Part 1 crimes reported in Stevens Square-Loring Heights, July 24 to September 2015 (source: Crime Prevention Specialist Chelsea Adams)

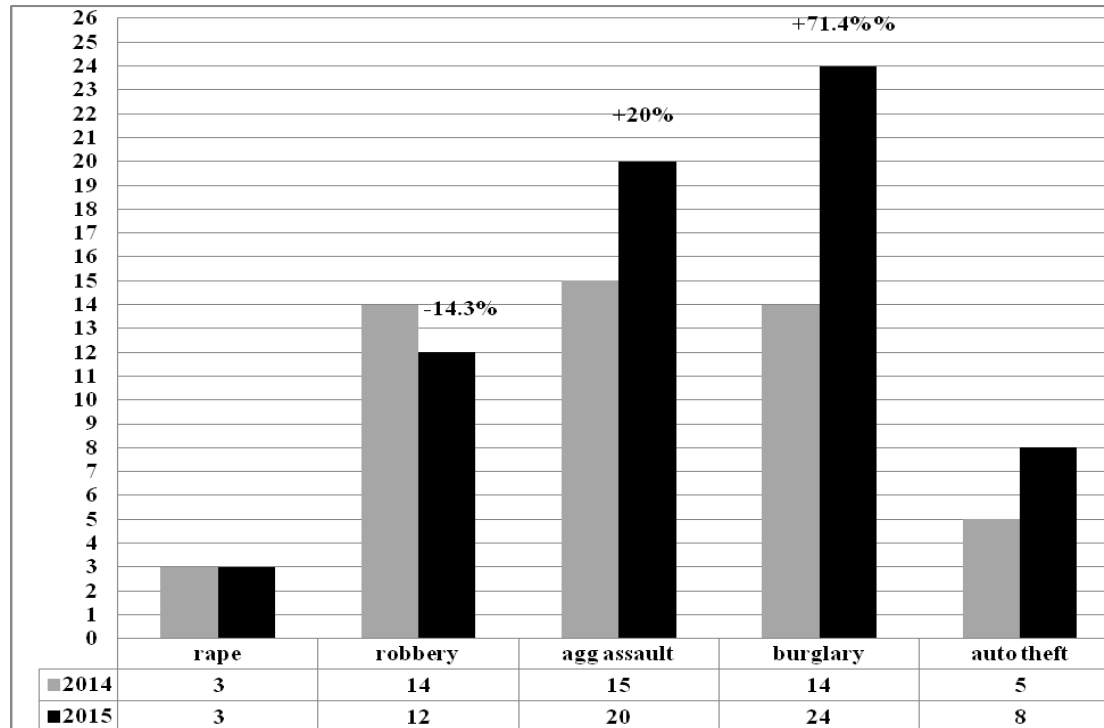
- 1 sexual assault: 9/12, in which the suspect is known to the victim – further information is restricted.
- 1 arson: 7/29, 8:10 p.m., at 220 East 19th St in which investigators determined that the fire had been intentionally set.
- 4 robberies of person: 8/3, 9 p.m., at 1816 Nicollet Ave in which an acquaintance robbed a victim of medication; 8/12, 8:10 p.m., at 1929 3rd Ave in which Devante Alexander Taylor (9/19/94) was arrested for attempting to rob two victims in separate incidents; 8/19, 5:15 p.m., at 19th & 3rd in which a victim was robbed by an acquaintance; 8/25, 1 a.m., at 601 Ridgewood Ave in which a suspect approached a victim – who was distracted by his phone – from behind, punched him, and stole his backpack.
- 3 aggravated assaults (not including domestics): – 7/25, 6 p.m., at 1933 Lyndale Ave in which a female acquaintance struck a victim in the head with a cane; 8/14 at Franklin & 3rd in which Abdifatah Muse Mohamed (1/1/83) was subsequently arrested for assaulting a victim who was uncooperative with police and was transported to a hospital for injuries; 9/8, 9:45 p.m., at 1920 4th Ave in which multiple suspects assaulted a victim who was transported to a hospital and then left before investigators could contact him.
- 4 burglaries: 8/21 at 1718 Clinton Ave in which a door to a condo unit was forced open and items stolen; 8/30 at 214 East 19th St in which a laundry room was burglarized; 9/1 to 9/3 at 1918 3rd Ave in which a bike was stolen from an unsecured common area; 9/21 at 1801 LaSalle Ave in which items were stolen from an apartment which was left unlocked so that maintenance staff could enter.
- 4 motor vehicle thefts – 7/25 to 7/29 at 1905 Stevens Ave in which a vehicle parked on the street was stolen and recovered on 8/5 at an address on the 900 block of 23rd Ave North – a suspect fled before officers could apprehend him; 8/16 at 18th & Stevens in which a known suspect stole a vehicle which was recovered on 8/21 in the alley behind 1820 4th Ave; 9/3 at Franklin & Lyndale in which a cab which had struck three vehicles was subsequently stolen and then recovered at 26th & Blaisdell; 9/15 at Groveland & LaSalle in which Richard Sherman Cushman (2/3/63) was arrested for stealing a police bait vehicle out of the 1st Precinct.

Joseph Jovan Williams (7/18/94)
Case 1/27/15, robbery of person at 440 Ridgewood Ave, arrested by squad 541. (15-031371)
Outcome On 5/13/15, pled guilty. Sentenced on 8/21/15: 18 months, stayed for three years, serve 120 days, with credit for 4 days served. Serve as electronic home monitoring if eligible. Work release if eligible. Conditions of release: supervised probation; obtain and maintain employment; no use of non-prescribed controlled substances; pay \$200 restitution; remain law abiding; cognitive skill training; no contact with the victim; stay at least three blocks away from the victim's residence / place of work. Report to the workhouse on 9/11/15. Workhouse release date: 11/25/15.
Sentencing judge – William Koch

Jeffrey Thomas Blake (1/10/58) 5 arrests in the area in the past year. 3 prior convictions in Hennepin County for consuming alcohol in public, disorderly conduct, and public urination.
Case 7/9/15, consuming alcohol in public in Stevens Square Park, 1801 Stevens Ave, cited by Park police. (15-254001)
Outcome On 8/17/15, pled guilty to open bottle. Pay \$300 fine and \$78 court fees.
