conditions of release for the gross misdemeanor trespassing case was issued on 7/28 and he was arrested for the warrant on 7/30 at Franklin &amp; Nicollet. On 8/6, the sentence for the gross misdemeanor case was amended: serve 365 days, with credit for 21 days served. Workhouse release date: 3/14/16.</p>
<p><b>Sentencing judge:</b> Jeannice Redding</p>

<p><b>Patrick Addy</b> (3/6/77) 12 arrests in the area in the past five years. 54 prior convictions in Hennepin and Ramsey Counties for trespassing (20), theft (6), disorderly conduct (11), public urination, 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault (2), public urination, criminal damage to property (2), unlawfully obtaining transit services, littering, consuming alcohol in public (4), open bottle (4), and unlawful smoking.</p>
<p><b>Case</b> 6/29/15, open bottle at Franklin &amp; Pillsbury, cited by day beat officers. (15-238941)</p>
<p><b>Outcome</b> On 8/17/15, this case was dismissed. Pled guilty to disorderly conduct from 5/17/15; another disorderly conduct charge, two 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault charges, and a theft charge were dismissed. Sentence: 90 days, 71 days stayed for one year, serve 19 days, with credit for 19 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; no same or similar offenses; remain law abiding. \$75 court fees waived. Pay \$50 fine plus additional \$78 court fees. Also pled guilty to consuming alcohol in public from 7/6/15. Sentence: 19 days with credit for 19 days served.</p>
