Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, August 26 to September 22, 2016 (source: Crime Prevention Specialist Chelsea Adams)

- 1 robbery – 9/5, 2:55 p.m., at Stevens Square Park in which a suspect hit an intoxicated person and took her cell phone.
- 1 aggravated assault – 8/31, 6 p.m., at Franklin & Nicollet in which chronic offender Brian Lee Martin (8/26/81) was arrested for 3rd degree assault causing substantial bodily harm and is in jail on \$75,000 bail pending a court appearance on 10/5.
- 1 burglary of business – 9/1, 3:45 a.m., at Clausen's Service Center, 22 East Franklin Ave, in which James Wesley Latimore a.k.a. Ralph Young (5/3/55) was arrested and is in jail on \$20,000 bail pending a court appearance on 10/7.

Abdullahi Yasin Muse (1/1/82) 4 arrests in the area in one month. 15 prior convictions in Olmsted County since 2012 for theft, public urination, 5th degree assault, disorderly conduct (3), criminal damage to property (3), trespassing (4), financial transaction fraud, and consuming alcohol in public.

Case 7/26/16, 5th degree assault and criminal damage to property at Nasib Restaurant, 1819 Nicollet Ave, cited by squad 520. (16-270839)

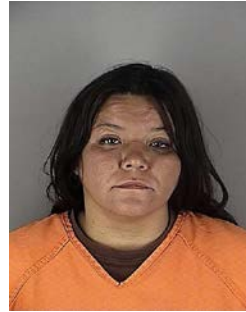
Case 8/2/16, trespassing and littering at LaSalle Community Garden, 1801 LaSalle Ave, cited by Franklin – Nicollet beat officers. (16-280117)

Case 8/11/16, trespassing at Nasib Restaurant, 1819 Nicollet Ave, arrested by Franklin – Nicollet beat officers. (16-292416)

Case 8/18/16, weapons violation, disorderly conduct, and criminal damage to property at 18th & Nicollet, arrested by Franklin – Nicollet beat officers. (16-301701)

Outcome On 8/26/16, pled guilty to disorderly conduct for the 7/26/16 incident; the other charges for this case were dismissed. Sentence: 17 days, with credit for 17 days served. \$50 fine and \$75 court fees waived. Pay additional court fees of \$78. Also pled guilty to the gross misdemeanor trespassing case from 8/11/16. The cases from 8/2/16 and 8/18/16 were dismissed. Sentence: 180 days, stayed for two years, serve 17 days, with credit for 17 days served. Conditions of release: unsupervised probation; no trespassing; no same or similar offenses; stay away from 1819 Nicollet Ave. Serve one day of Sentence to Service in lieu of \$78 court fees. \$50 fine and additional \$75 court fees waived.

Sharee Lanette Barrett (7/10/81) 14 arrests in the area in the past year. 13 prior convictions in Minnesota for possession of marijuana in a motor vehicle, 5th degree felony possession of a controlled substance, receiving stolen property, giving police a false name, disorderly conduct (4), open bottle (2), consuming alcohol in public, 2nd degree burglary of dwelling, and 5th degree assault.

Case 9/25/15, open bottle at Franklin & Nicollet, cited by Franklin – Nicollet beat officers, squad 507. (15-361610)

Case 10/3/15, theft and trespassing at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave, cited by Franklin – Nicollet beat officers. (15-371700)

Case 10/3/15, consuming alcohol in public at Franklin & Nicollet, arrested by squad 525. (15-372267)

Case 10/6/15, theft and trespassing at CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave, arrested by squad 510. (15-375325)

Case 7/14/16, trespassing at Wedge Community Co-op, 2105 Lyndale Ave, cited by Franklin – Nicollet beat officers. (16-256826)

Outcome Through the course of these cases, the defendant failed to appear in court or violated pretrial conditions of release six times, resulting in the issuing of warrants for her arrest on 10/20/15, 2/10/16, 3/15/16, 3/31/16, 5/12/16, and 7/26/16. On 9/12/16, pled guilty to the 10/3/15 trespassing case at CVS; the theft charge was dismissed. Sentence: 90 days, with credit for 90 days served. Pled guilty to the 12/5/15 trespassing case at Starbucks. Sentence: 90 days, with credit for 90 days served. Pled guilty to the 12/12/15 felony 3rd degree burglary case at CVS. Sentence: 15 months in prison, stayed for three years, serve 172 days in the workhouse, with credit for 171 days served. The court ordered a durational departure from the presumptive sentence called for in the state Sentencing Guidelines. Conditions of release: supervised probation; immediate furlough to treatment; no use of alcohol or controlled substances; remain law abiding; chemical dependency evaluation / treatment; complete treatment; stay away from CVS, 2001 Nicollet Ave, and Macy's, 700 Nicollet Mall. The cases from 9/25/15, 10/3/15 (consuming), 10/6/15, 11/16/15, and 7/14/16 (open bottle plus trespassing) were dismissed. Pled guilty to gross misdemeanor 5th degree assault from 9/26/15; a disorderly conduct charge was dismissed. Sentence: 365 days, with 194 days stayed for two years, serve 171 days, with credit for 171 days served. This sentence was ordered to be served concurrently with the felony sentence above. Conditions of release: supervised probation; no same or similar offenses; no assault; no disorderly conduct. Pled guilty to a 5th degree assault case from 5/12/16; a trespassing charge was dismissed. Sentence: 90 days, with credit for 90 days served. The following cases were also dismissed: theft from 5/9/15; open bottle from 10/28/15; 3rd degree burglary of business from 1/17/16; giving police a false name from 7/31/16.

Abdi Mohamed Areis (1/1/85) 8 arrests in the area since June, 2015. 31 prior convictions in Hennepin County for driving while intoxicated (2), theft, interfering with a 911 call, obstructing the legal process, theft (4), trespassing (16), disorderly conduct, open bottle (2), giving police the false name of another person, public urination, and interfering with traffic.

Case 5/20/16, open bottle at Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave, cited by Franklin – Nicollet beat officers. (16-179661)

Case 6/14/16, consuming alcohol in public at Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave, cited by Park police. (16-214493)

Case 6/14/16, open bottle at Franklin & Nicollet, cited by Franklin – Nicollet beat officers. (16-214868)

Case 6/15/16, open bottle at Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave, cited by Park police. (16-215873)

Case 9/10/16, consuming alcohol in public at Fair Oaks Park, 2200 3rd Ave, cited by Park police. (16-331087)

Outcome On 9/13/16, pled guilty to the case from 5/20/16. The other four cases were dismissed. Sentence: 90 days, with credit for 2 days served. This sentence was ordered to be served concurrently with the sentences for two other cases to which the defendant pled guilty: open bottle from 6/7/16 and open bottle from 6/9/16. The sentence for the 6/7/16 case indicates that the defendant will be furloughed to treatment. In addition, these three cases were ordered to be served consecutively with another case to which the defendant pled guilty: trespassing from 9/12/16. Sentence: 90 days, stayed for one year. Conditions of release: probation to the court; remain law abiding; stay a reasonable distance away from the scene of the crime; obey Metro Transit trespass notices. Pay \$78 court fees. Additional \$75 court fees waived. Workhouse release date: 11/9/16.

William Gus Ernst (11/22/65) 9 arrests in the area in the past eight years. 65 prior convictions in Minnesota for theft (22), trespassing (7), 2nd degree criminal sexual conduct, consuming alcohol in public (11), open bottle (6), possession of liquor in a park (2), loitering with intent to solicit, possession of drug paraphernalia, interfering with traffic, disorderly conduct, 5th degree assault (3), 4th degree assault, pedestrian fails to obey traffic signals, drug ordinance violation, indecent exposure (3), 3rd degree burglary, attempted robbery, and failure to register as a predatory offender.

Case 7/14/16, trespassing at 20 Groveland Ave, cited by Franklin – Nicollet beat officers. (16-256525)

Outcome On 9/16/16, pled guilty. Sentence: 39 days, with credit for 39 days served. Pay \$78 court fees. \$50 fine and additional \$75 court fees waived. Also pled guilty to 4th degree felony assault of hospital emergency personnel from 3/23/16. Sentence: 13 months, stayed for three years, with credit for 39 days served. Conditions of release: supervised probation; follow all state and federal laws; no contact with victim(s); no use of alcohol or controlled substances; take prescribed medications; complete chemical assessment; cognitive skill training; register as a predatory offender.
